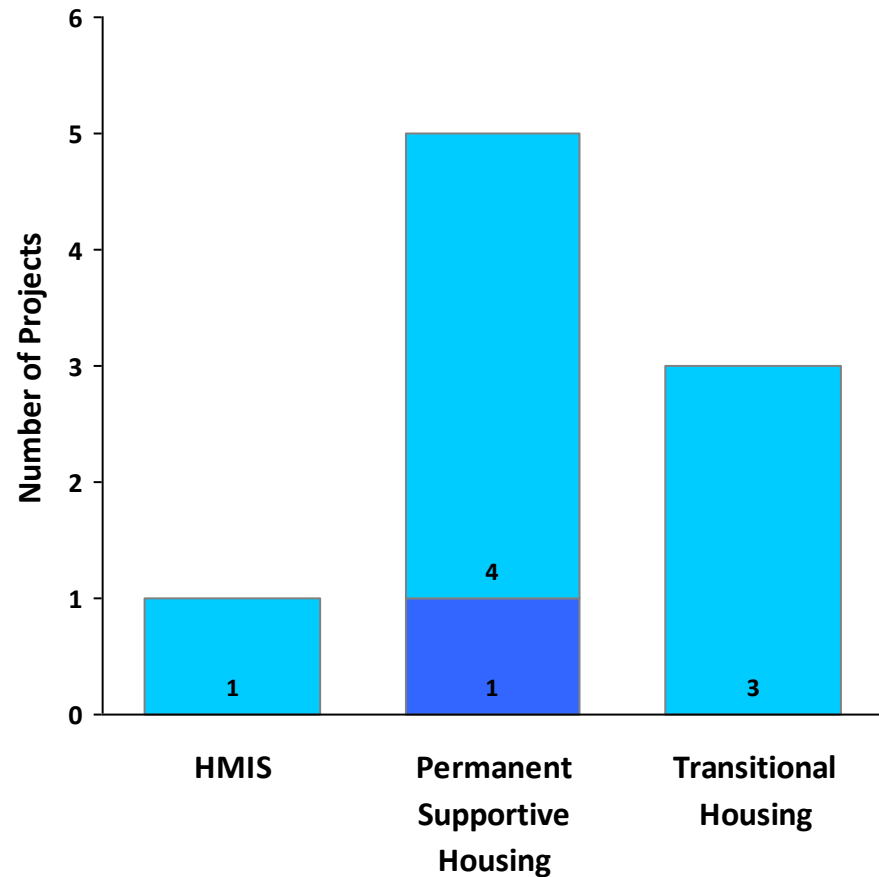

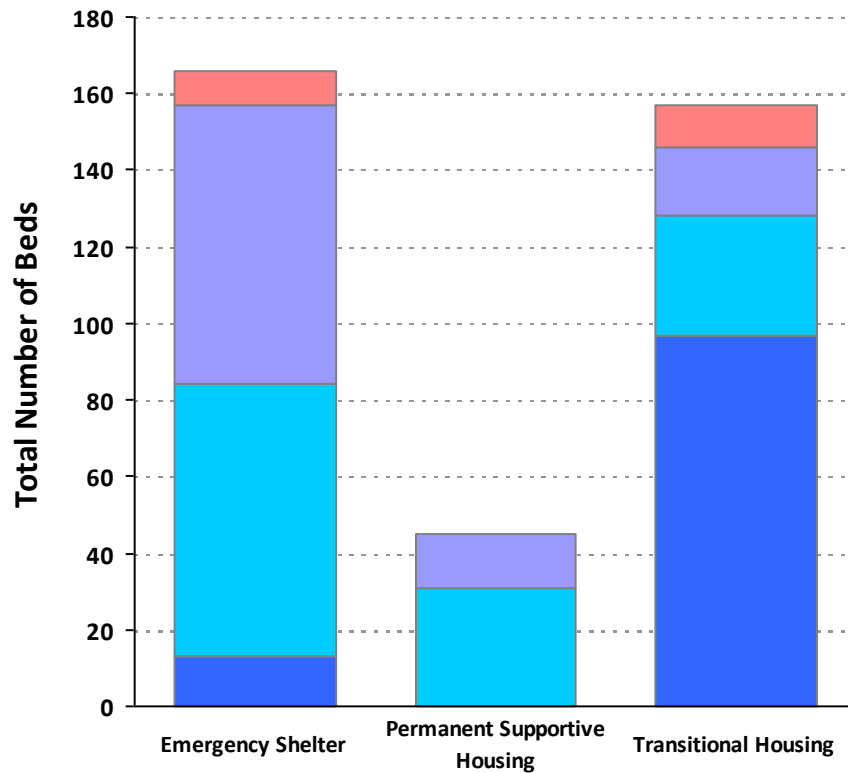


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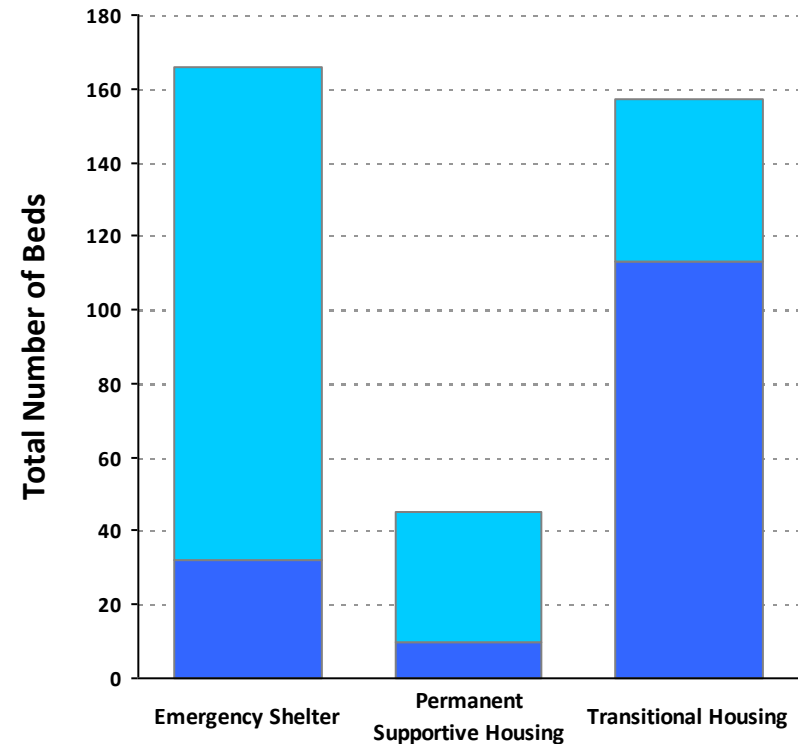
2010 Housing Inventory Summarized by Target Population and Bed Type

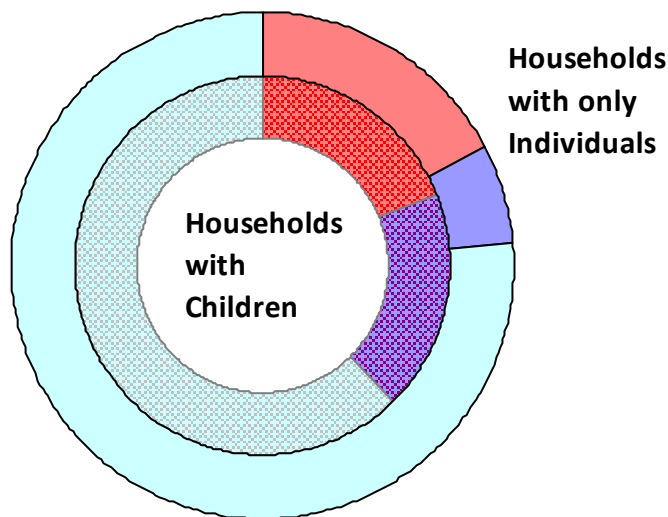
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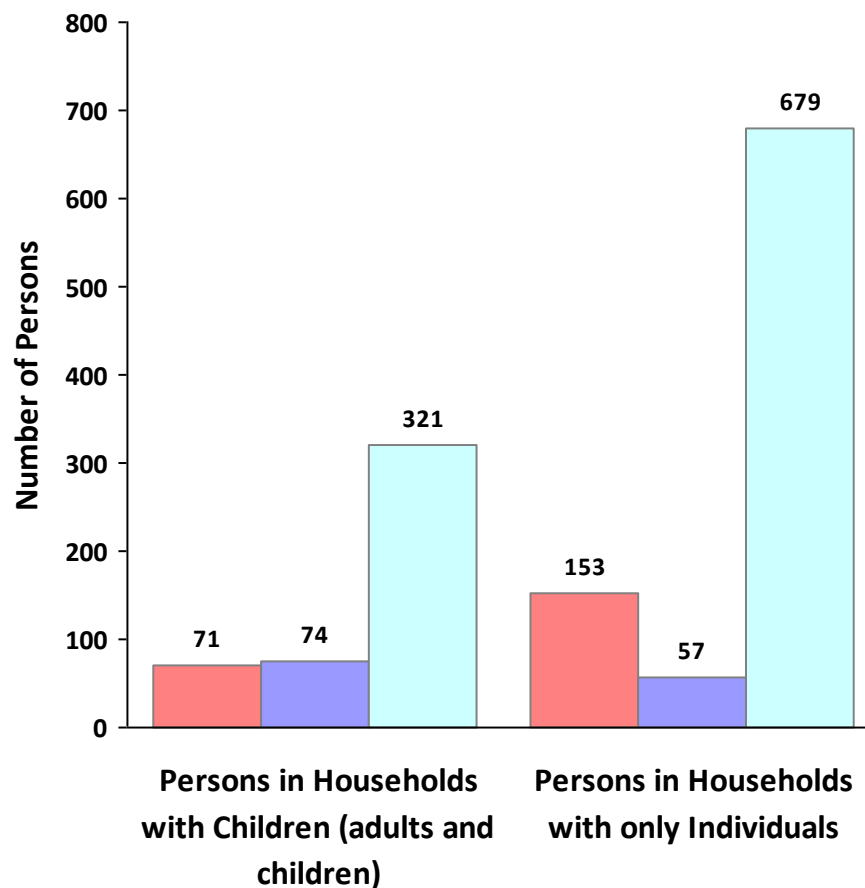
2010 Point in Time Count Summarized by Household Type
