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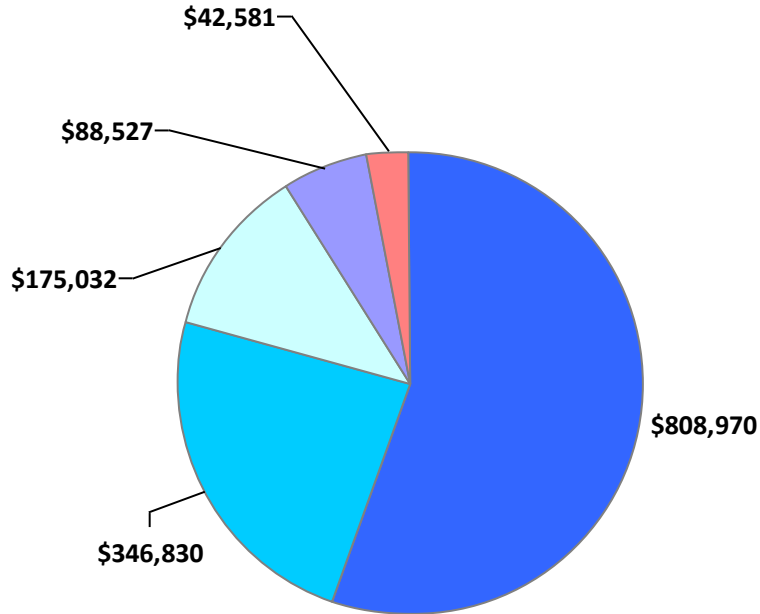

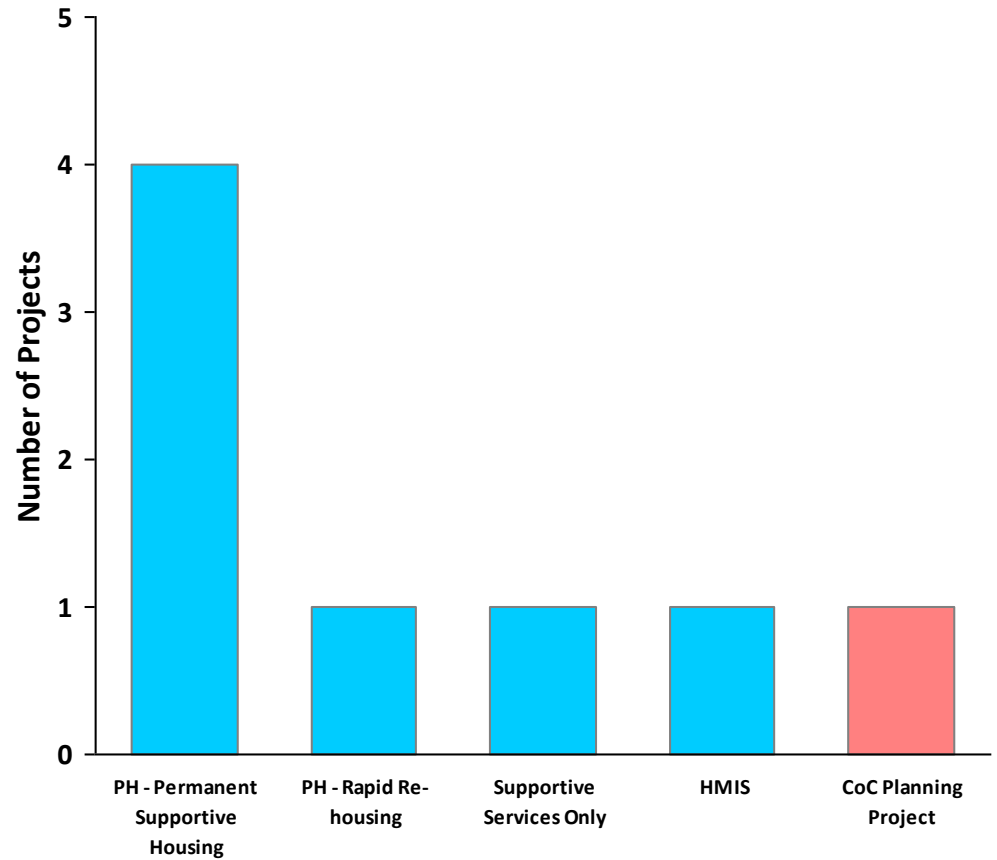

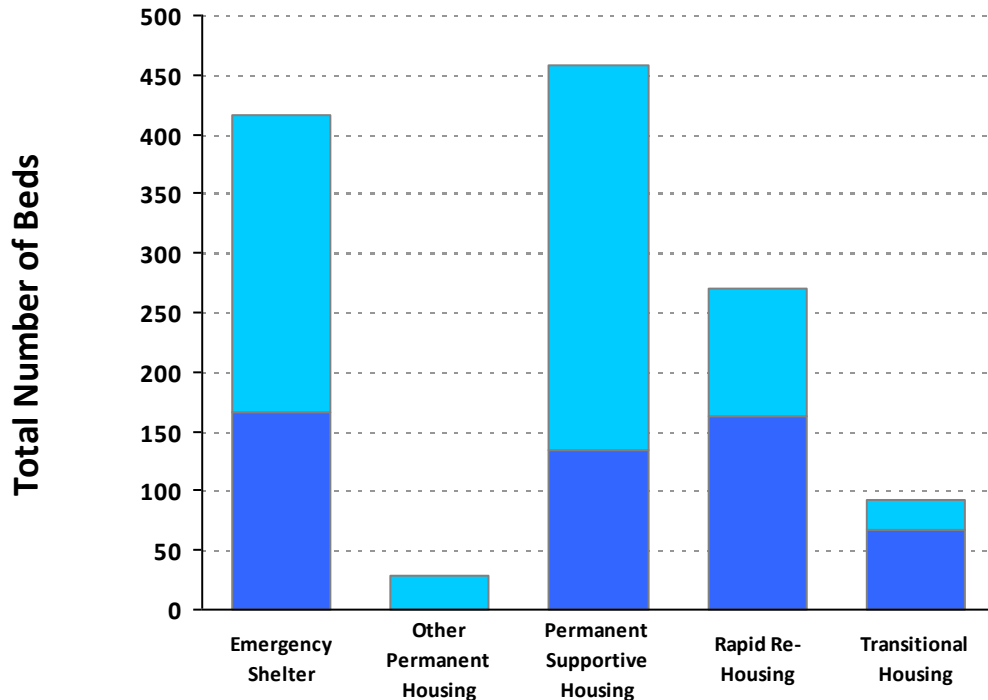
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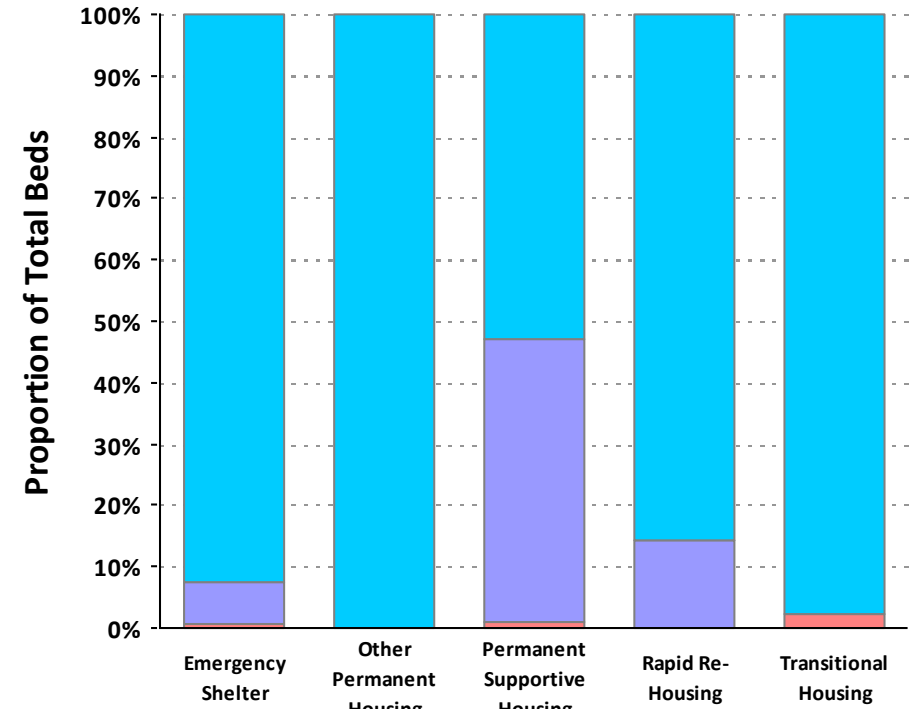

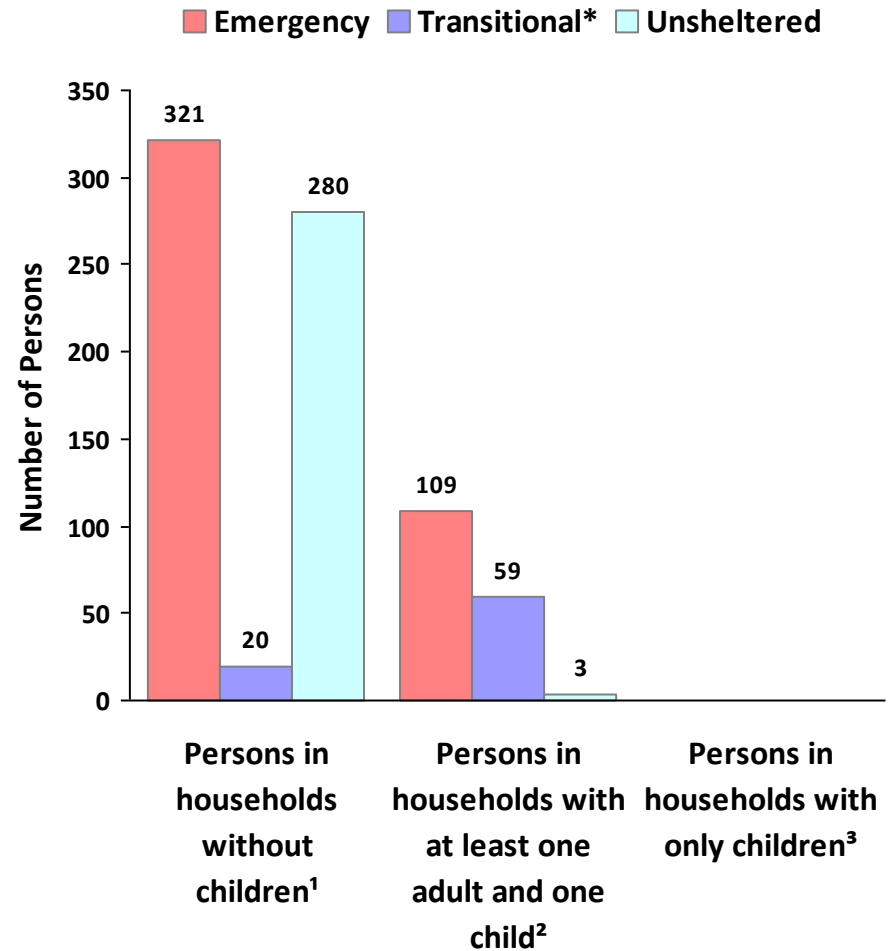
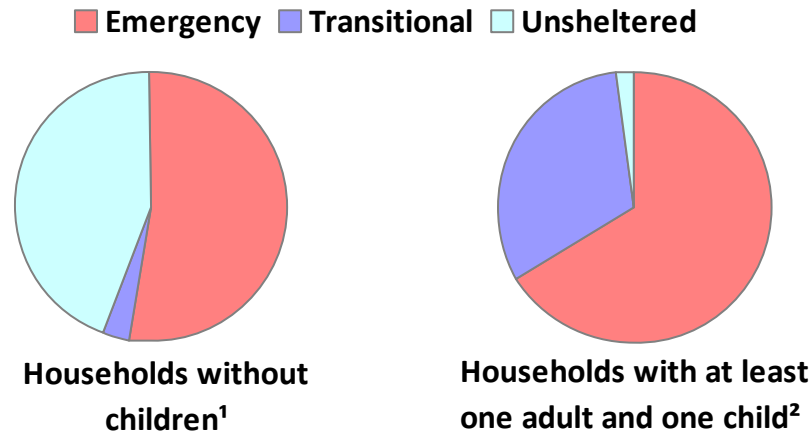
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2022 Point in Time Count Summarized by Household Type

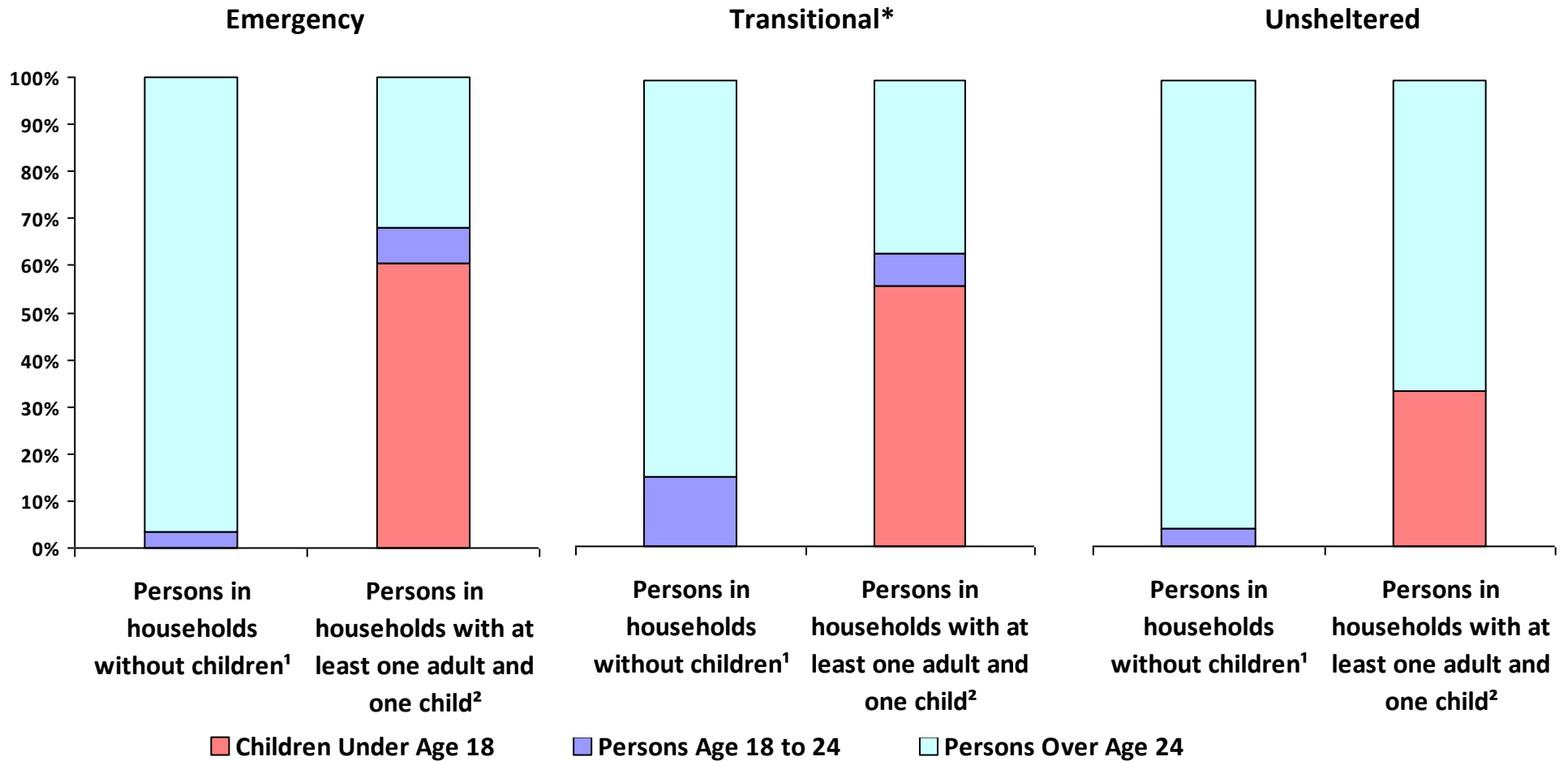


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2022 Point-In-Time Count Proportion of Persons in each Age Group by Household Type



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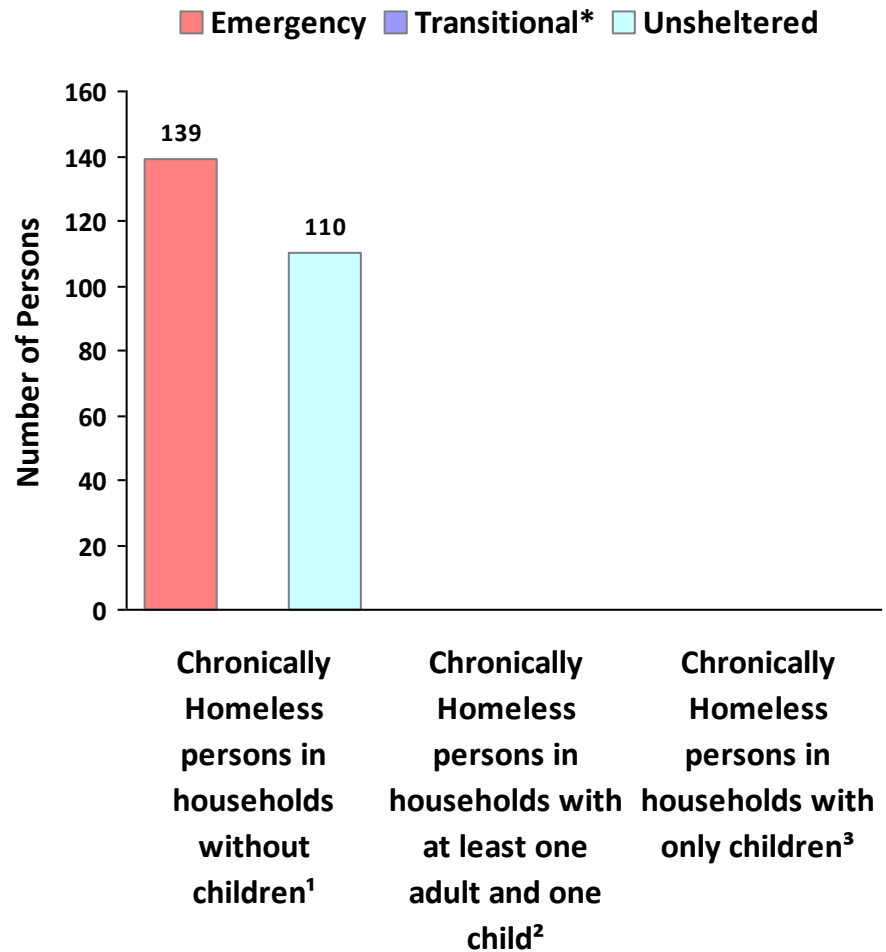
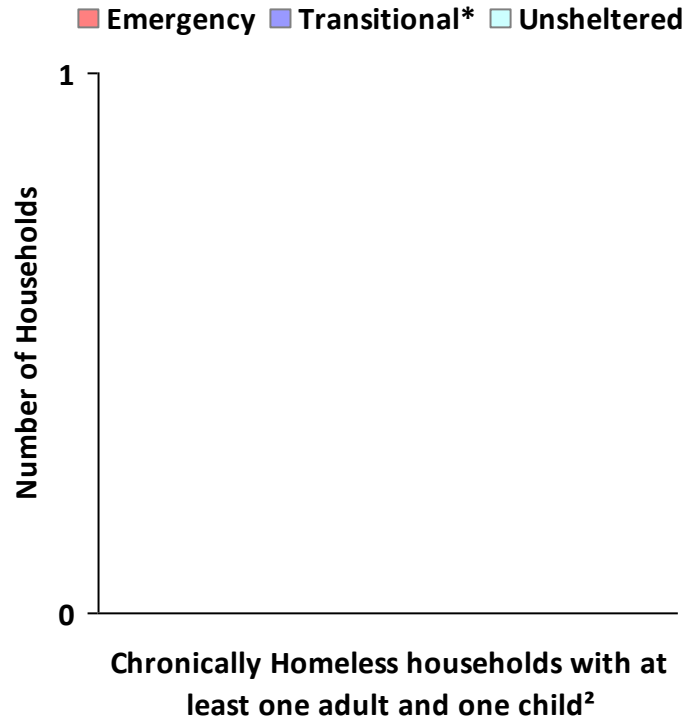


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2022 Point in Time Count Summarized by Chronically Homeless by Household Type
