# What is a DRGR Flag?

- DRGR Flags assist grantees and CPD Reps with identifying and resolving issues (or potential issues) arising in the DRGR system.
- Flags can occur at the Grant, Action Plan, or QPR level
- There are three Flag Types:
  - At-Risk indicators (e.g. expenditure deadline approaching)
  - Compliance (e.g. admin cap exceeded; QPR is late)
  - Data clean-up (e.g. performance measures missing)
- Flags can be accessed from the Compliance Module
- The new Housing Flags are Data Clean-up Flags



# New Housing Flag Criteria

- Action Plan
  - Unit Type: Missing Single Family or Multifamily Housing Unit projections
  - Tenure: Missing Owner or Renter Household projections
- QPR
  - The number of reported Housing Units does not equal the number of reported Households
  - The number of Total Housing Units does not equal the sum of reported units by Unit Type
  - The number of Total Households does not equal the sum of reported households by tenure
