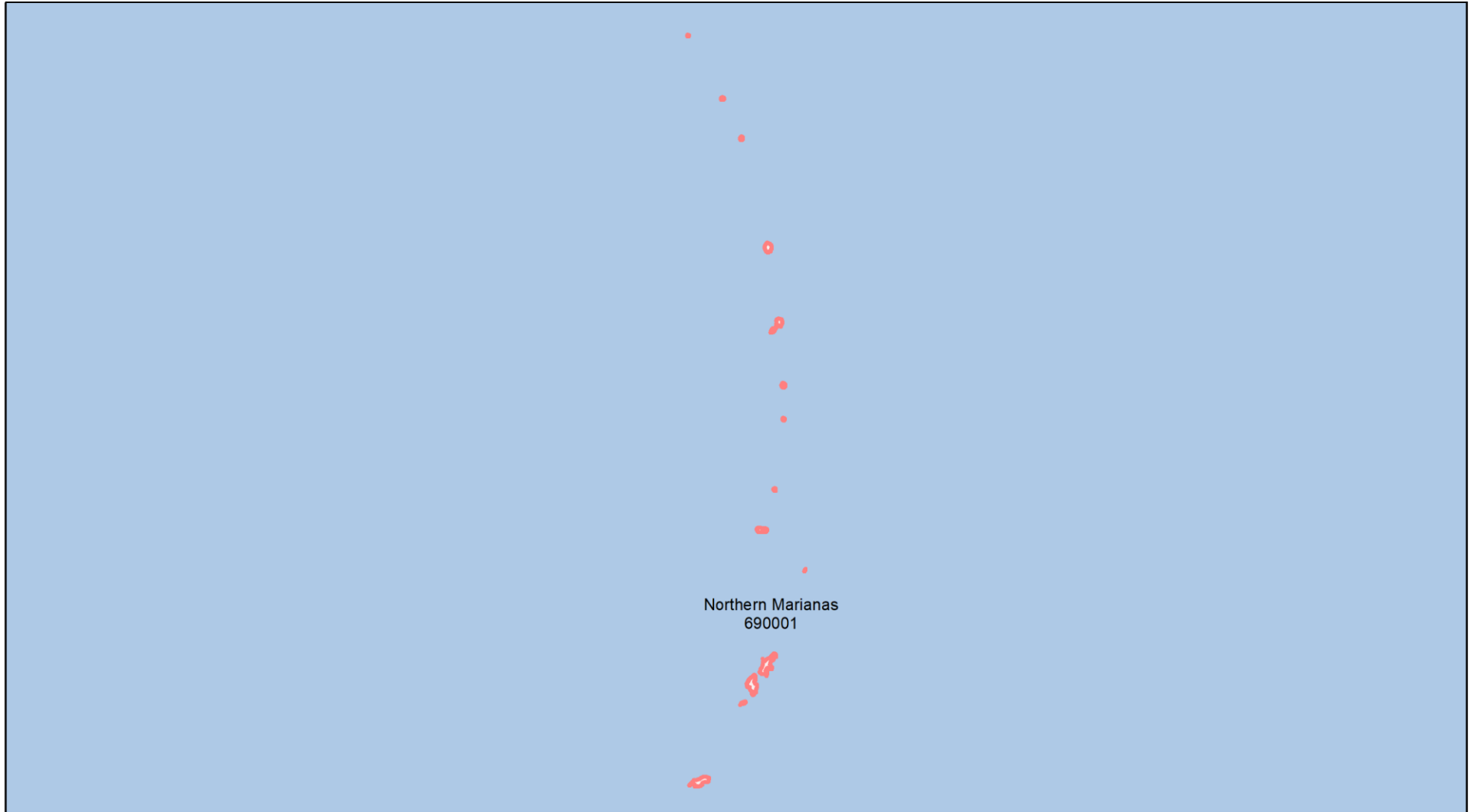

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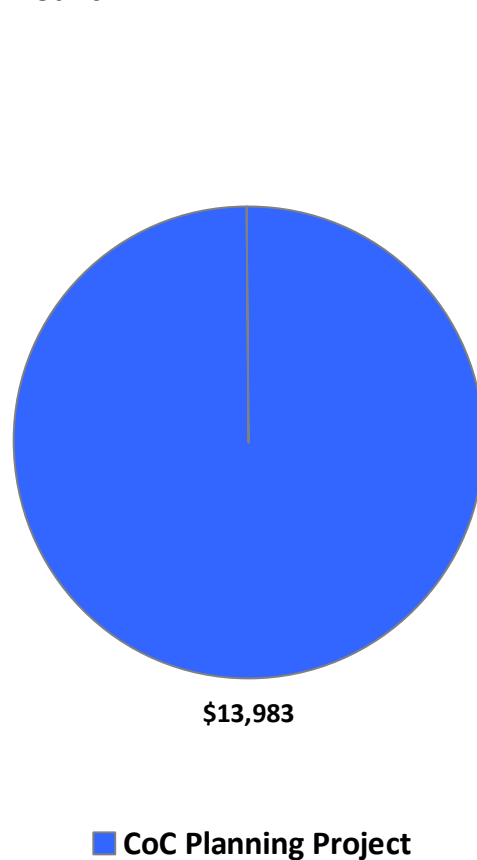

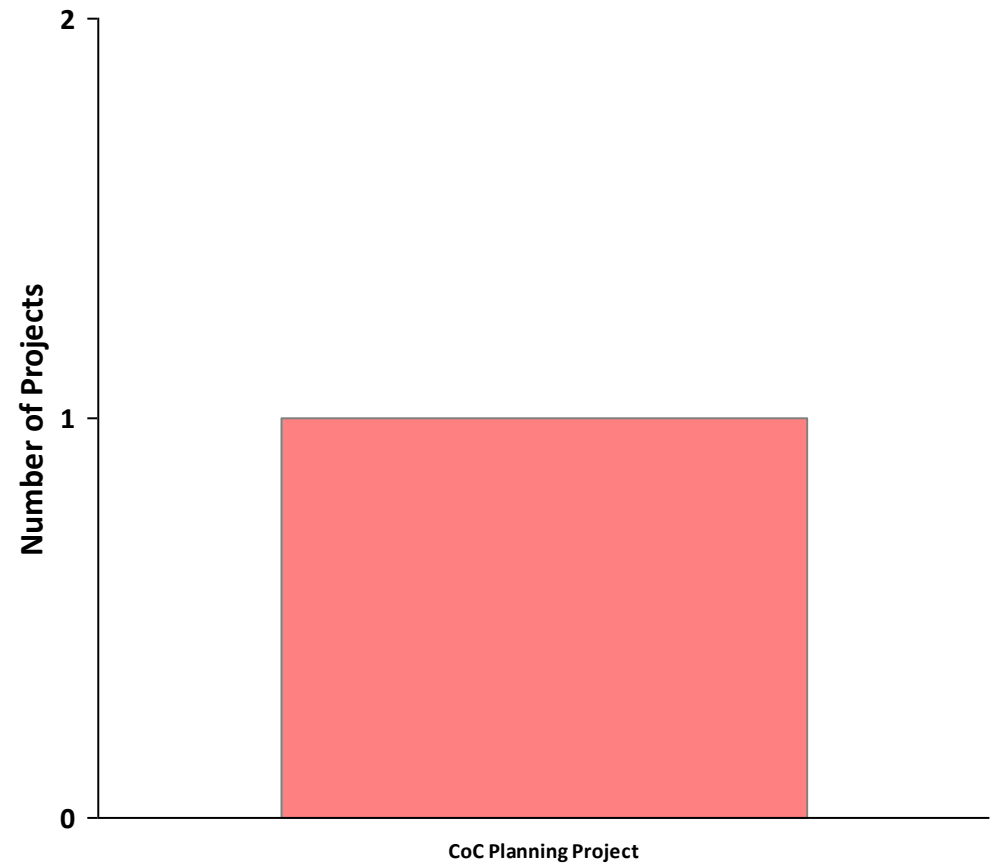

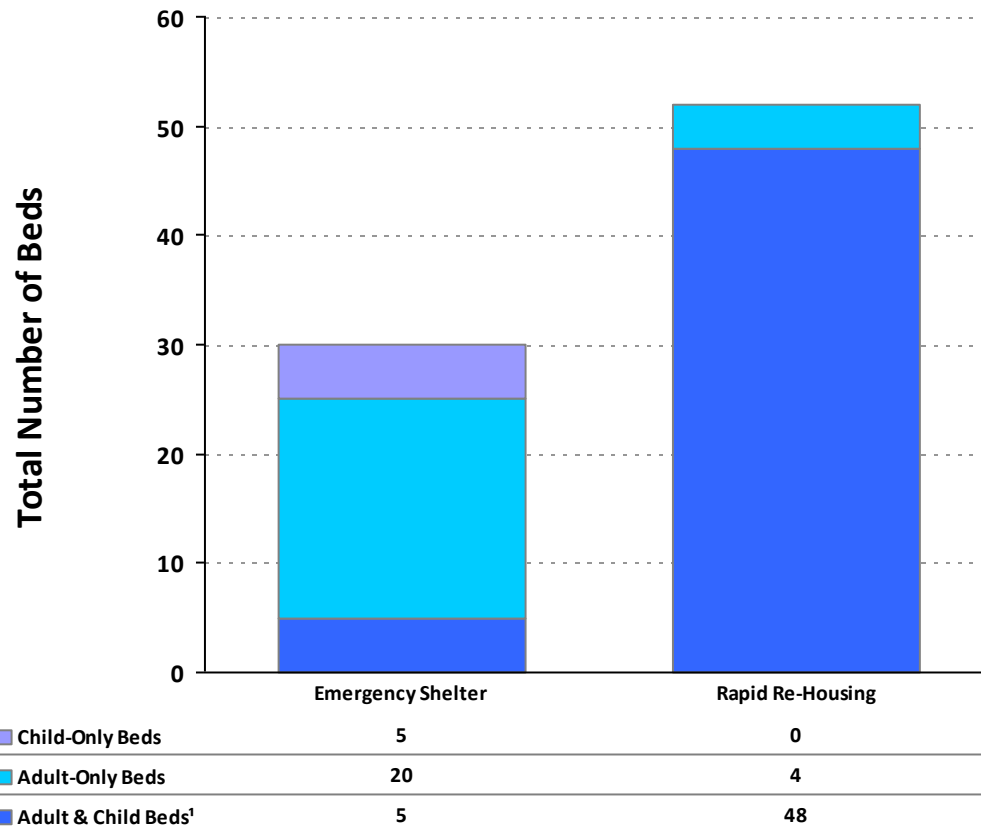

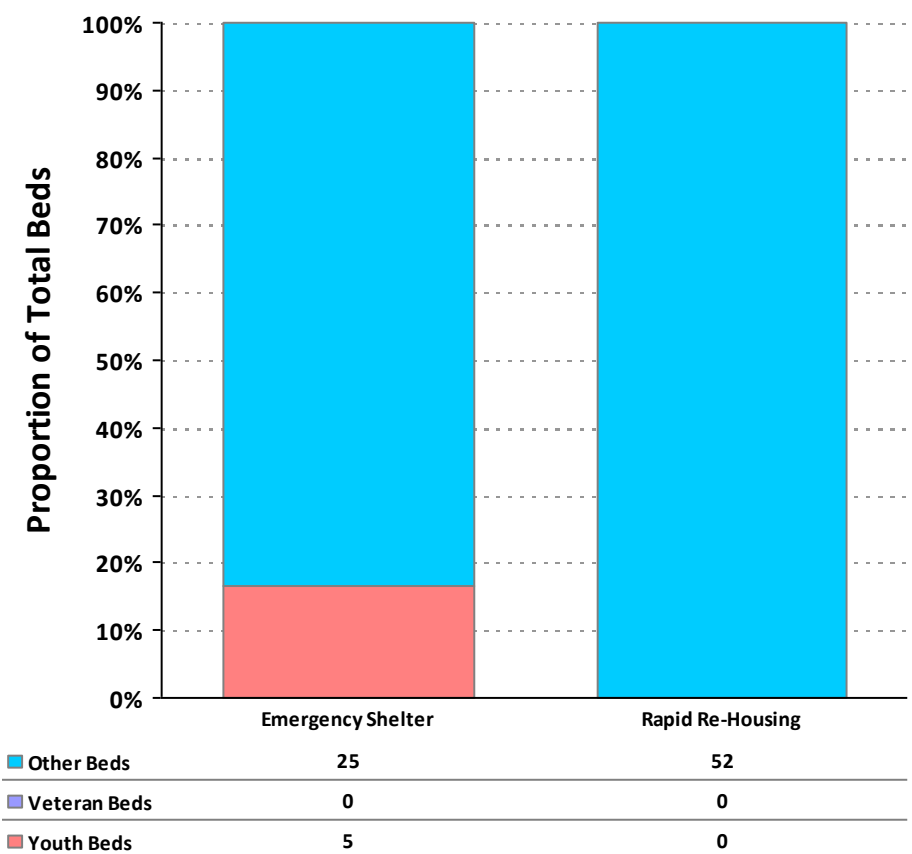

¹Adult & Child Beds refer to beds for households with one adult (age 18 or older) and at least one child (under the age of 18).



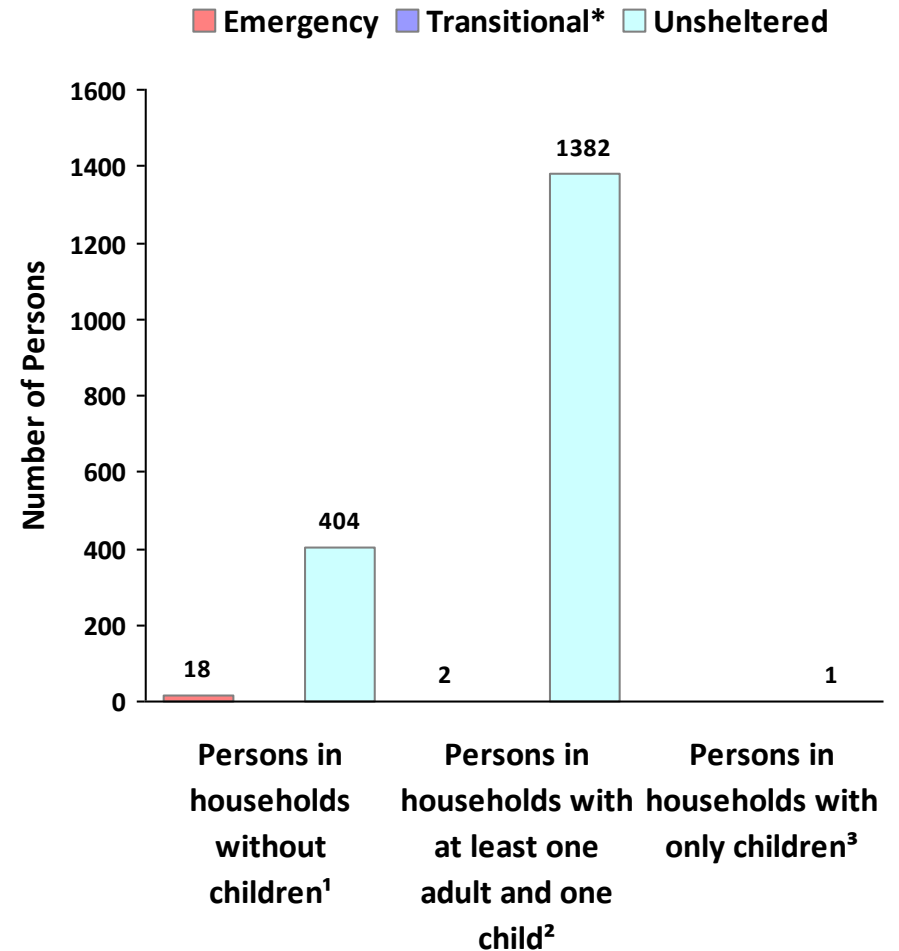
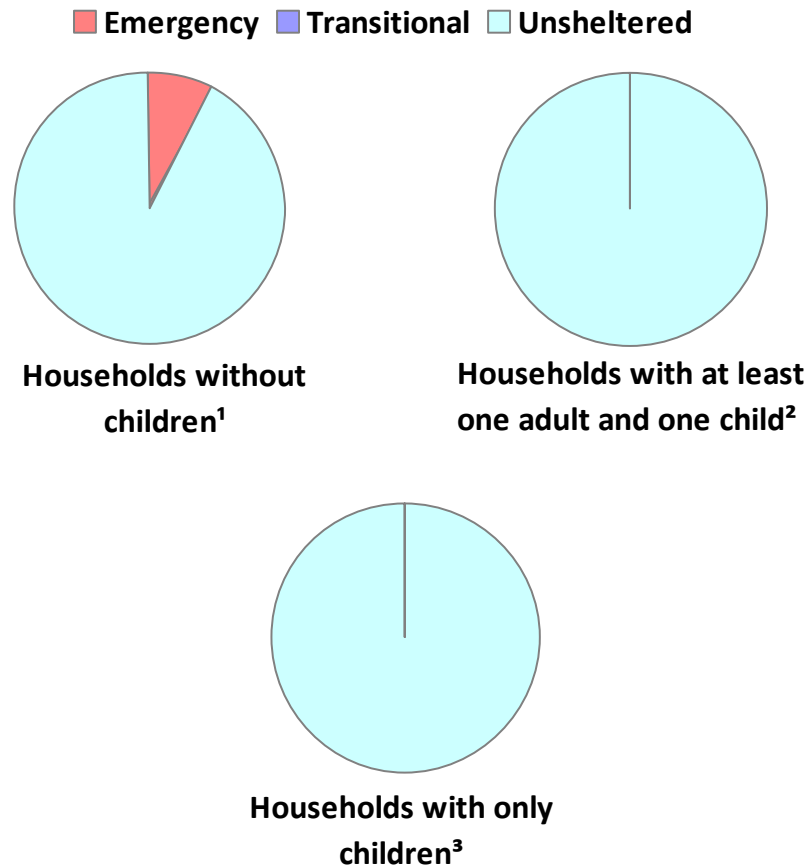

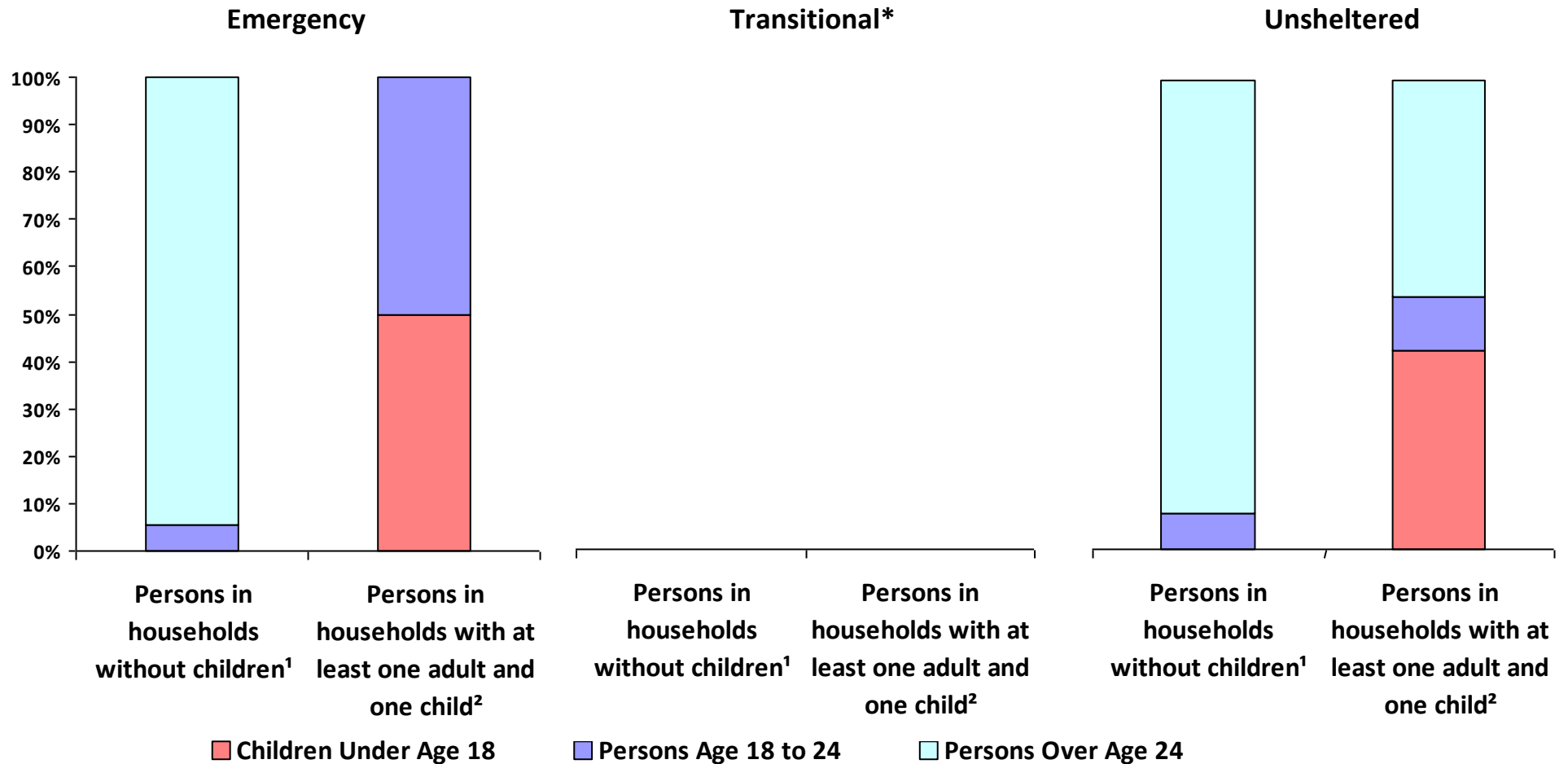

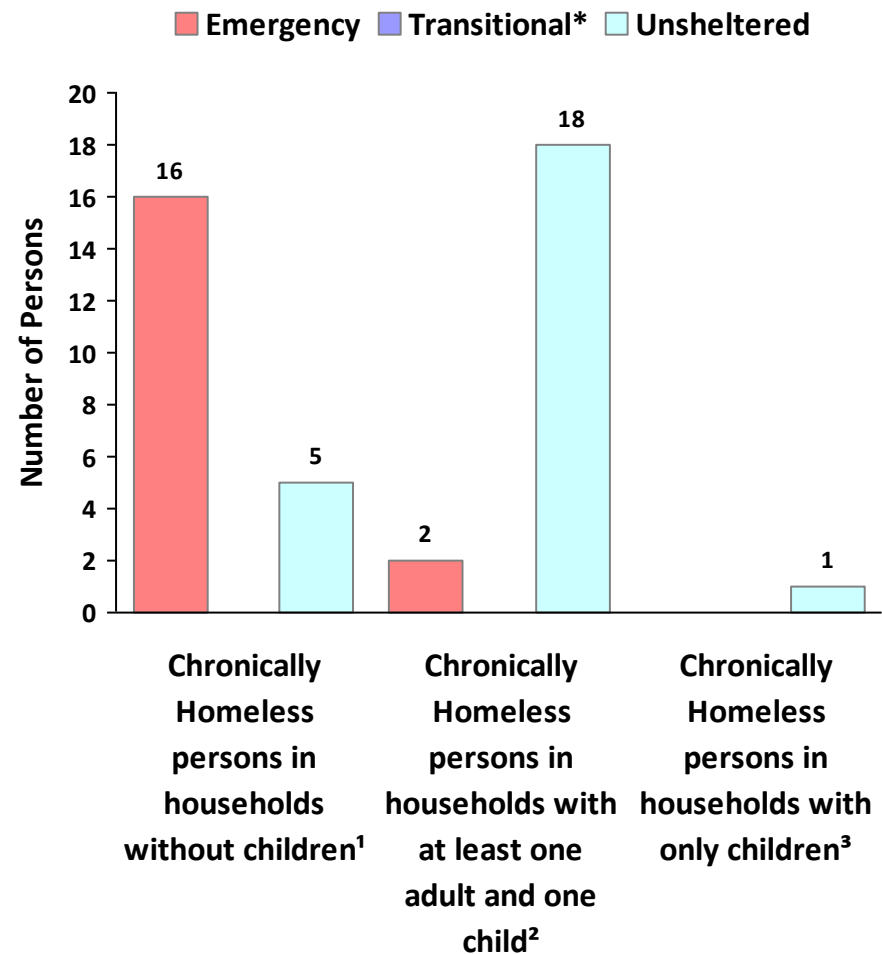
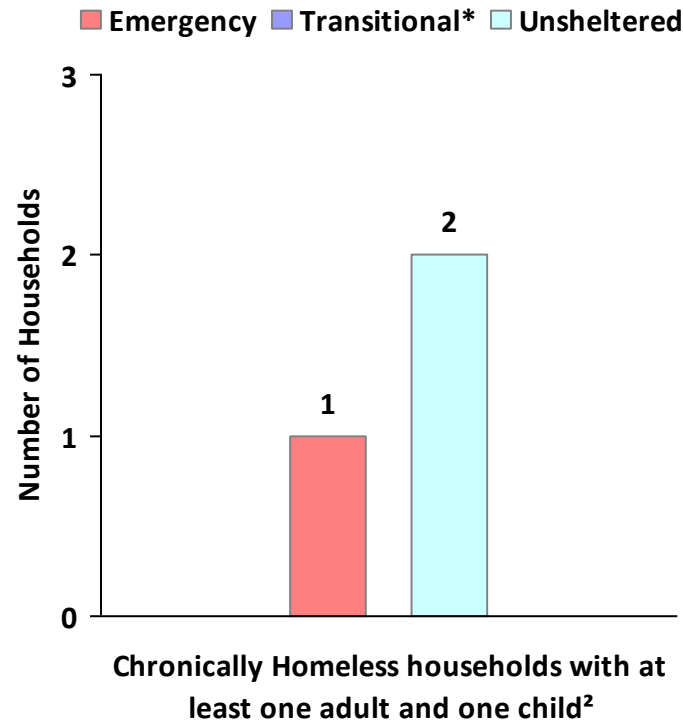
