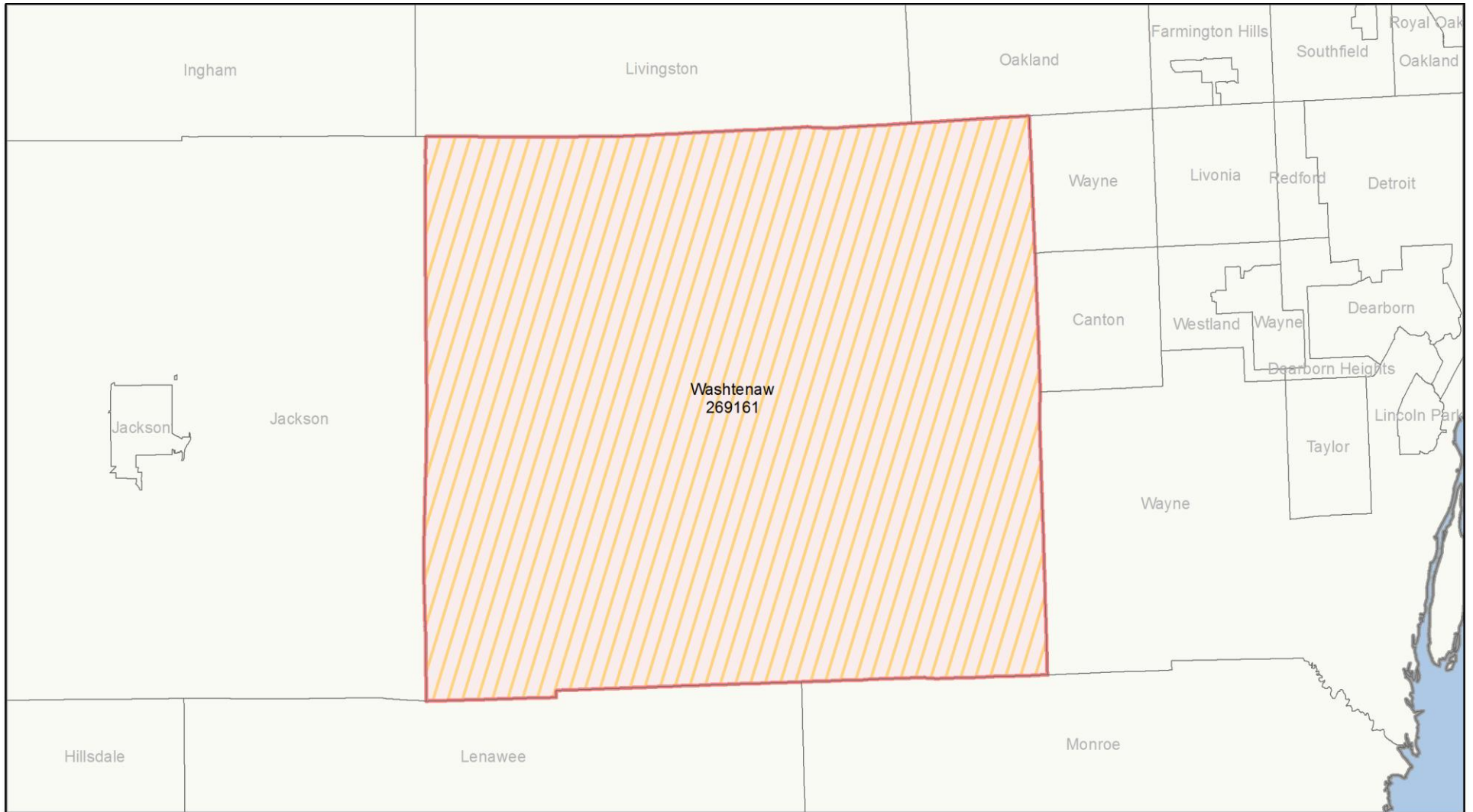

 2013 CoC Boundary  2012 CoC Boundary



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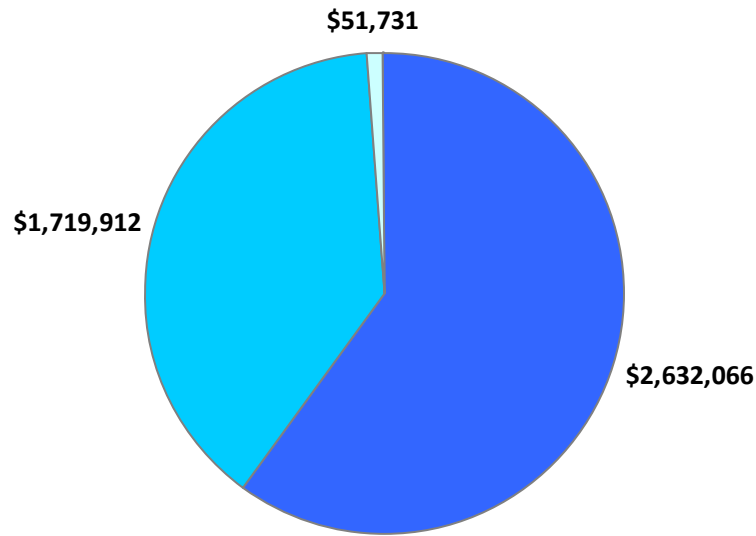
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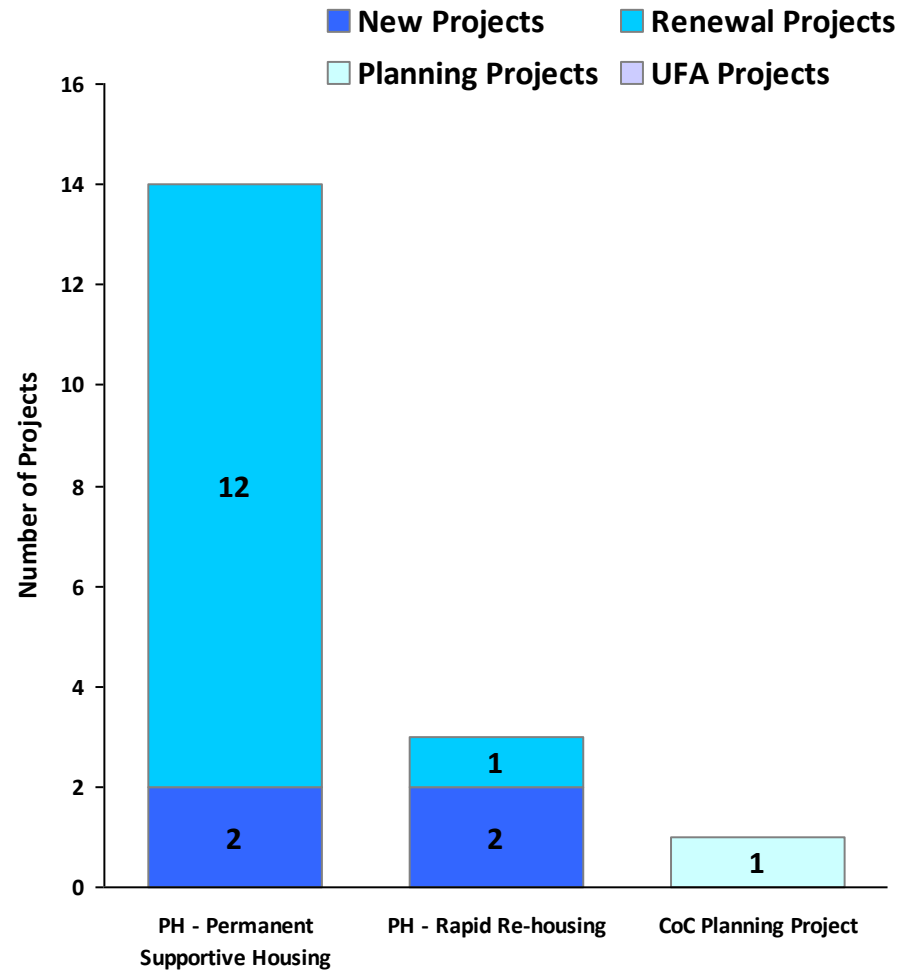

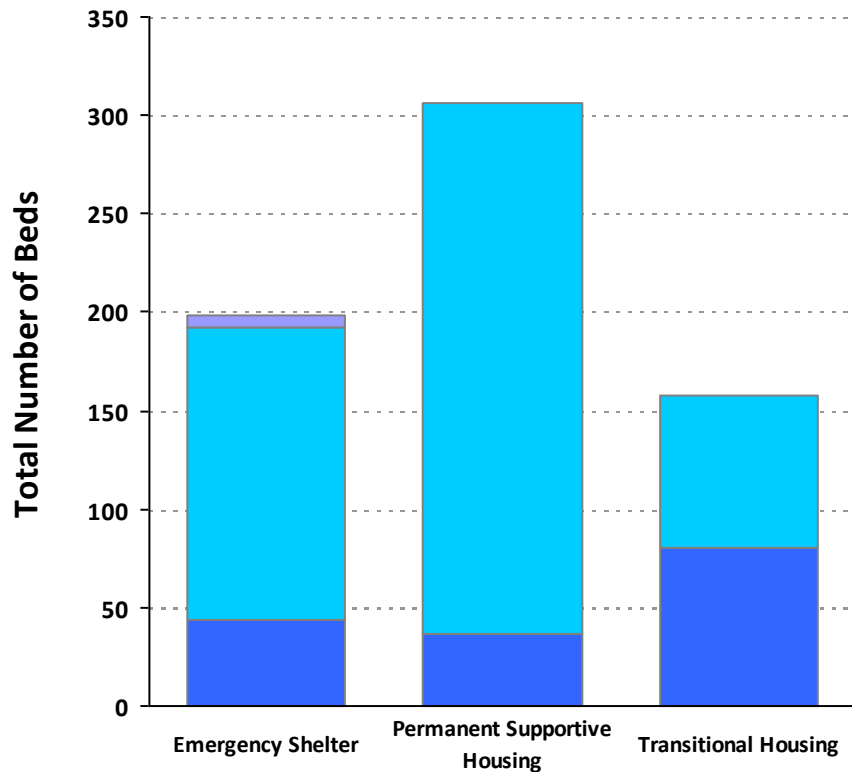

Beds by Designated Target Population

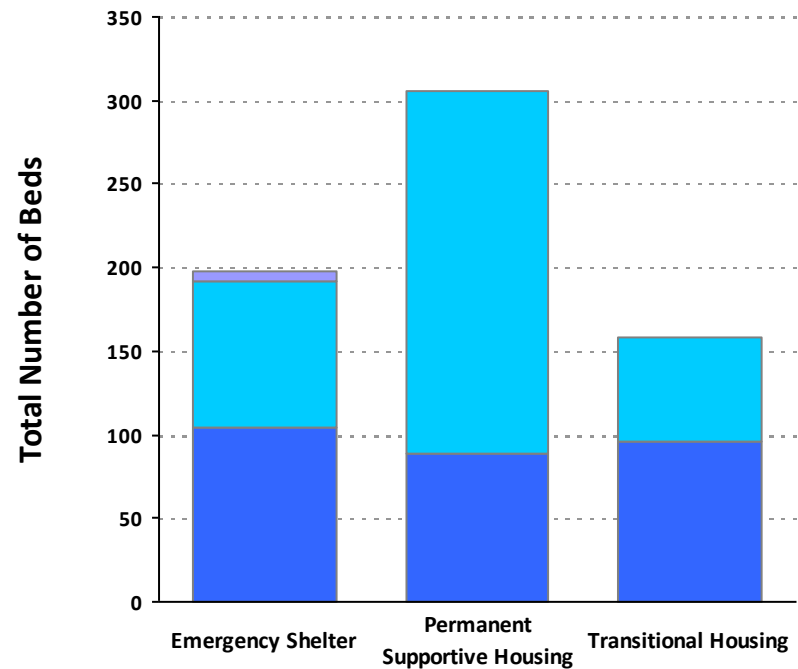

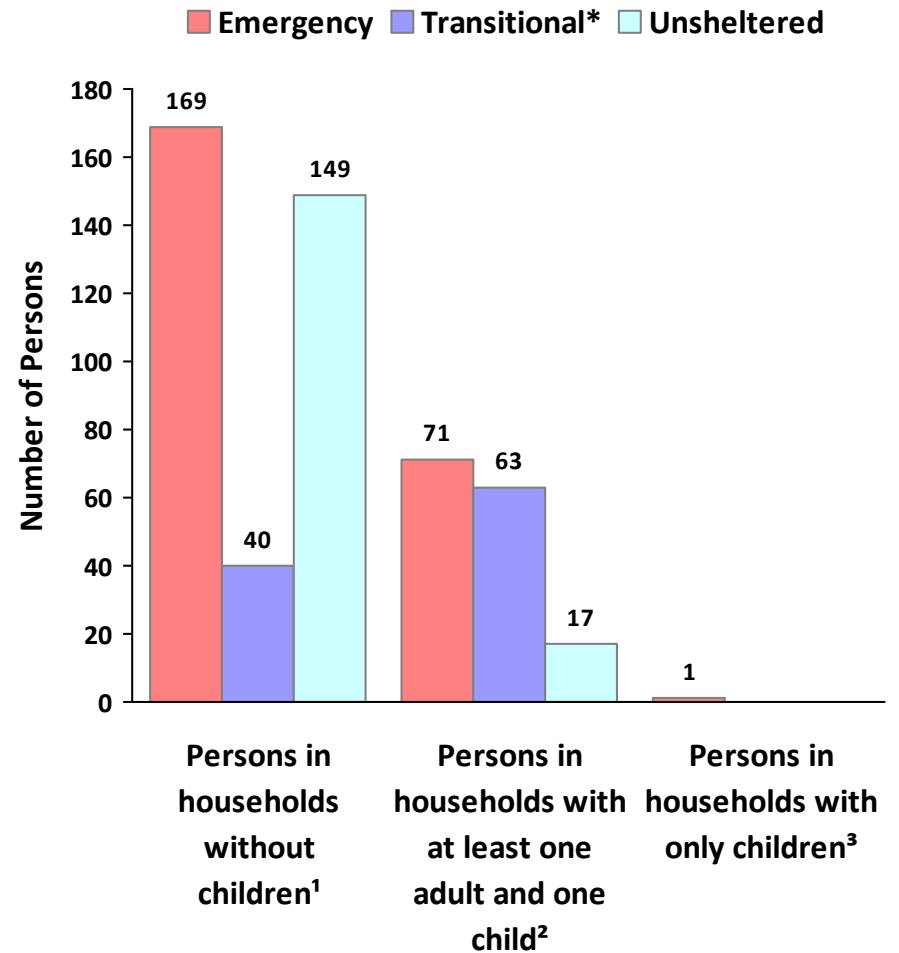
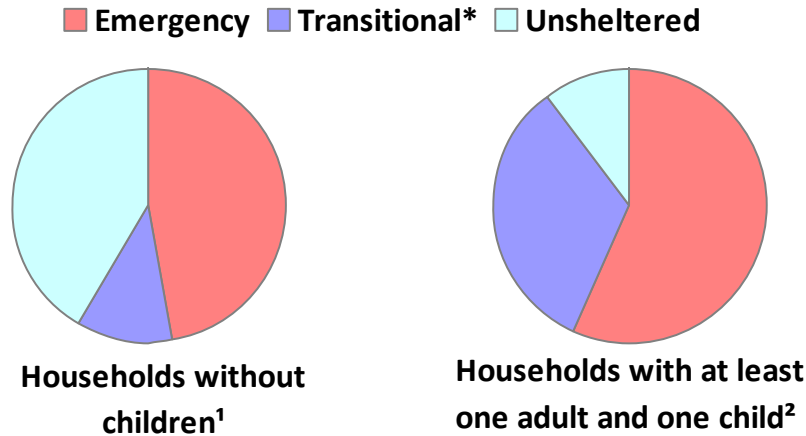

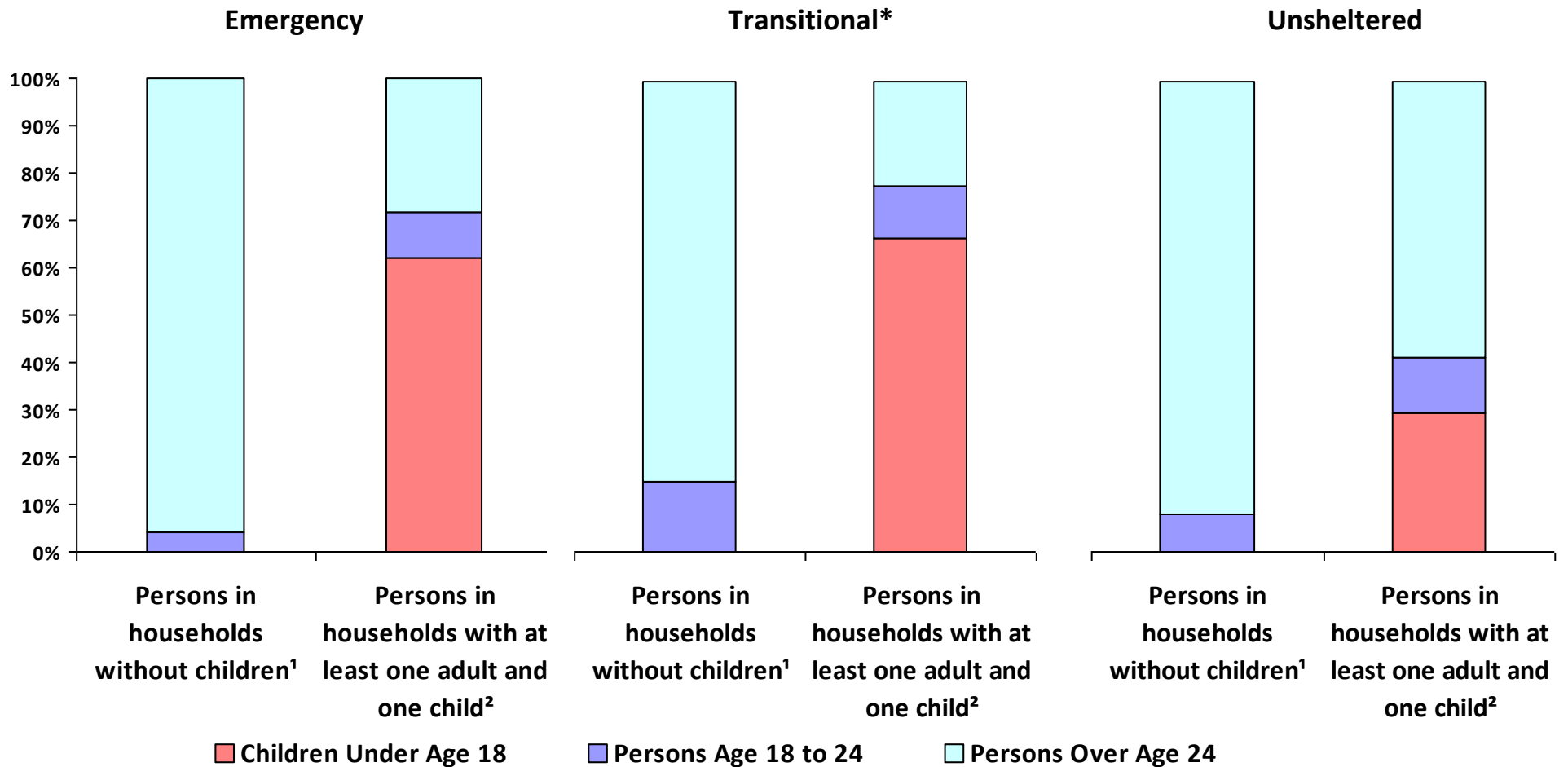


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2013 Point-In-Time Count Proportion of Persons in each Age Group by Household Type
