

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


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




³This category includes persons under age 18, including children in one-child households, adolescent parents and their children, adolescent siblings, or other household configurations composed only of children.




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2019 Point-In-Time Count Proportion of Persons in each Age Group by Household Type



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



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2019 Point in Time Count Summarized by Chronically Homeless by Household Type
