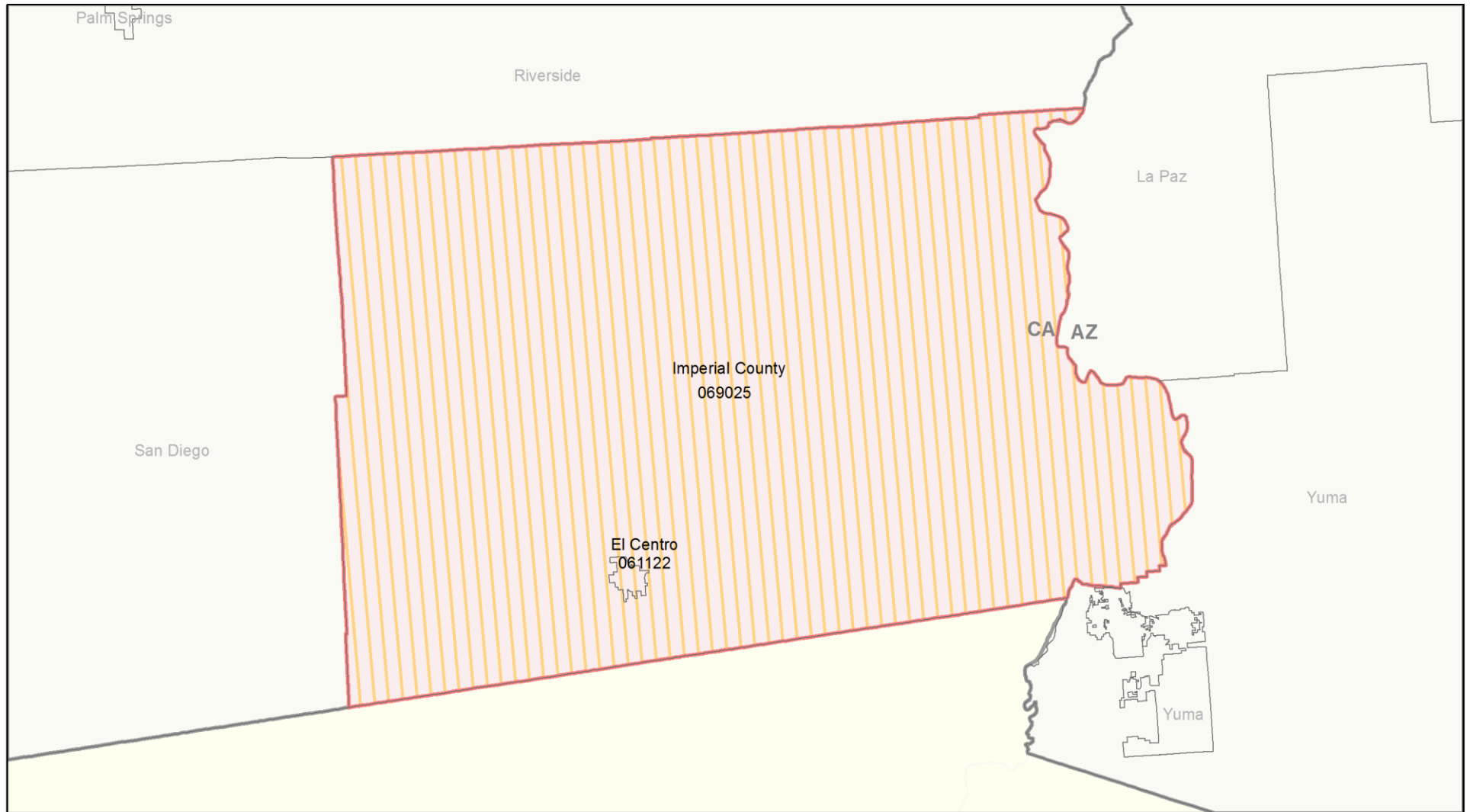

 2016 CoC Boundary  2015 CoC Boundary



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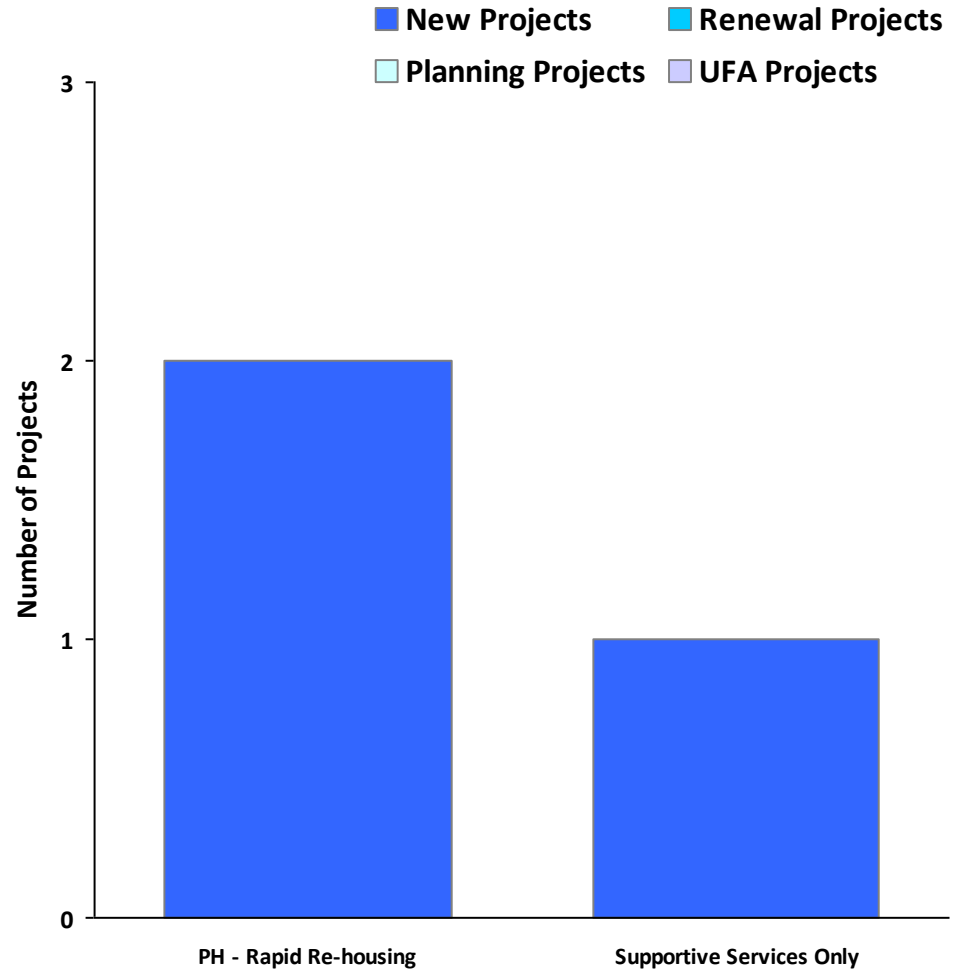
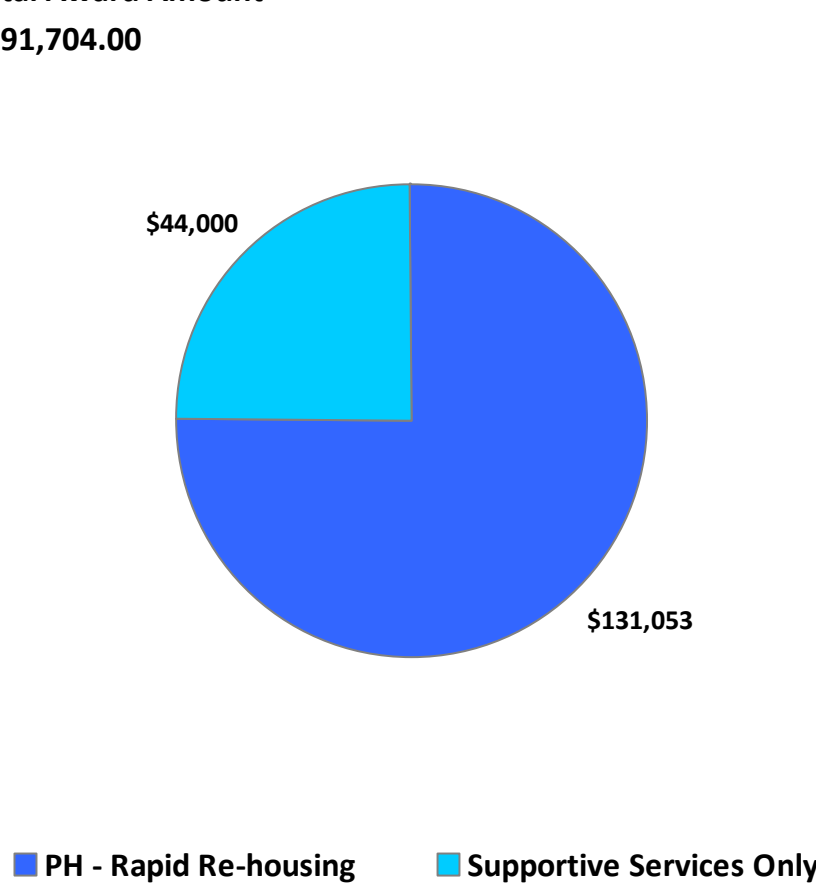

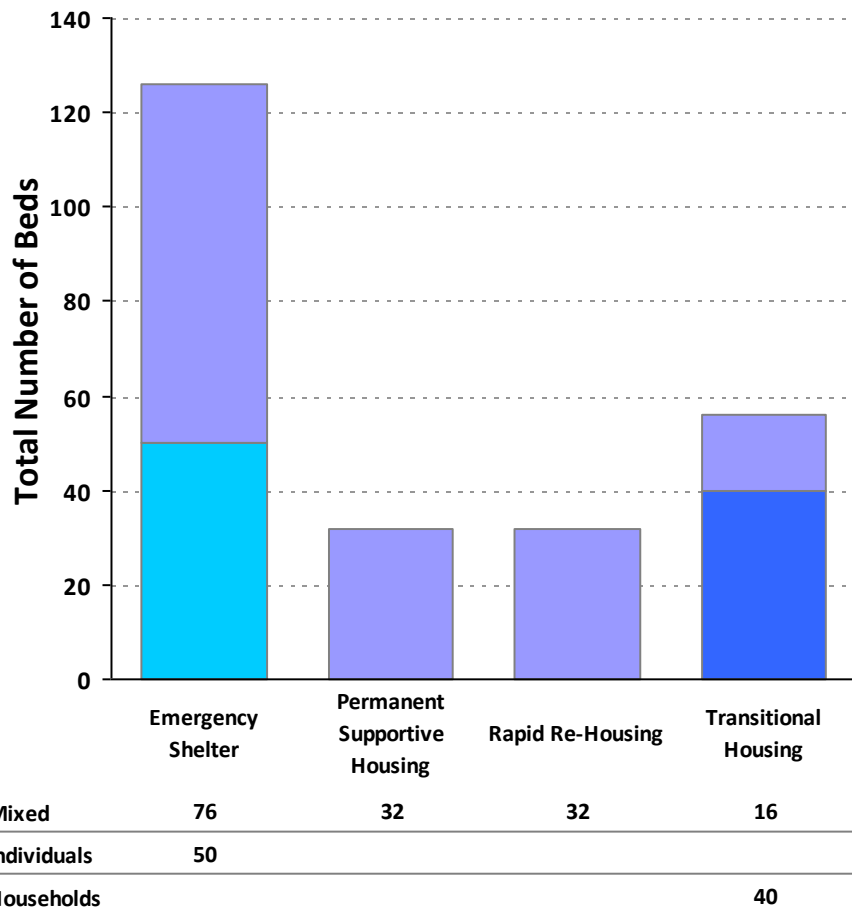

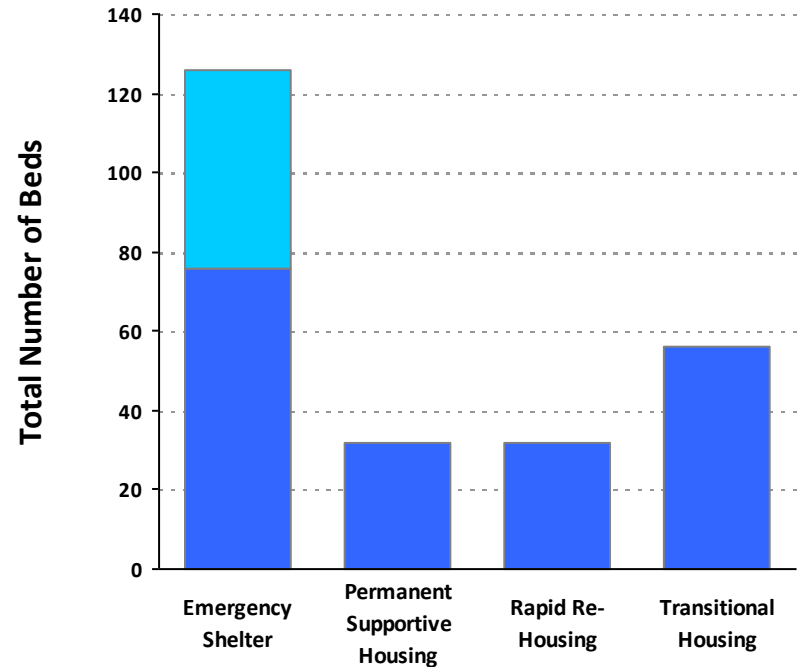

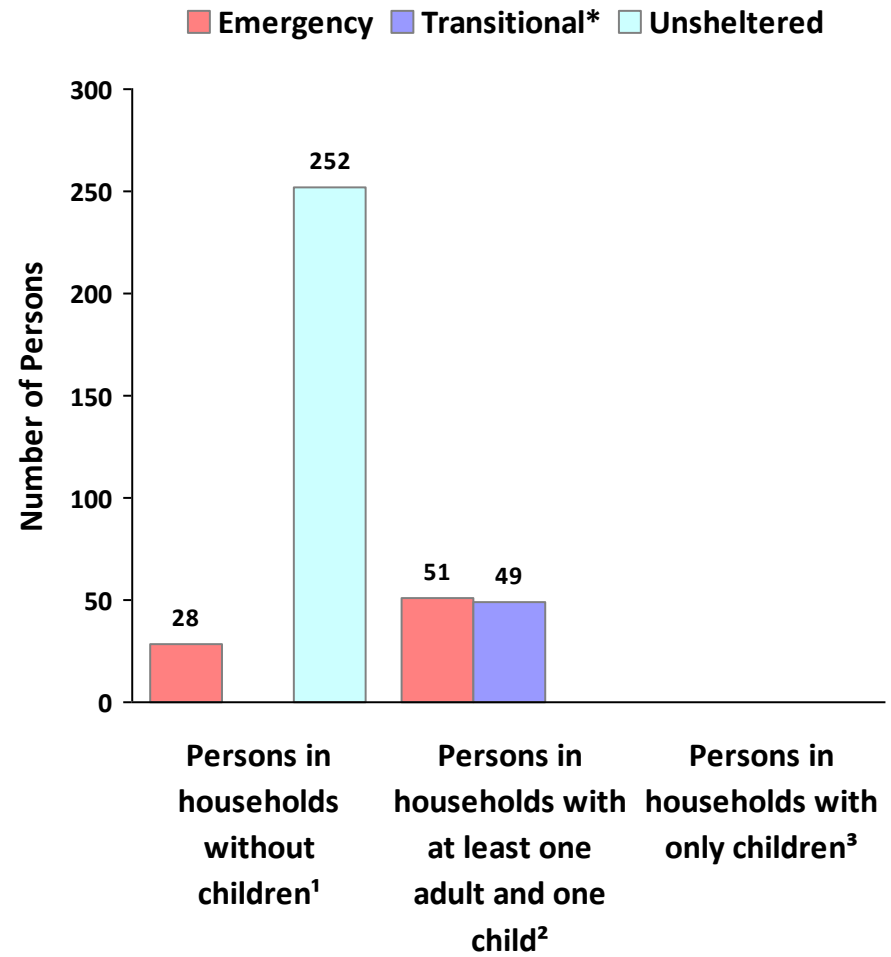
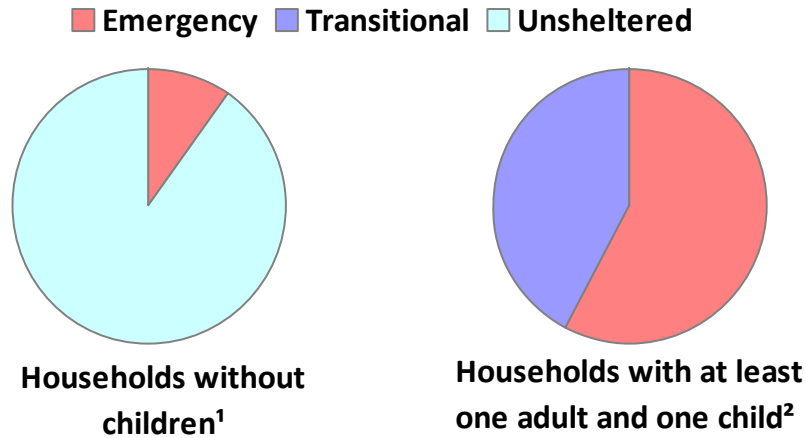

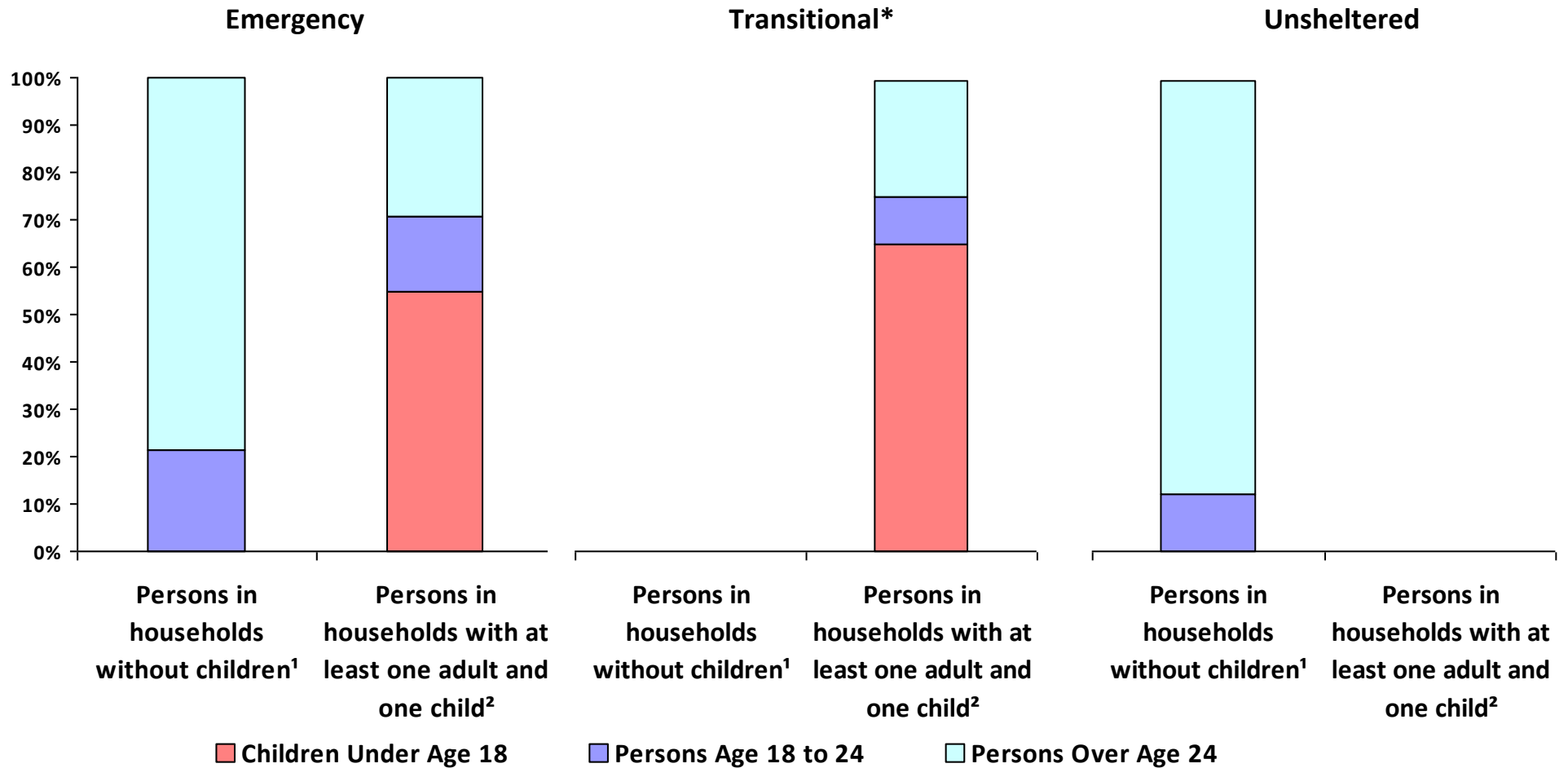
