2021 HIC & PIT COUNT DATA SUBMISSION



Data Submission Guidance

2021 HIC and PIT Count Data Submission Guidance (published April 2021) includes detailed instructions on:

HIC Change: ESG-CV Funding Source

A new McKinney-Vento funding source has been added to account for ESG-CV projects. All projects funded with ESG-CV should select **"yes" for the ESG-CV funding source** then should select either **ESG-ES** or **ESG-RRH** for each project





HIC Guidance: SSVF EHA Inventory

Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) Emergency Housing Assistance (EHA) in use on the night of the count should be included in the HIC (as ES) and sheltered PIT count (as ES).

- **Project Type**: Emergency Shelter (ES)
- Emergency Shelter Bed and Unit Availability: Overflow Beds
- Year-Round Bed Inventory: 0 year-round beds
- Funding Source: VA: Supportive Services for Veteran Families Program (SSVF)

Note: A validation warning will appear in HDX when SSVF is selected as the funding source for an ES project. Please add a note on the project record to confirm that the inventory listed is for "SSVF EHA."



HIC Guidance: SSVF EHA Inventory

- HMIS Participation & HMIS Project ID: These fields will depend on how the SSVF project already accounts for EHA resources in HMIS.
 - If the SSVF EHA is tracked as a "service" in the SSVF RRH project in HMIS, then the EHA ES
 HIC inventory should be listed as <u>non-HMIS-participating</u> and the <u>HMIS Project ID</u> should
 be the *same as the SSVF RRH project's HMIS Project ID with "-EHA" on the end.*

Example:

- SSVF RRH project's HMIS Project ID: "4" in HMIS and on the HIC
- SSVF EHA project's HMIS Project ID: "4-EHA" on the HIC
- If the SSVF project reports EHA as an ES project in HMIS (which is allowed but not required), then the EHA ES HIC project should be listed as <u>HMIS-participating</u>. The <u>HMIS</u>
 <u>Project ID</u> in the HIC should then *match the Project ID in HMIS*.
- Project Inventory PIT Count: Should reflect the total number of people served by EHA on the night of the count.



HIC & PIT Count Guidance: HMIS & SSVF EHA

- For SSVF projects that log EHA as a "service" transaction in the SSVF RRH project in HMIS:
 - Include all veterans enrolled in VA-funded SSVF RRH projects in HMIS who have:
 - \checkmark No Housing Move-in Date recorded as of the night of the count.

<u>AND</u>

- \checkmark An existing EHA TFA Service recorded for the month in which the PIT count took place.
- In the sheltered PIT count & on the HIC inventory PIT field: Include the number of people who meet these criteria.
- On the HIC: If the CoC does not know the number of beds supplied for each household, assume 1 bed per person (i.e., 100% bed utilization).



HIC Guidance: GPD Projects & Hotel/Motel Beds

- Hotel/motel beds provided by VA-funded Grant Per Diem (GPD) projects should be counted as part of the GPD project. These beds should not be counted as their own ES project.
- Clients staying in GPD-funded hotel/motel beds on the night of count should be counted in each GPD project inventory's PIT count field on the HIC.



Reporting HUD-VASH Households in the HIC

For CoCs using the HUD-VASH HOMES Transfer Tool:

It is acceptable to consider each household served a "household without children" with one person in it.

For CoCs using **HMIS or another method of data collection** on HUD-VASH households served:

Keep counting households served as accurately as possible.



"Received HUD Waiver?"

- As always, this question refers to whether a CoC received a waiver from HUD to conduct their PIT count outside the last 20 days of January.
- This does not refer to use of the unsheltered PIT count waivers available through the <u>CPD Memo</u>: <u>Availability of Waivers for the Biennial Point-in-Time Count of Unsheltered Homelessness.</u>

"Sheltered-Only Count"

 For CoCs that did not conduct any type of unsheltered PIT count in 2021





"Sheltered and Full Unsheltered Count"

- For CoCs that conducted the sheltered and unsheltered PIT count as they would in any other year. These CoCs collected and can report data on:
 - The full CoC geography
 - All required data elements for all people counted, including:
 - Household type
 - Demographics
 - Chronic status
 - Subpopulation data (i.e., youth and veteran households)
 - Additional populations





"Sheltered and Partial Unsheltered Count"

- For CoCs that collected some but not all unsheltered data elements
- "Partial unsheltered count" does not mean partial geographic or population coverage. CoCs must still have used a methodology that meets HUD's standards to cover the full geography and population, but without some data elements (e.g., "head count" only)

New color coding to help users identify where they have and can edit unsheltered data fields:

- White fields can be manually entered or changed.
- **Light blue fields** are "totals" fields that have been manually (i.e., not automatically) calculated.
- **47 Grey fields with numbers** in them have been automatically calculated from other manually entered data and cannot be edited.
 - **Grey fields with a blue border on the right-hand side** are fields that would be editable but are not editable because a relevant field in another table has been manually changed. If you hover over this kind of field with your mouse, it will tell you why it cannot be edited.

Partial Unsheltered Count: Accounting for Incomplete Data

- For CoCs that conducted partial unsheltered counts, in each unsheltered demographic category (i.e., age, gender, race, and ethnicity), please enter complete demographics that sum to the total number of people reported in that column or leave demographics blank.
- Demographic data that do not sum to the total will not be used, and the total field will be assumed to be correct. You should not submit partial data within any specific demographic, additional population, or subpopulation category.
