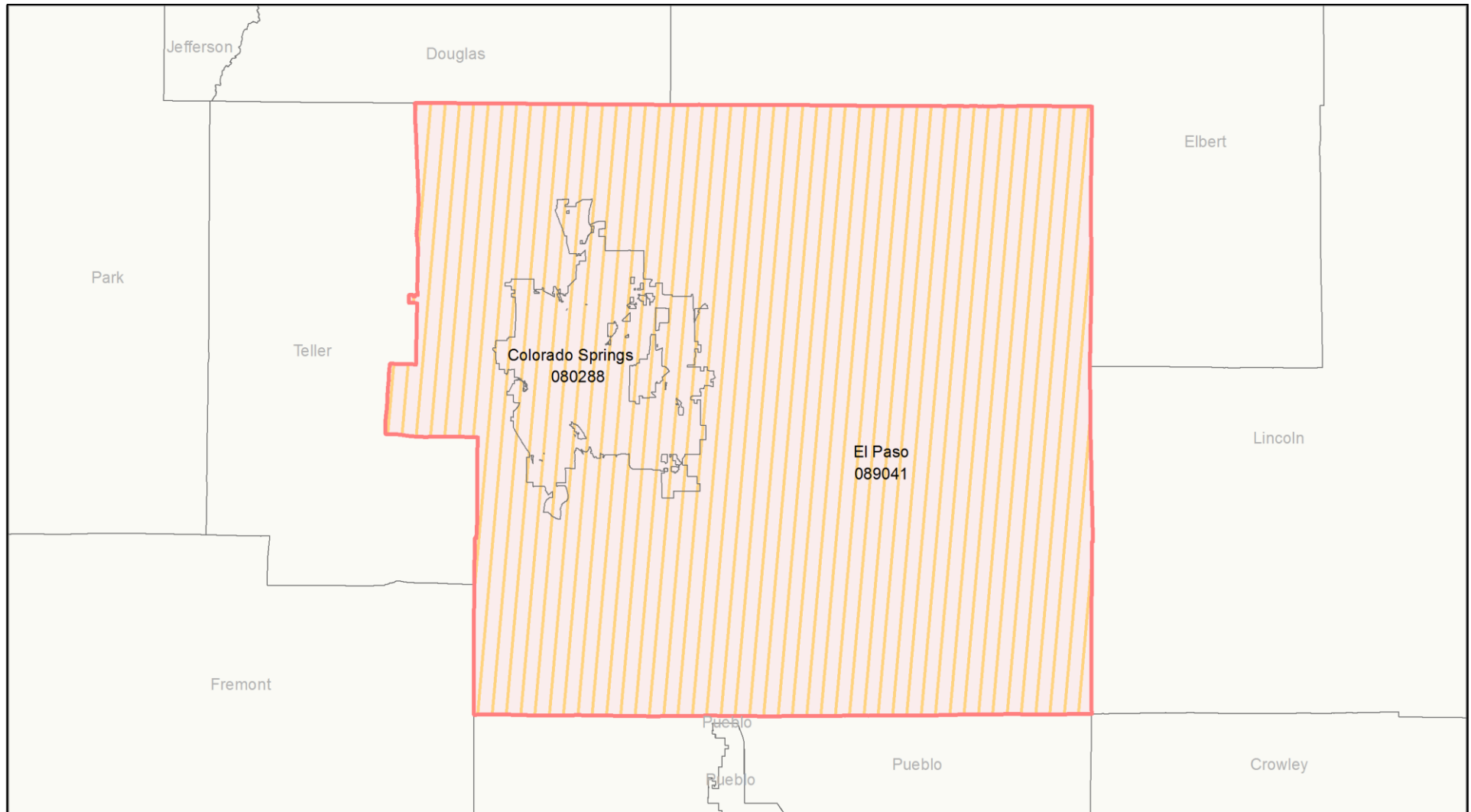

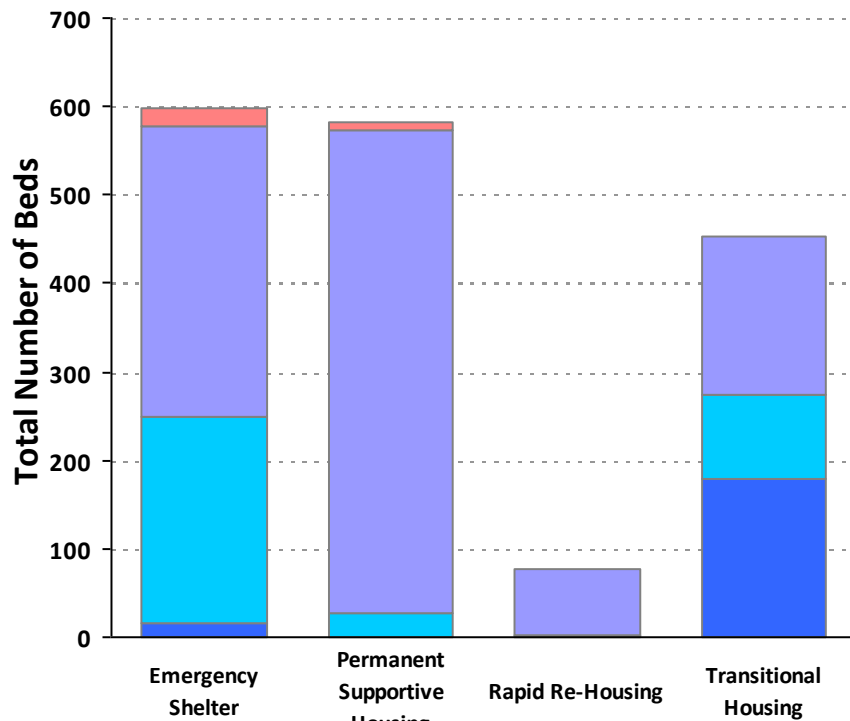

**Beds by Designated Target Population**

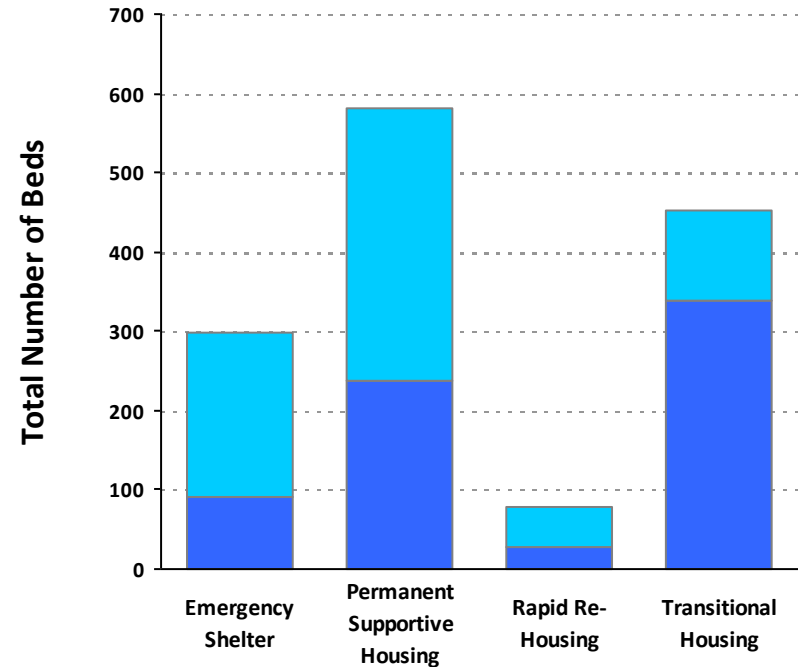

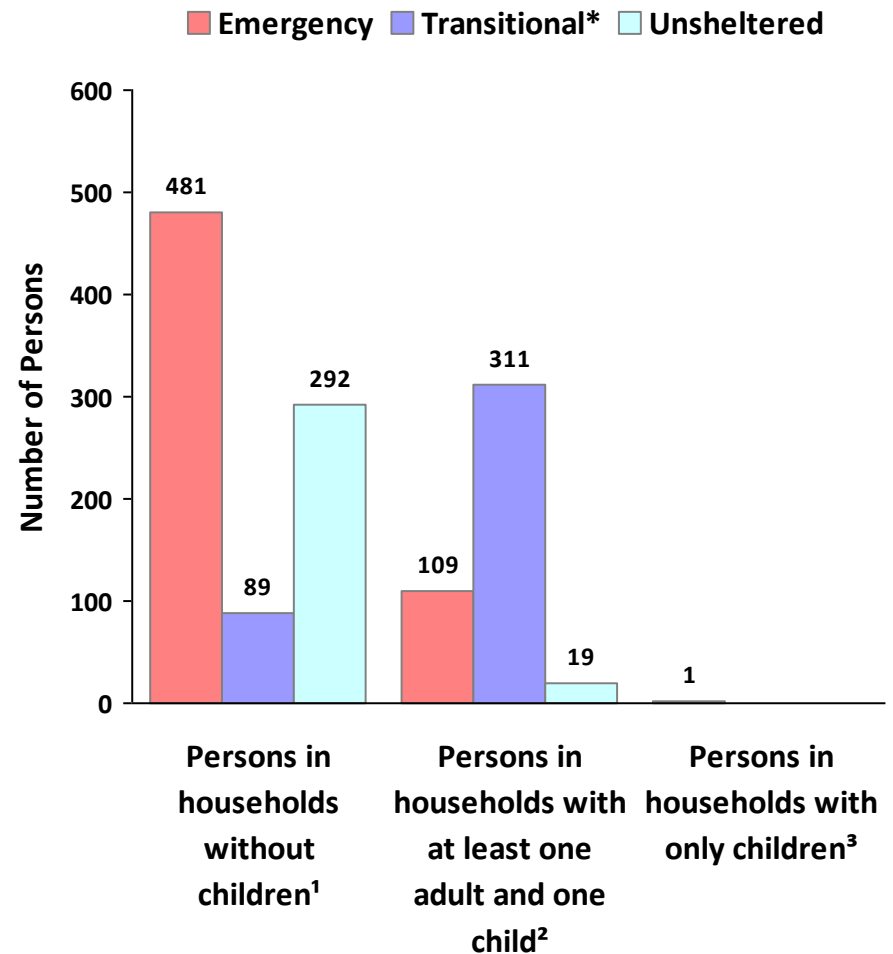
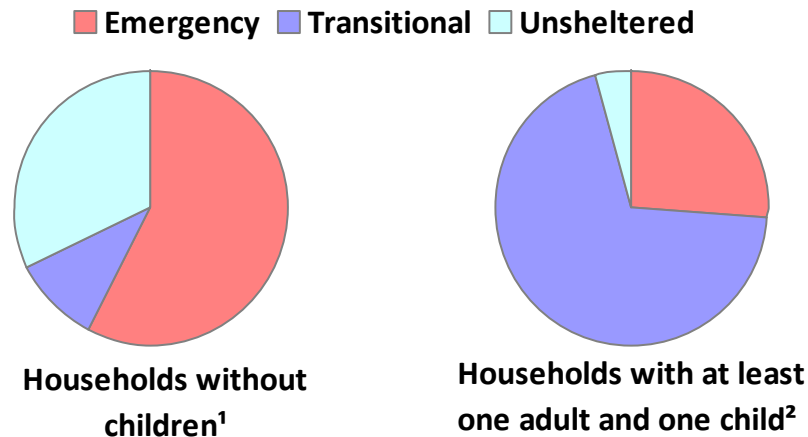

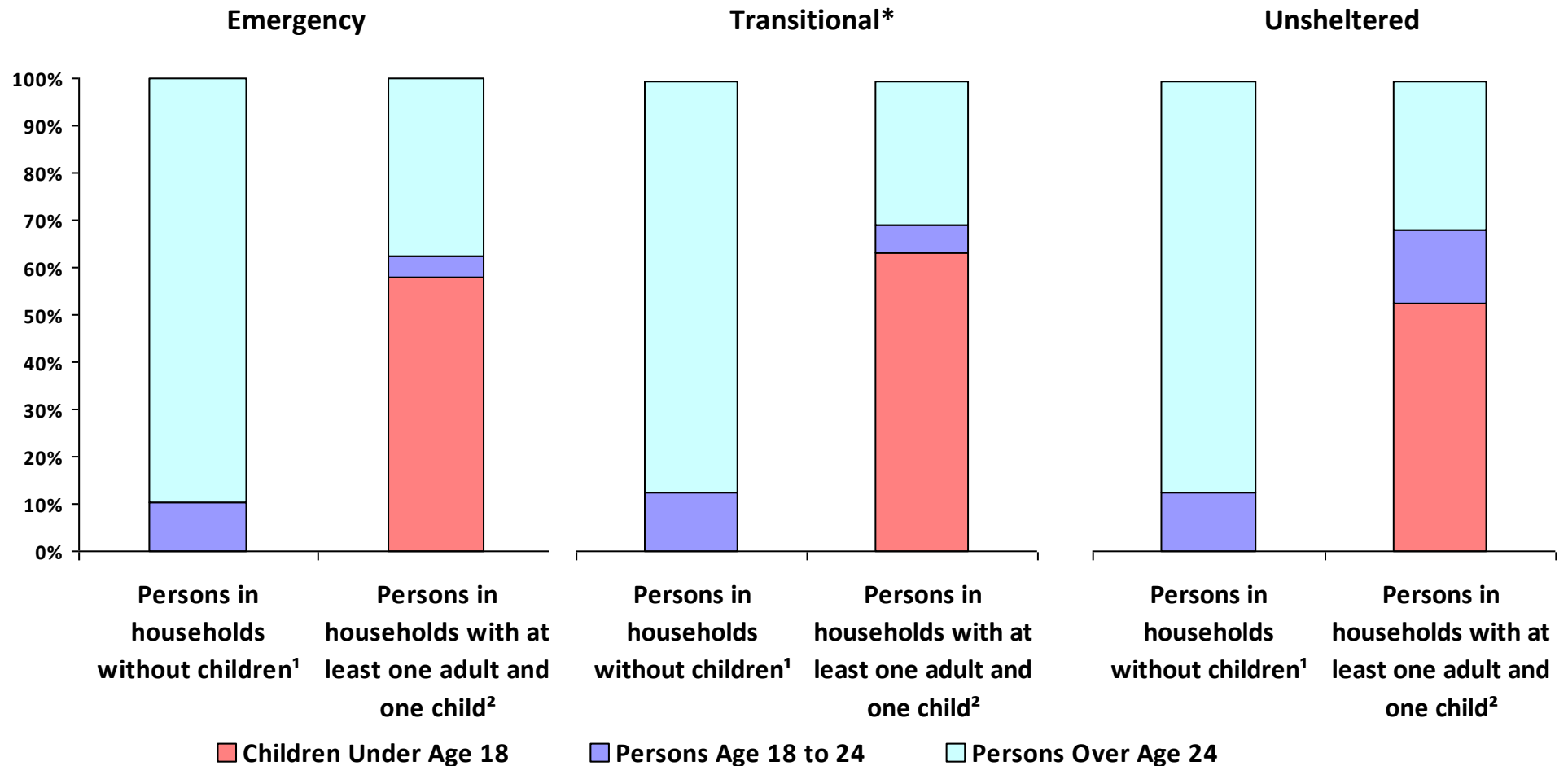


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### 2016 Point-In-Time Count Proportion of Persons in each Age Group by Household Type
