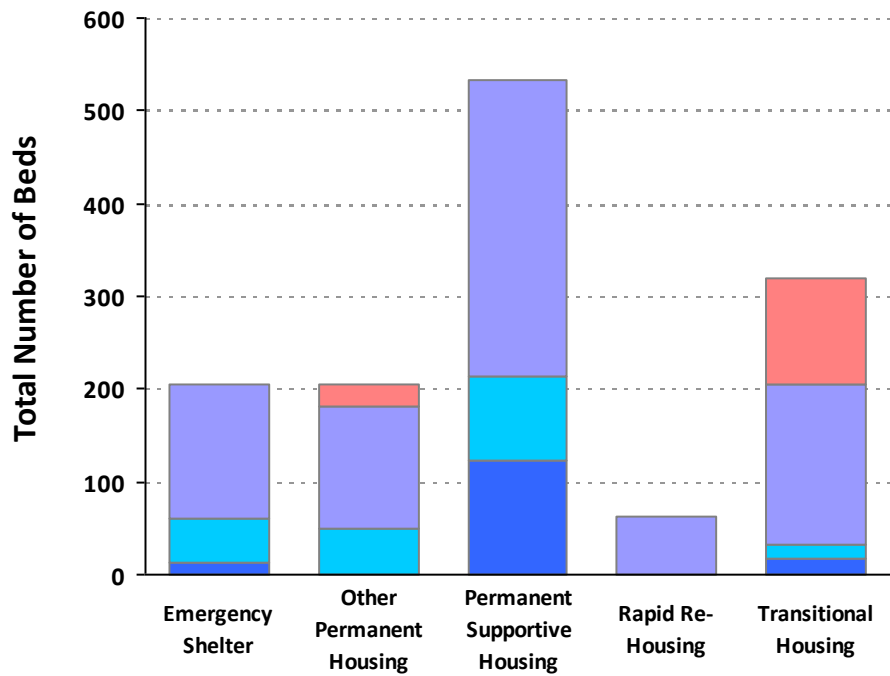
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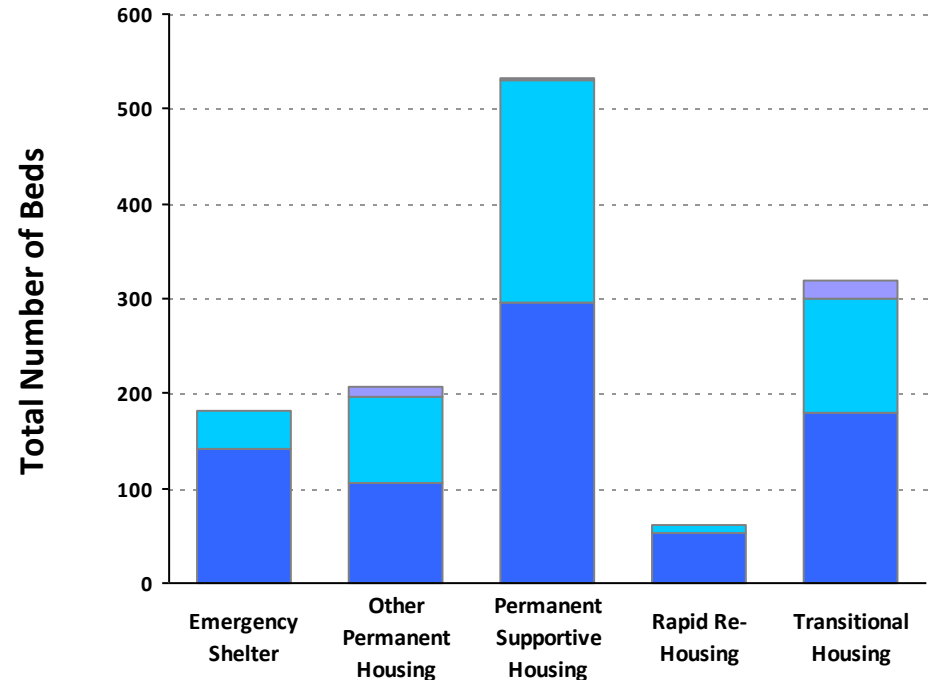

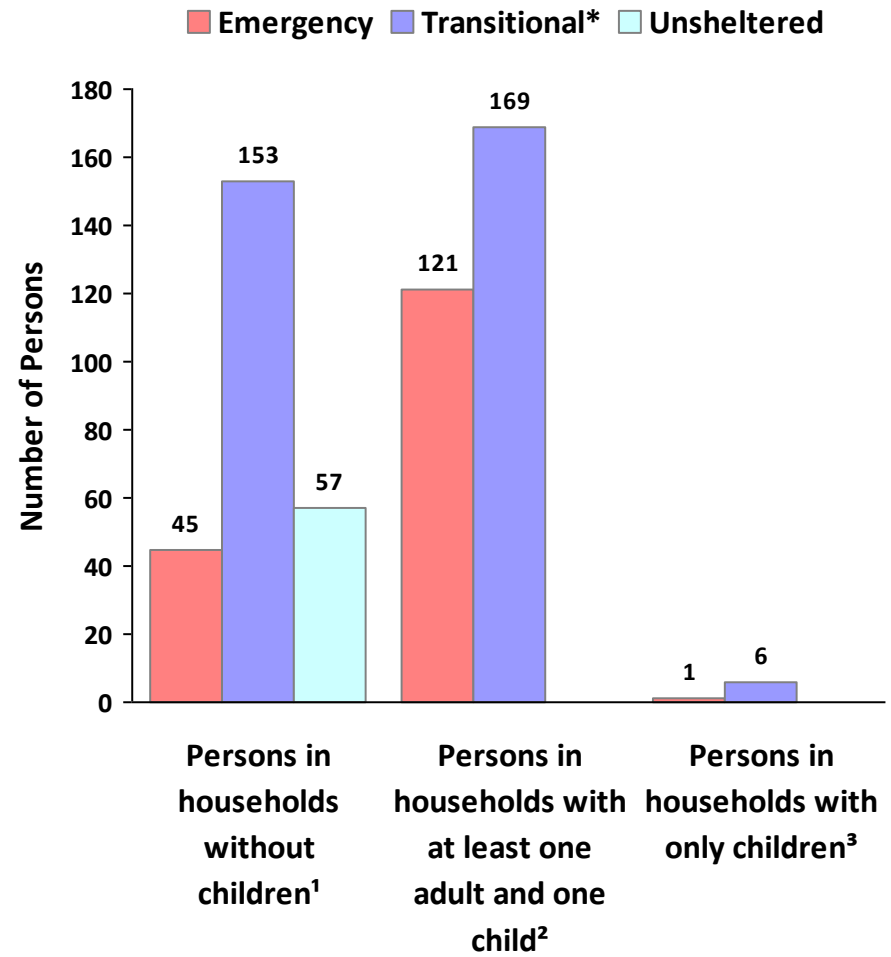
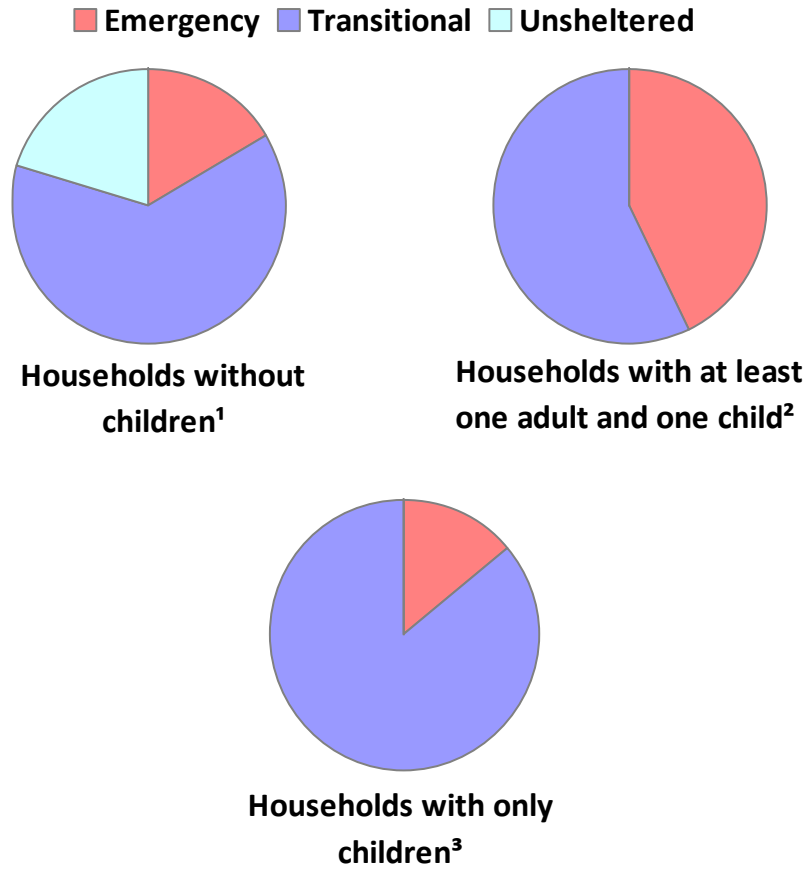

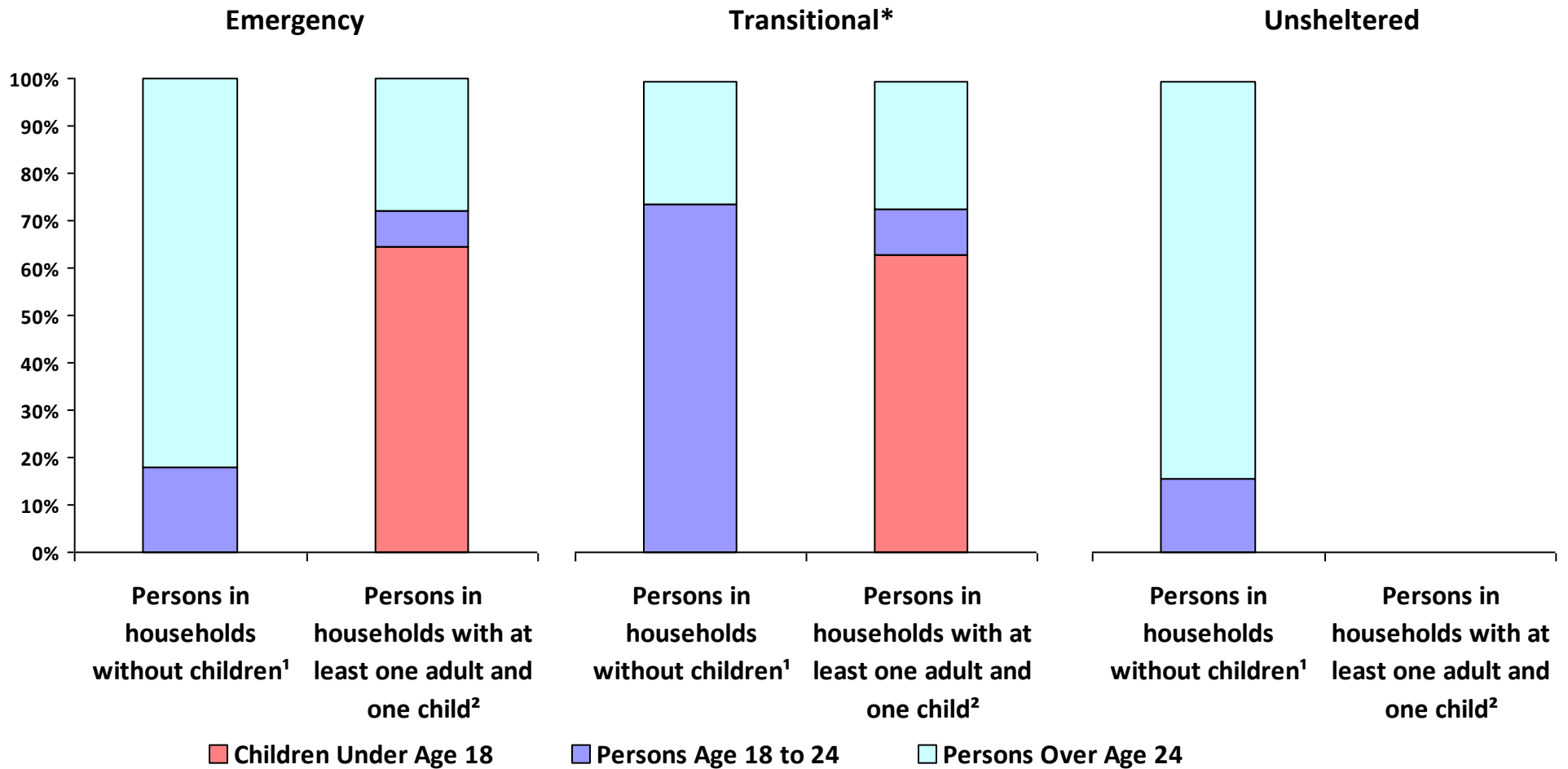

**2017 Point-In-Time Count Proportion of Persons in each Age Group by Household Type**



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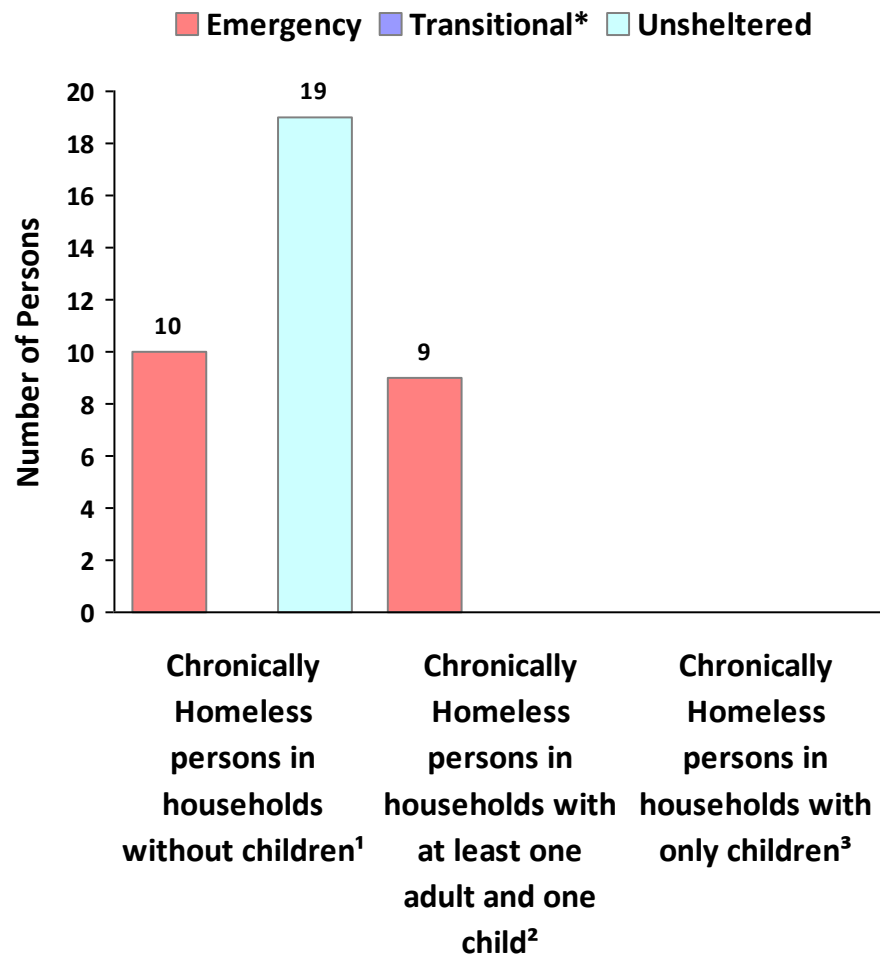
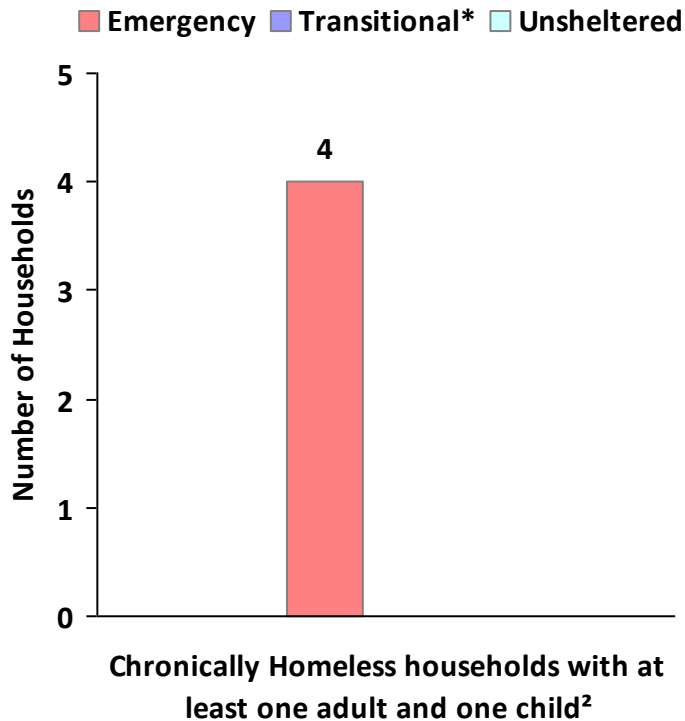
