TO DISASTER RECOVERY WHEN FUNDED
SIX PROJECTS TOTALLING MORE THAN
\$900 MILLION, WHICH ARE IN THE
PROCESS OF BEING DEVELOPED.

IT REFLECTED EXCESSIVE
COLLABORATION AND IS DEEPLY
STEEPED IN THE COMMUNITIES
THEMSELVES.

THE PROGRAM WAS INNOVATED IN MANY WAYS.

NOT THE LEAST OF WHICH IS INTERSECTED BETWEEN THOSE APPROACHES.

AND LIMITED BETWEEN THE PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN PHILANTHROPY AND HUD.

AND USING A TWO-PHASED PROCESS TO HELP IDENTIFY NEEDS AND IDENTIFY SOLUTIONS TO THE PROBLEM AS ASSOCIATED WITH THE DISASTERS.

CHANGE UPON COMMUNITIES THAT
RECEIVE GRANTS BUT ALL PARTIES

TWO-PHASE COMPETITION.

NOW, WE'RE ABOUT HALFWAY THROUGH
THE COMPETITION IN ENTERING INTO
PHASE TWO, APPLICATION DEADLINE
FOR PHASE TWO WILL BE
OCTOBER 27TH, 2015.

AND THAT IS GOING TO BE WHEN
YOUR APPLICATIONS WILL BE DUE TO
HUD.

PHASE ONE, AS YOU HOPEFULLY
KNOW, IS THE PERIOD OF TIME IN
WHICH WE ASKED COMMUNITIES TO
LOOK AT THE CHALLENGES THEY FACE
AND RISKS THEY'RE LIKELY TO BE
FACED WITHIN THE FUTURE AND TO
IDENTIFY THEIR VULNERABILITIES
TO FIGURE OUT WHAT THE COMMUNITY
OBJECTIVES THEY SEEK TO ACHIEVE
THROUGH THIS RESILIENCE EFFORT,
IDENTIFY THEIR TEAM AND PARTNERS
THEY'LL NEED FOR THE PLAN, AND
TO IDENTIFY THE THRESHOLD
REQUIREMENTS AND SPECIAL
REQUIREMENTS HUD SET FORTH, AND
CONSULT WITH STAKE HOLDERS ABOUT
HOW TO DEVELOP THE PLAN AND TO
ARTICULATE THAT IN THE FORM OF
AN IDEA OR CONCEPT THAT IS

THE PHASE ONE FRAMING AND IDEA
DEVELOPED SO FAR.

WE'LL ASK TO PREVENT COST
ANALYSIS FOR LARGE PROJECTS.

WE'LL ASK THAT THE COMMUNITY AND
APPLICANT TAKES AND CONTINUES TO
COMMIT ACTIONS THAT WILL
STRENGTHEN COMPETITIVENESS OF
THEIR PROPOSAL AND ENSURE THERE
IS A LONG TERM WIN OCCURRING IN
THE COMMUNITY.

AND FINALLY, WE'RE LOOKING FOR
APPLICANTS TO EXTEND RESILIENCE

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BEYOND ACTIONS AND AREAS
IDENTIFIED IN THE PHASE TWO
APPLICATION.

WE HOPE THAT LEVERAGING AND
USING A BROADER GEOGRAPHY, AS
WELL AS DEVELOPING A RAFT OF
LONG TERM COMMITMENT BY THE
APPLICANT WILL LEAD TO A LONG
TERM GOAL.

WE THINK THAT YOU SHOULD APPLY
FOR PHASE TWO IN ORDER TO PURSUE
LOCAL, PHYSICAL, SOCIAL,
ECONOMIC RESILIENCE

WE HOPE AND EXPECT THAT YOU'LL
FOCUS ON THE MOST-VULNERABLE
POPULATIONS AND SECTORS AND USE
THIS OPPORTUNITY TO DO ALL THAT
CAN BE DONE TO PROTECT THEM.

WE HOPE THAT YOU WILL FIND VALUE
IN COMPETING AND LEARNING WITH
THE COMMUNITIES AND EXPECT THAT
SOME NATIONS GREATEST LESSONS
AROUND RESILIENCE WILL EMERGE
FROM THIS COMPETITION

WE HOPE THAT YOU'RE ATTRACTED
ABOUT THE OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN
ABOUT RESILIENCE WITH A LONG
RANGE OF SUPPORT FROM ACROSS THE

NOW, WITH ALL OF THESE WEBINARS WE'VE GIVEN YOU THE CAVEAT THAT ANYTHING WE SAY HERE IS GENERAL, NOT SPECIFIC AND THE NOFA IS GOING TO PREVAIL.

CAVEAT ENDED.

SO THAT SAID YOU NEED TO GO TO GRANTS.GOV AND GET THE NOFA, AND WE'LL POST INSTRUCTIONS FOR. THAT WE KNOW GRANTS.GOV LIKES TO HIDE APPENDIXES.

WE WANT YOU TO CONNECT TO THE CBBG MAILING LIST AND WITH OUR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE RESOURCES WE SEND OUT MESSAGES ABOUT WEBINARS AND OTHER NOTES. THROUGH THE MEANS.

WE'RE EXPECTING YOU TO GO AND SIGN ON YOUR PARTNERS AND CONNECT WITH EXPERTS, CONSULT WITH YOUR STAKE HOLDERS, RECRUNCH YOUR DATA.

REFORM YOUR CONCLUSION, AND GET A COMPELLING PROJECT THAT ARISES FROM YOUR PHASE ONE FRAMING.

RESPOND TO FACTORS AND IN PHASE TWO, UNLIKE PHASE ONE, WE TOLD YOU THAT SOME OF THOSE THINGS WON'T APPLY TO YOU, IN PHASE TWO YOU NEED TO RESPOND TO THE PROMPTS.

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YOU'RE GOING TO HAVE TO SAY THAT
BUT RESPOND TO ALL PROMPTS AND
YOU'RE GOING TO SUBMIT A PHASE
TWO APPLICATION.

BY THE DEADLINE.

THIS ONE, YOU'RE FAMILIAR WITH.
MOST IMPACTED AND DISTRESSED
AREA WITH UNMET RECOVERY NEEDS
THE FUNDS THAT ARE GOING TO BE
AWARDED MAY ONLY BE USED TO
ADDRESS UNMET RECOVERY NEEDS
INCLUDING RELATED RESILIENCE
NEEDS OF THE AREAS LOCATED IN
ELIGIBILITY COUNTIES.

THRESHOLD BUT WE EXPECT THAT TO
REACH FURTHER.

AND TO REACH TO RECOVERY ARE
RESILIENCE MEANS IN SURROUNDING
AREAS, REGIONS, THE STATE, MULTI
STATE REGIONS

WE WANT YOU TO REVIEW WEBINARS
ON THIS THRESHOLD AND REVIEW THE
COMMENTS.

LET'S TALK ABOUT THE DEADLINE
FOR PHASE TWO.

THERE IS A NOTICE OF FUND
AVAILABILITIES, AND HAS
APPENDIXES.

A IS YOUR PROGRAM IMPOSED AWARD
REQUIREMENT.

AND YOU'RE GETTING CLOSER TO
THAT.

YOUR PROJECT IS GOING TO HAVE TO
COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS.

IF YOU HAVEN'T READ IT, NOW IS

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THE TIME.

THERE IS A LIST OF PARTNERS THAT ARE GOING TO REMAIN HOW FOR EACH PARTNER IF YOU WANT US TO CONSIDER THEIR CAPACITY, A PARTNER LETTER AND AGREEMENT. AND NEED TO BE EXECUTED AND SUBMITTED.

THERE ARE PHASE TWO INSTRUCTIONS FOR REQUESTING WAIVERS OF VARIOUS THINGS.

AND THE TWO-YEAR SCHEDULE.

THINK ABOUT THESE.

THEY'RE NOT LIMITED BY PAGE LIMITS

YOU WANT TO GET YOUR REQUESTS IN IF POSSIBLE.

THERE IS CERTIFICATIONS.

WE'VE UPDATED DIRECTIONS BECAUSE WE REALIZE THEY DIDN'T MATCH WHAT GRANTS.GOV MADE YOU ALL DO.

THERE IS EARNED CRITERIA.

THERE IS A CHECK LIST FORM.

FOR THOSE OF YOU PROPOSING PROJECTS THAT ARE GOING TO BE IN TWO OR MORE COUNTIES, WITH A COST ANALYSIS THAT GUIDANCE HAS BEEN UPDATED.

AND WILL BE WORKING ON THAT.

YOU'RE GOING TO SHOW US THEY'RE EQUAL TO COST.

WHEN YOU KEEP USING THE SECTIONS IN 2014, AND BECAUSE YOU MIGHT HAVE TO DIG FOR THAT ON GRANTS.GOV WE'RE GOING TO FIND A WAY TO MAKE IT AVAILABLE ON OUR WEB PAGE AS WELL.

MANY OF YOU HAVE SEEN THIS BEFORE.

AND HERE IS A RULE OF THUMB WHATEVER THE FACTOR IS ASKING FOR, DISCUSS YOUR OVER ALL PROPOSAL AREA IF IT'S DIFFERENT, OR LARGER.

SO YOU SHOULD UPDATE YOUR AREAS TO PHASE TWO.

AND ARE ENCOURAGED BUT IT WASN'T PERFECT.

AND YOU MAY ADD, OR CHANGE AREAS WITHIN LIMITS.

ALSO, THIS GIVES YOU THE LANGUAGE, WHICH IS THAT YOUR AREA MUST BE THE SAME.

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IF YOU HAD SOME OF YOUR
GEOGRAPHY WE'RE TALKING ABOUT
GEOGRAPHY INFORM PHASE ONE, NOT
ACCEPTED.

FOR MORE VULNERABLE POPULATIONS
WE WANT TO MAKE A POINT YOUR
COMMUNITY IS ONLY RESILIENT AS
MAKER OF LENGTHS IN THE
COMMUNITY.

SOCIAL, ECONOMIC, PHYSICAL.
A LOT OF YOU UNDERSTAND THIS
ABOUT PHYSICAL LINKS THAT
HAVEN'T GOT IT.

ABOUT THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL SO
IT HAS INFORMATION THEY NEED TO
RECOVER.

SO FIGURE OUT WHAT ALL OF YOUR
PROBLEMS ARE BY TALKING TO
EVERYBODY.

INCLUDING VULNERABLE POPULATIONS
AND TELL US WHAT THEY SAID, HOW
IT CHANGED YOUR PROPOSAL.

WE UNDERSTAND THAT FAMILIES THAT
ARE HOVERING AROUND THE POVERTY
LINE ARE MOST DIRECTLY IMPACTED
WHEN A NATURAL DISASTER HAMPERS
THEIR ABILITY TO GET TO WORK.

TO HAVE EMPLOYMENT.

AND THAT CAN OCCUR IN ORDER TO
ALLOW THEM TO REBUILD.

IT CAN MEAN THE DIFFERENCE
BETWEEN HAVING A HOME OR BEING
HOMELESS.

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN FINANCIAL
STABILITY AND INSTABILITY.

GO OUT AND TALK TO FOLKS AND
CONSIDER WHAT THEIR NEEDS ARE.
AND WE'LL BE LOOKING FORWARD TO
FUTURE RISKS.

WHAT MIGHT BE THE CHALLENGES
THAT MIGHT EMERGE?

HOW CAN YOU SOFTEN THE BLOW TO
PUT IN PLANS TO MITIGATE THOSE
SHOCKS TO THAT COMMUNITY?

>> I AGREE.

IF YOU CAN GET REALLY CREATIVE,
AND FIND A WAY TO BOUNCE
FORWARD, WE'D BE VERY
INTERESTED.

SO, INELIGIBILITY ACTIVITIES,
THERE ARE THING THAT'S ARE

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INELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES.

HOWEVER, HUD DID RESERVE THE RIGHT, IF YOU TRY TO KEEP CLASSIFY ELIGIBILITY OF AN ACTIVITY, WE CAN WRITE BACK AND SAY SUBMIT A WAIVER REQUEST OR, YOU KNOW, WE'VE BUILT STUFF IN THERE.

WE KNOW YOU'RE GOING TO BE BEING INNOVATIVE.

SOME THINGS MAY NOT FIT EXACTLY. SO IT IS A RESPONSIBILITY TO REVIEW ELIGIBILITY.

AND EXPLAIN THE ELIGIBILITY.

I BELIEVE IT'S GOING TO BE IN EXHIBIT B.

SO SEE THE NOFA CROSS-CUTTING SECTION.

FOR REQUIREMENTS AND THEY'RE LISTED INELIGIBLE PITS THAT ARE AREN'T GOING TO BE VERY FAMILIAR.

THEY'RE NOT GOING TO BE UNFAMILIAR AT ALL.

SO THE APPENDIX E FOR THE WAIVER AND INSTRUCTIONS.

ALL RIGHT.

PHASE TWO FACTORS.

CAPACITY IS 20 POINTS MAXIMUM, 14 POINTS, MINIMUM.

THAT MEANS THERE IS THRESHOLD INSIDE OF THE CAPACITY FACTOR.

THE MAIN EXTENT IS 20 POINTS.

SOUNDNESS OF APPROACH IS 40 POINTS WITH 25 AS A SCORE MINIMUM.

LEVERAGE IS TEN.

LONG TERM COMMITMENT IS TEN WITH A 2-POINT MINIMUM.

THERE WILL BE A BENEFIT COST REQUIRED FOR COVERED PROJECTS.

SO THIS IS GOING TO BE VERY FAMILIAR TO THOSE OF NEW COMPETITION REGULARLY.

IN THE PAST.

THIS PAST EXPERIENCE REMEMBER PARTNER IS ONLY CONSIDERED IF WE HAVE A LETTER AND AGREEMENT FOR THAT PARTNER.

THERE IS A STATUTORY LIMIT YOU CAN'T DELEGATE YOUR GOVERNMENTAL RESPONSIBILITIES RELATED TO THE MANAGEMENT OF THE FUNDS

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THEMSELVES.

THE LEAD AGENCY MOVES TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT.

AND IF YOU'RE SELECTED FOR A REWARD THEY'RE GOING TO BE ASKING FOR ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION ON. THAT WE WANT YOU TO GIVE A MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE.

THAT IS TEN POINTS.

WE'RE GOING TO REMIND YOU TO SUBMIT AN ORGANIZATIONAL CHART ALONG WITH YOUR NARRATIVE.

SO FACTOR TWO, THERE ARE FIVE POINTS FOR UNMET RECOVERY AND TARGET GEOGRAPHY.

I DON'T WANT TO YOU THINK YOU SHOULD LEAVE IT ON THE TABLE.

I'M NOT ALLOWED TO TELL YOU THIS SCORING YET BUT WE HAVE A COMPETITION THAT YOU SHOULD BE WORKING ON THESE.

YOU WANT TO COVER THE NEEDS OF YOUR PROPOSAL AND GEOGRAPHY.

AND YOU CAN SUMMARIZE THE SAME AS IN PHASE ONE.
