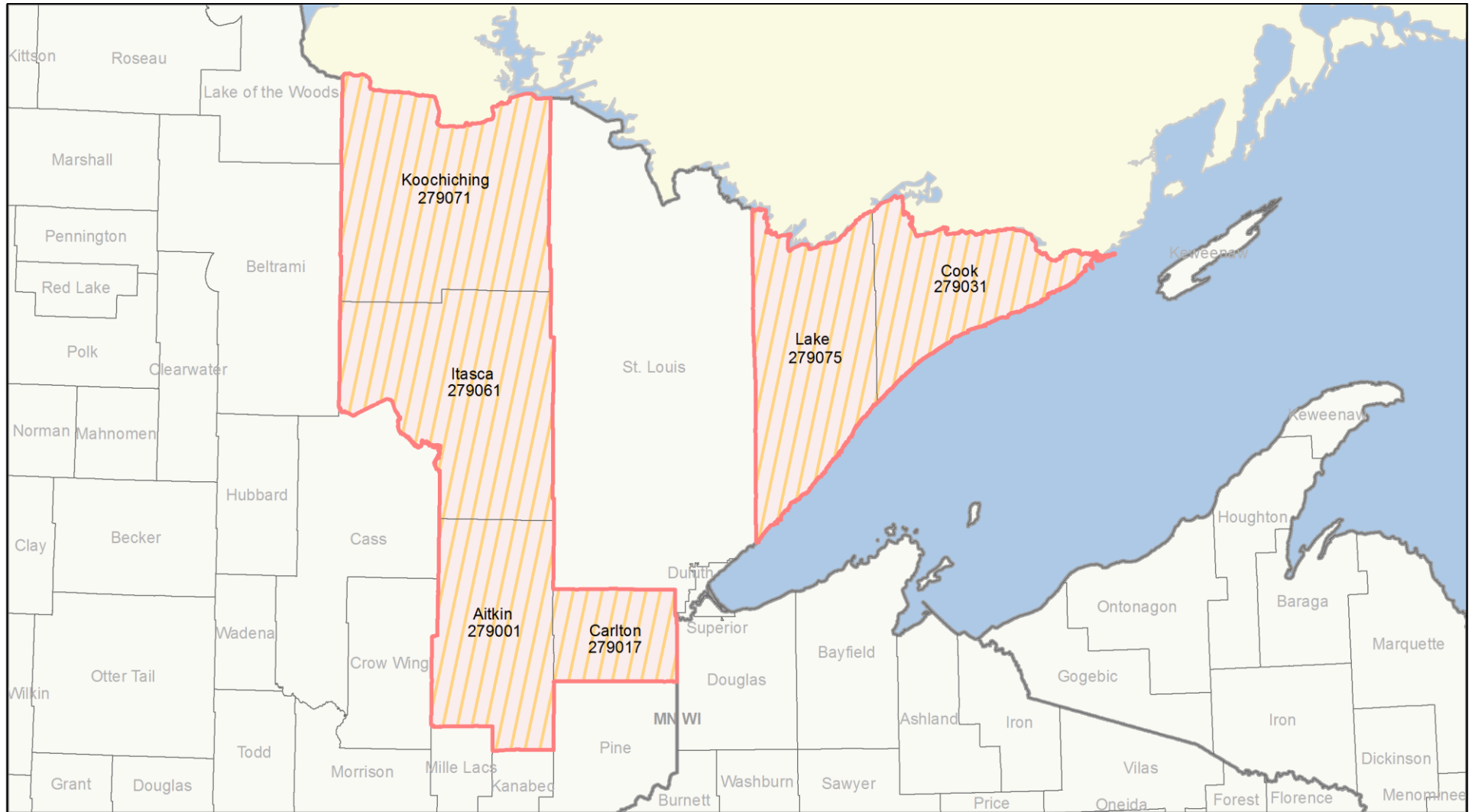

 2017 CoC Boundary  2016 CoC Boundary



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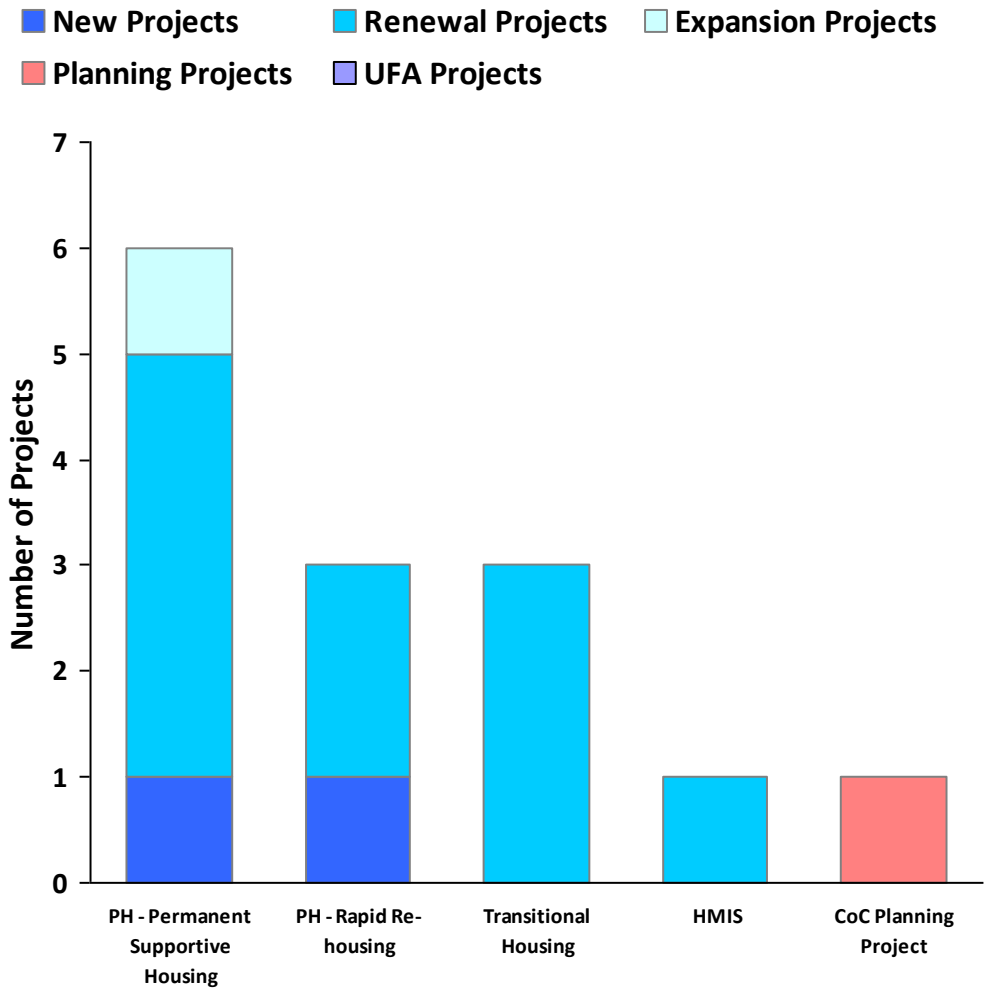
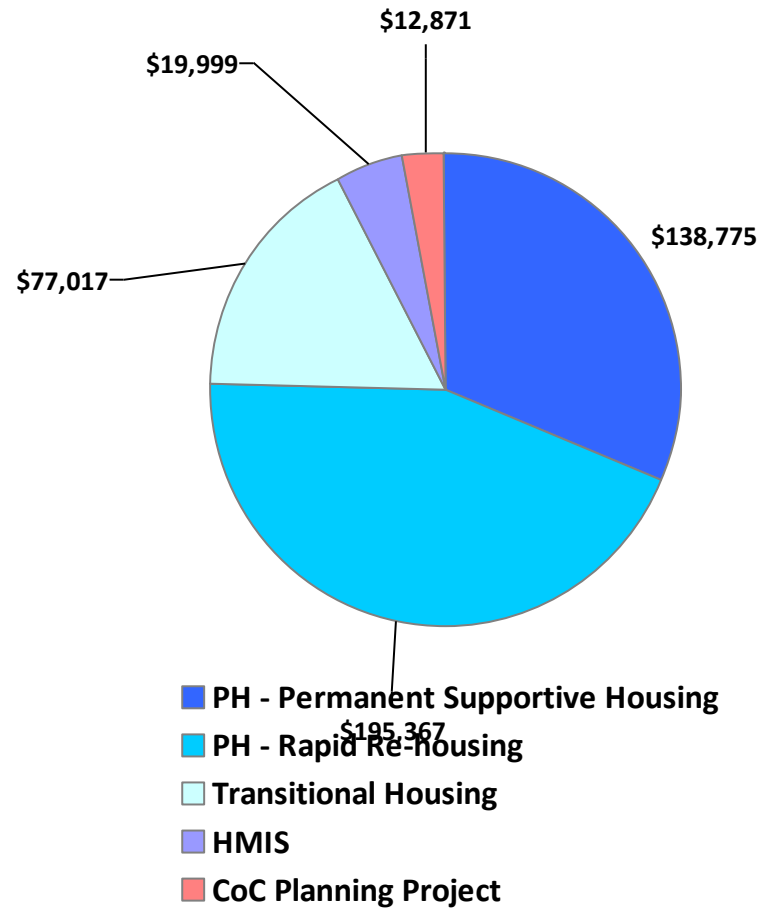

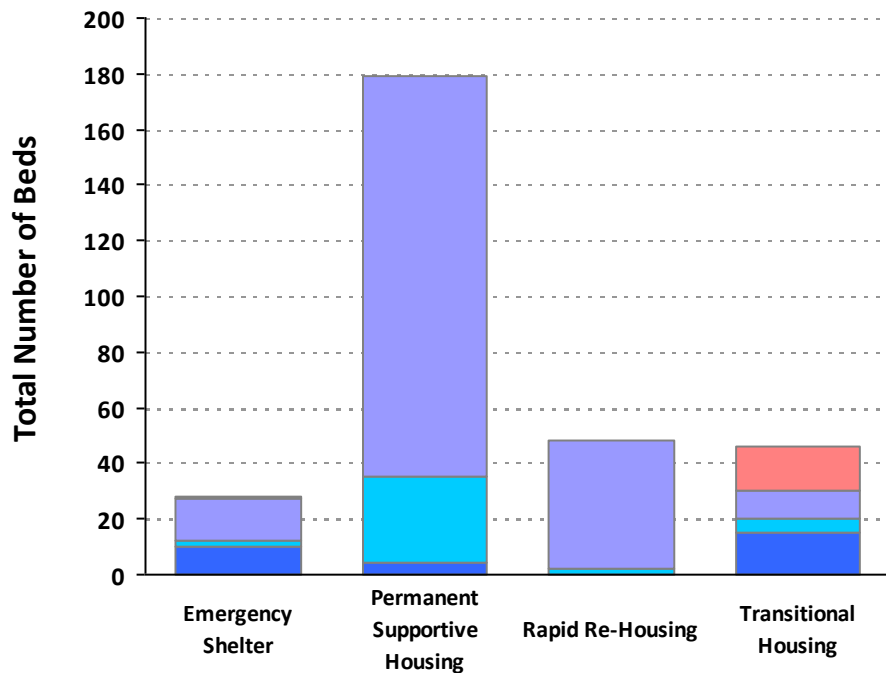

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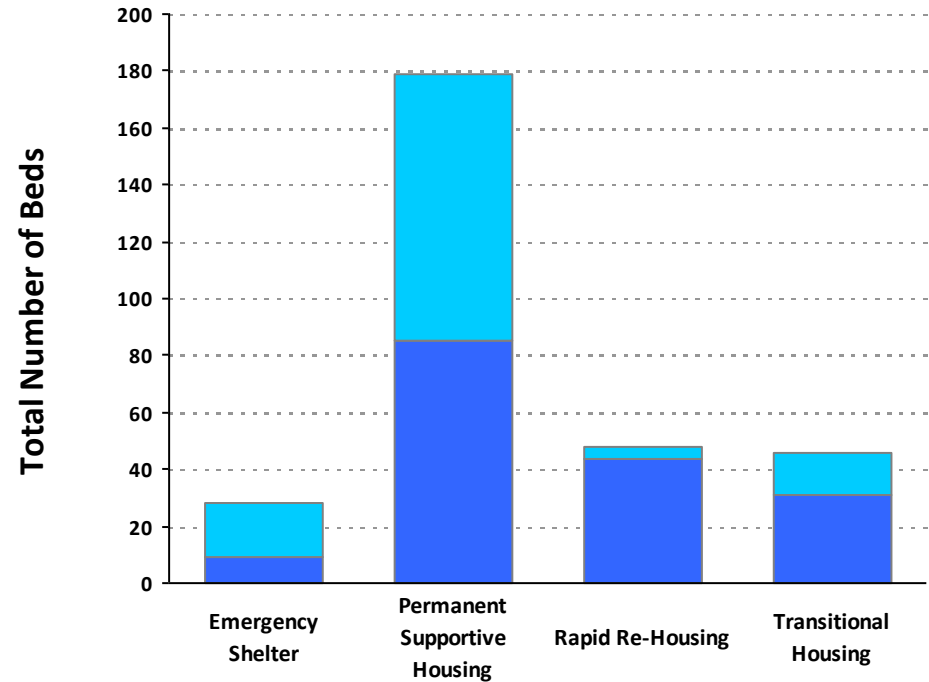
2017 Housing Inventory Summarized by Target Population and Bed Type

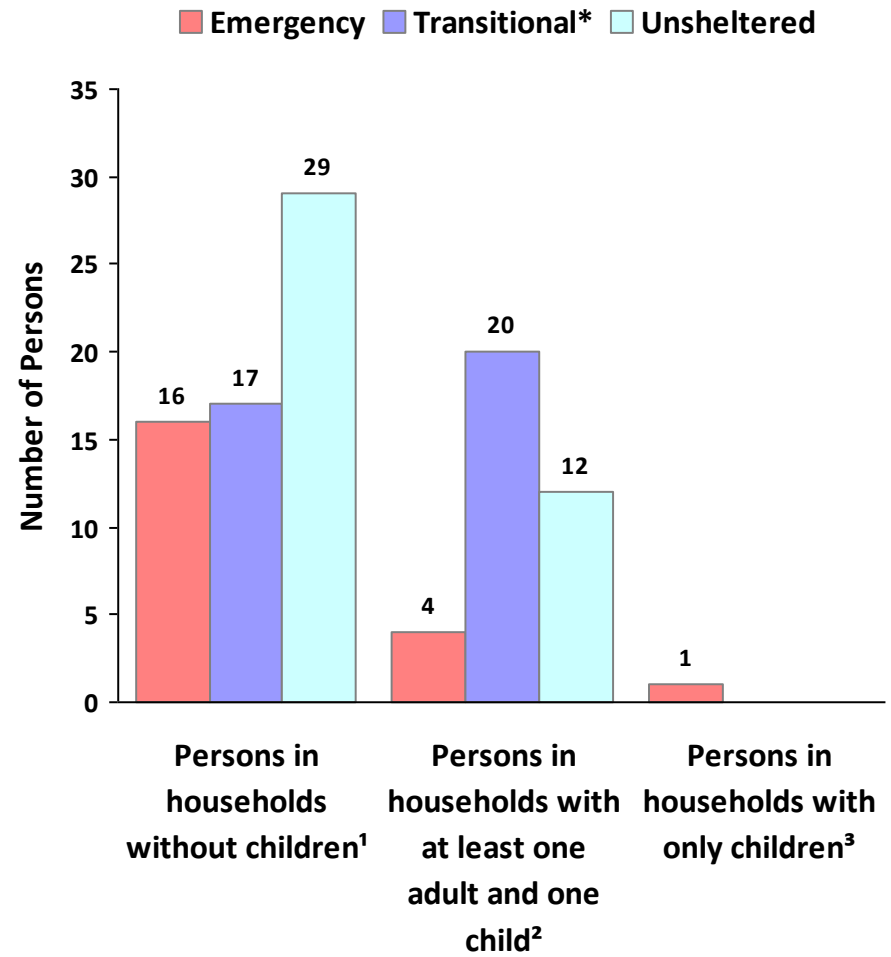
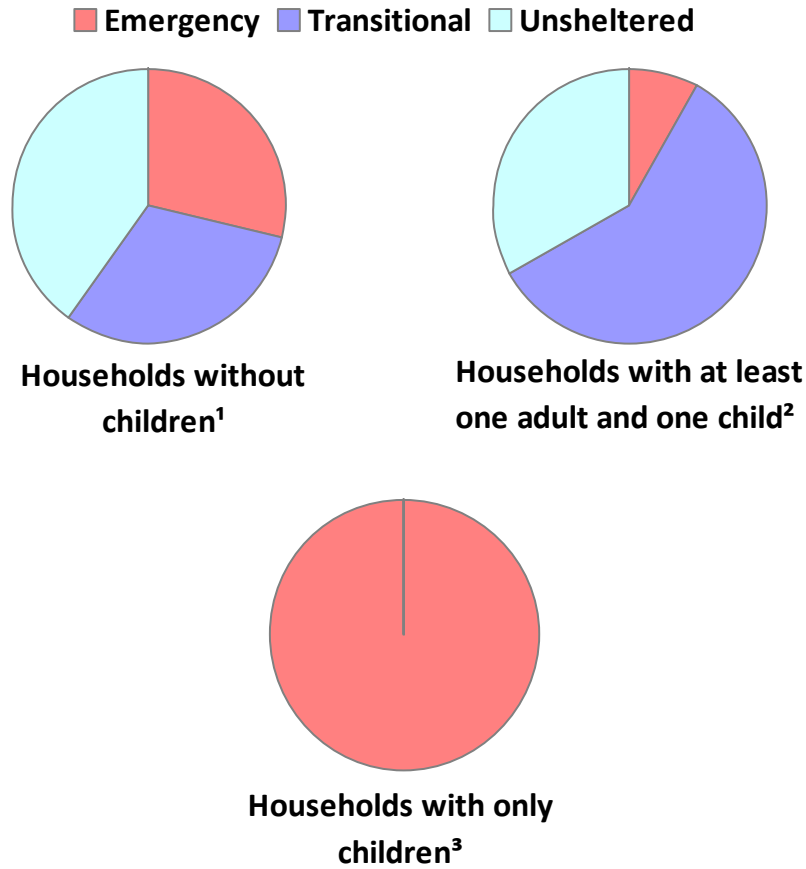

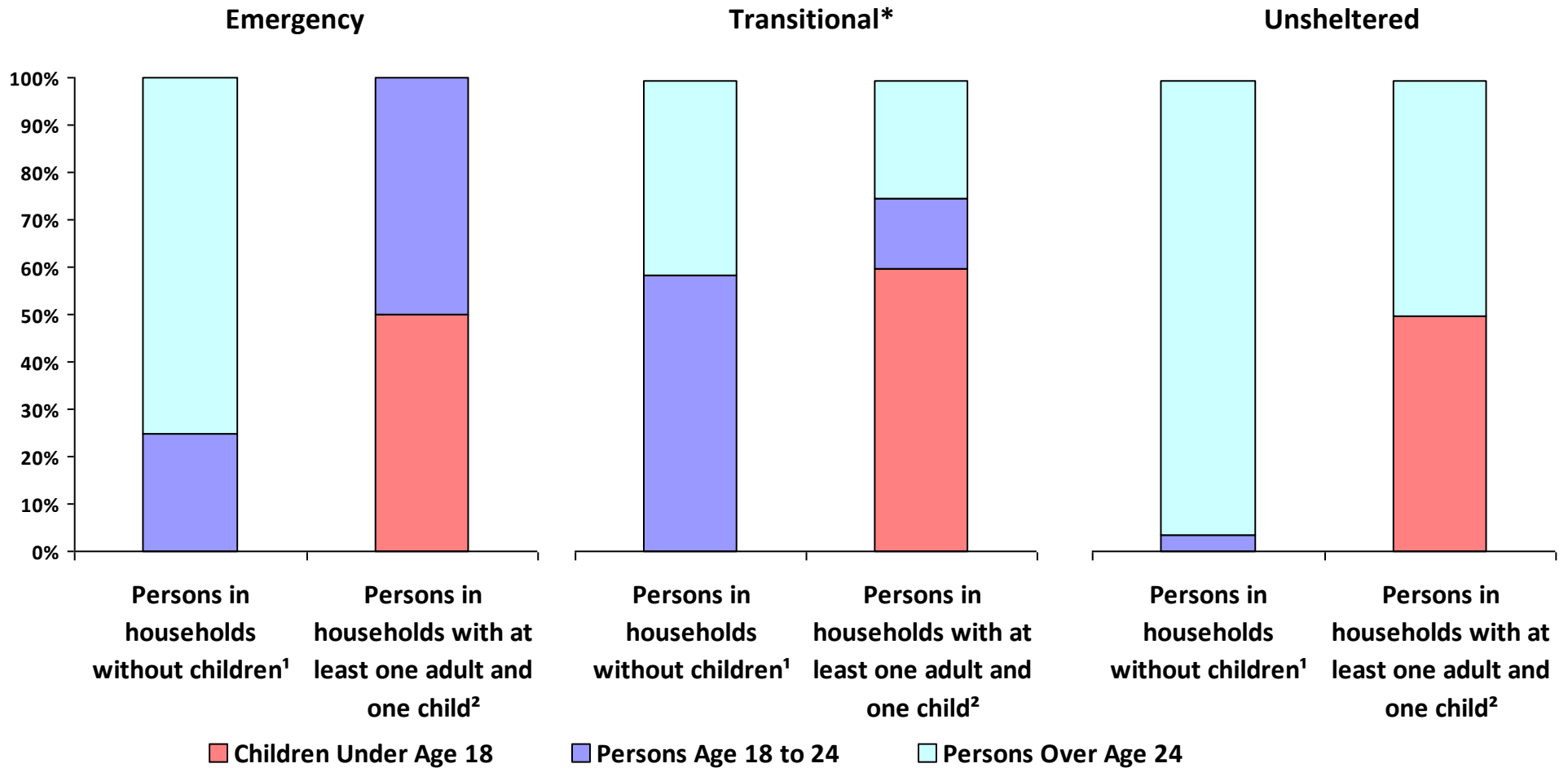

2017 Point-In-Time Count Proportion of Persons in each Age Group by Household Type



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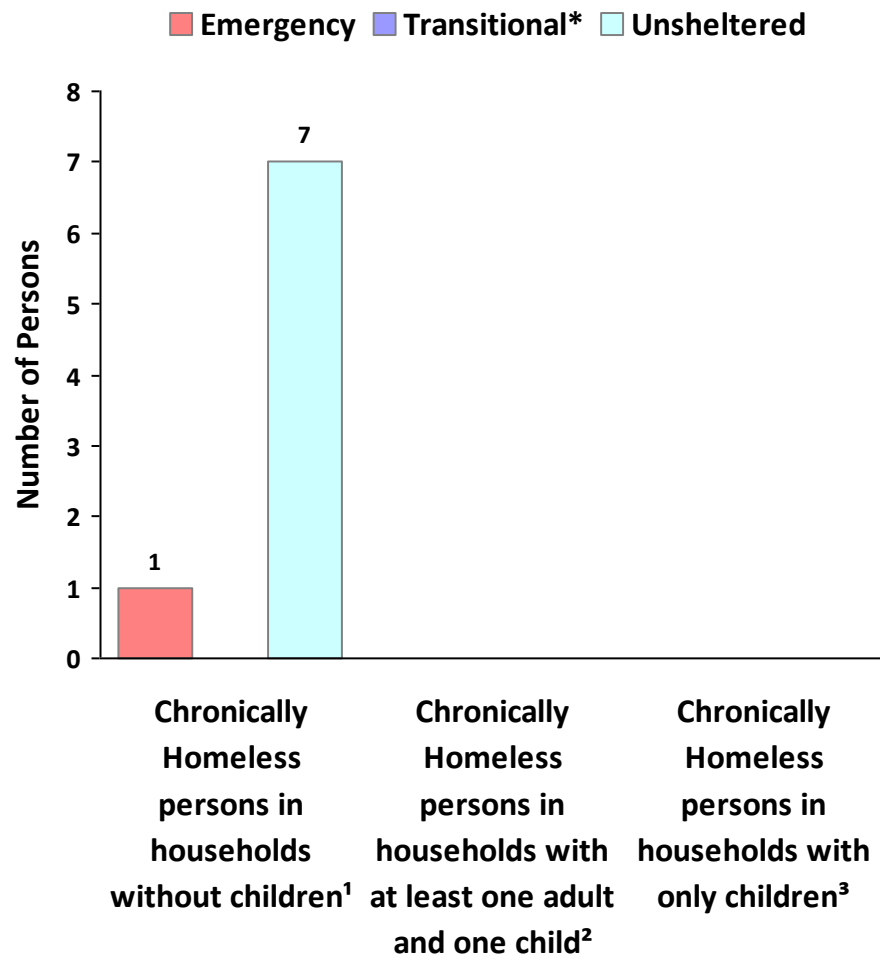
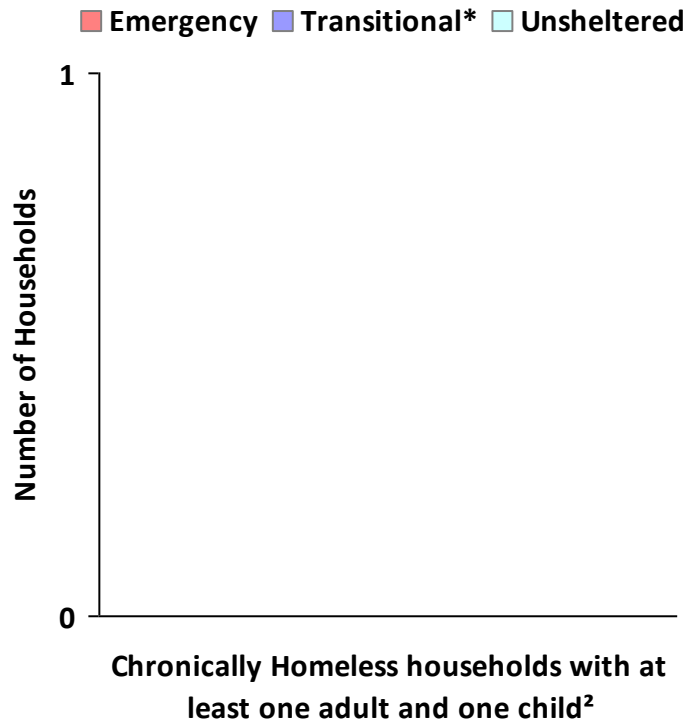
