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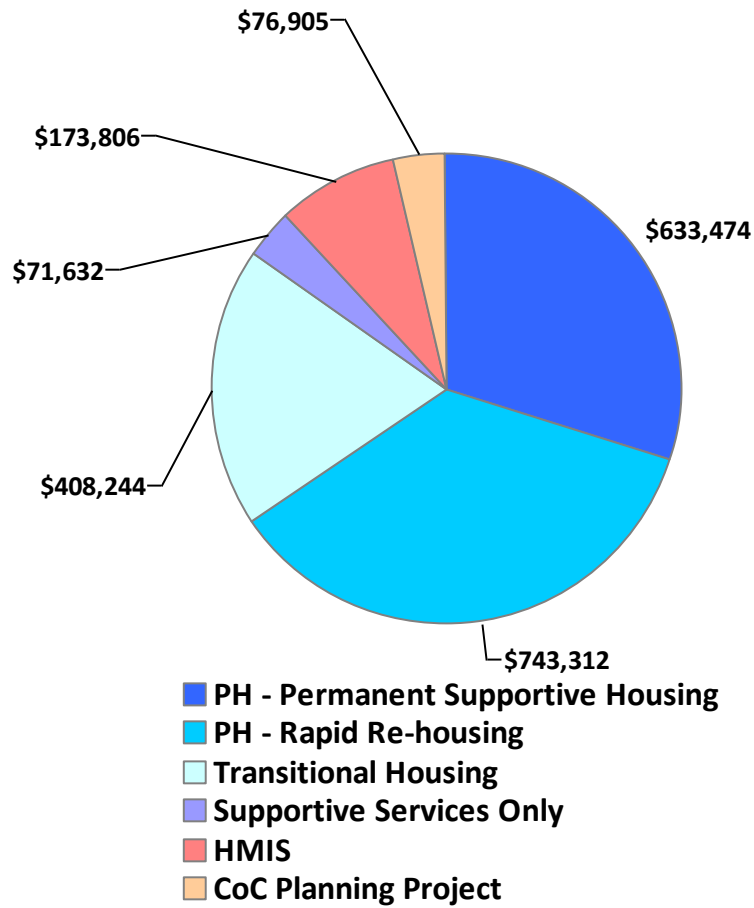

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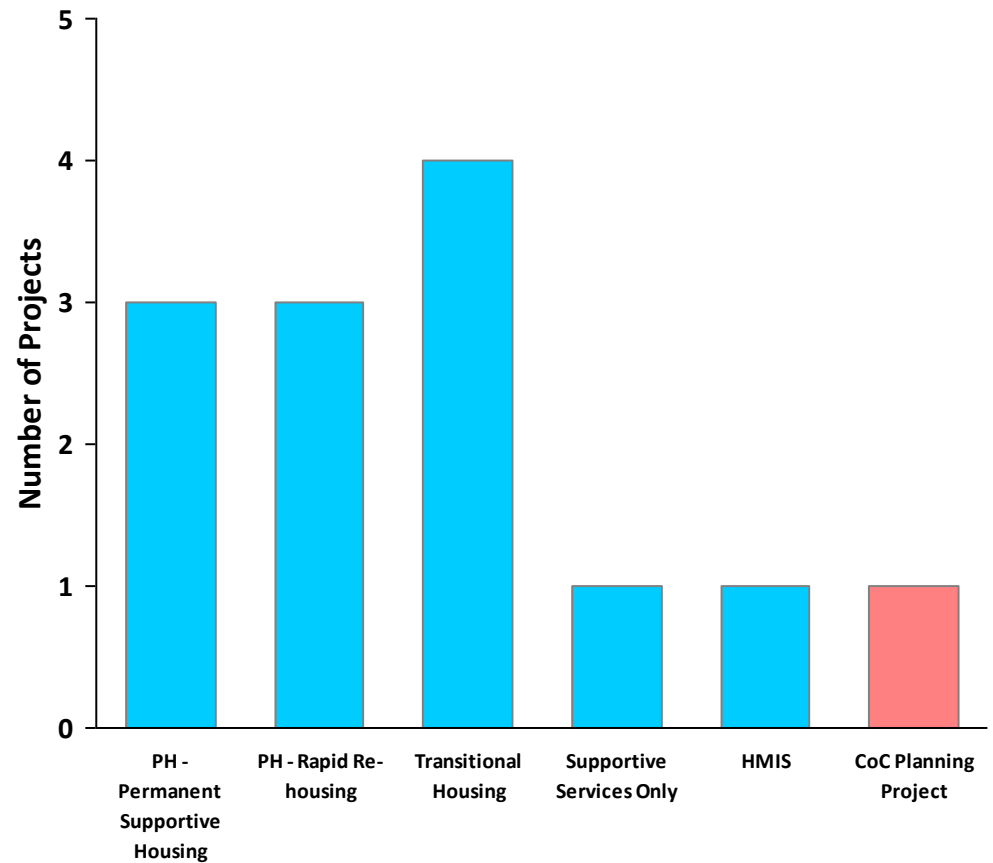

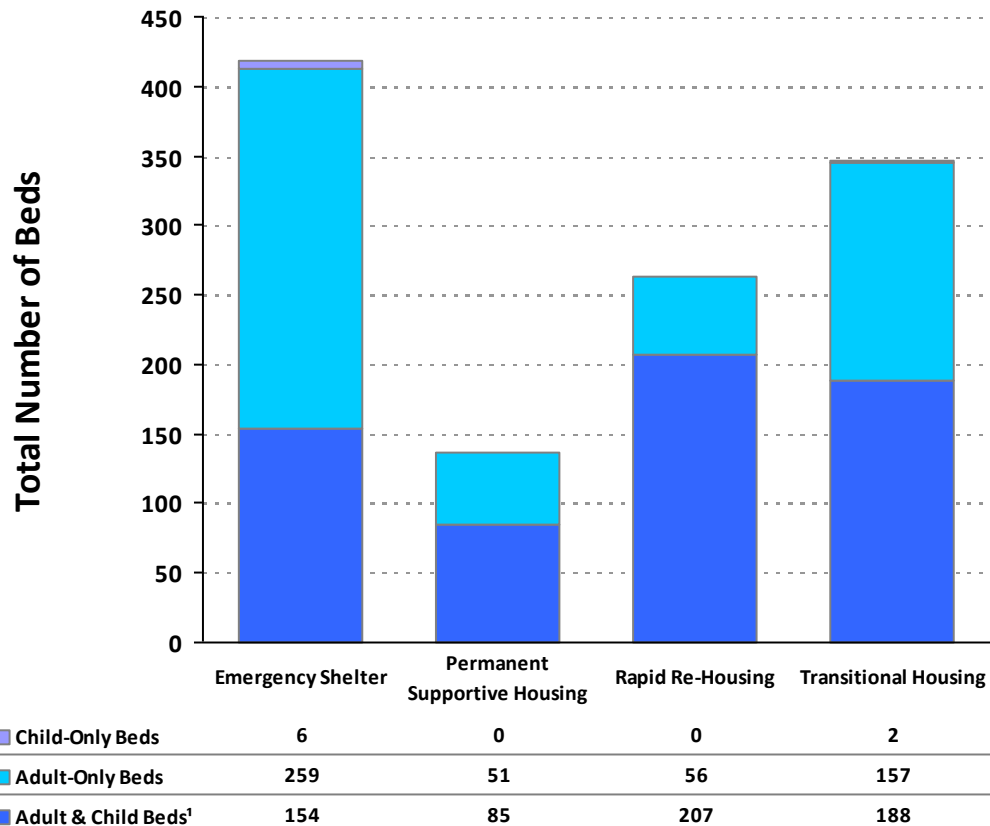
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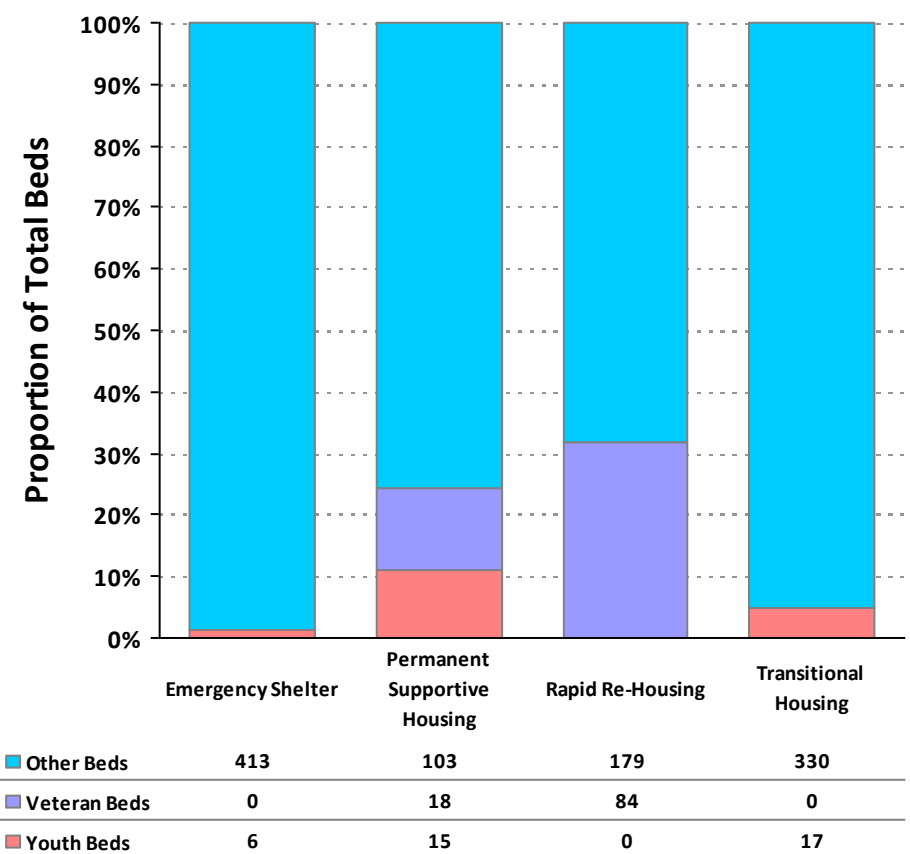
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## 2019 Housing Inventory Summarized by Target Population and Bed Type

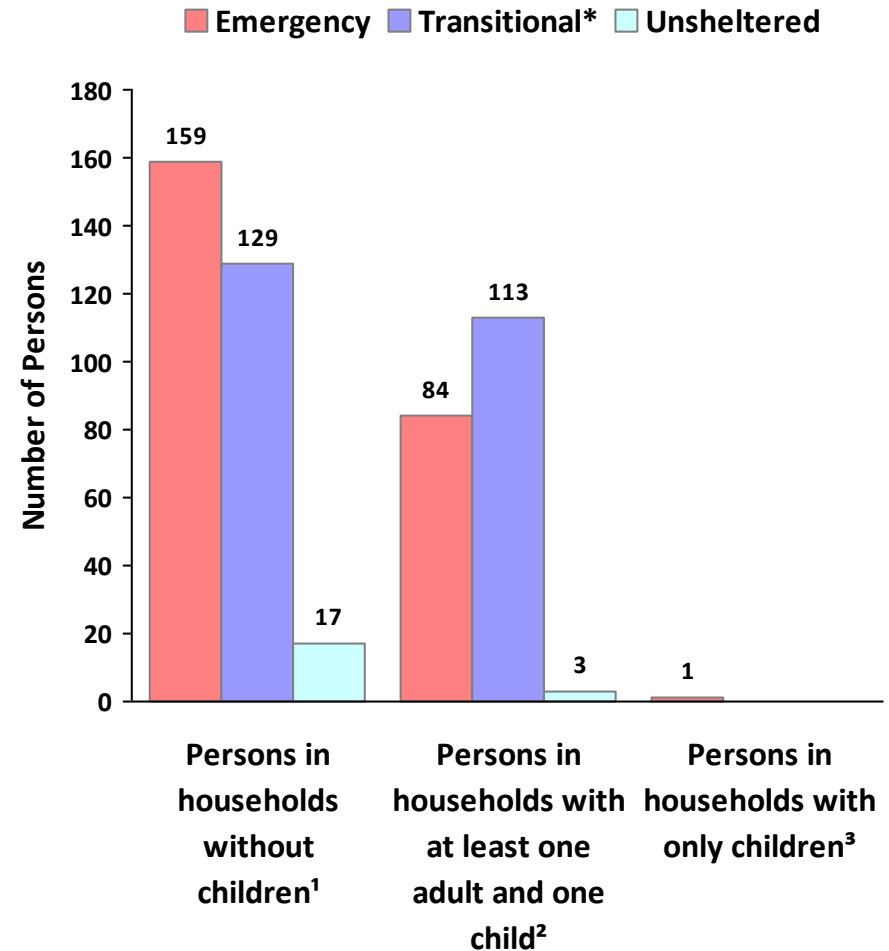
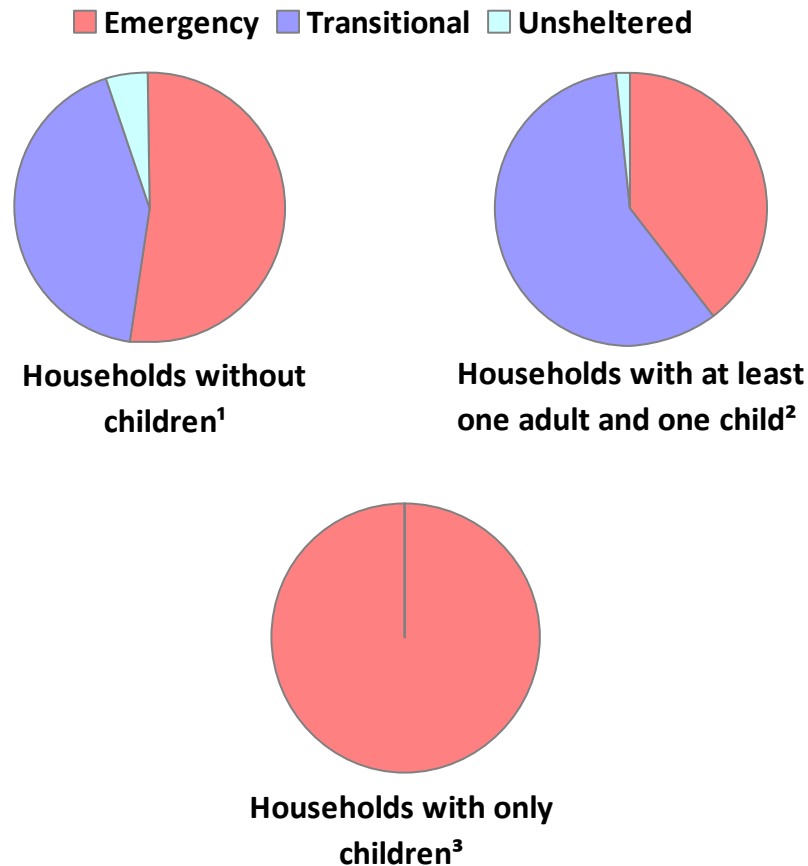

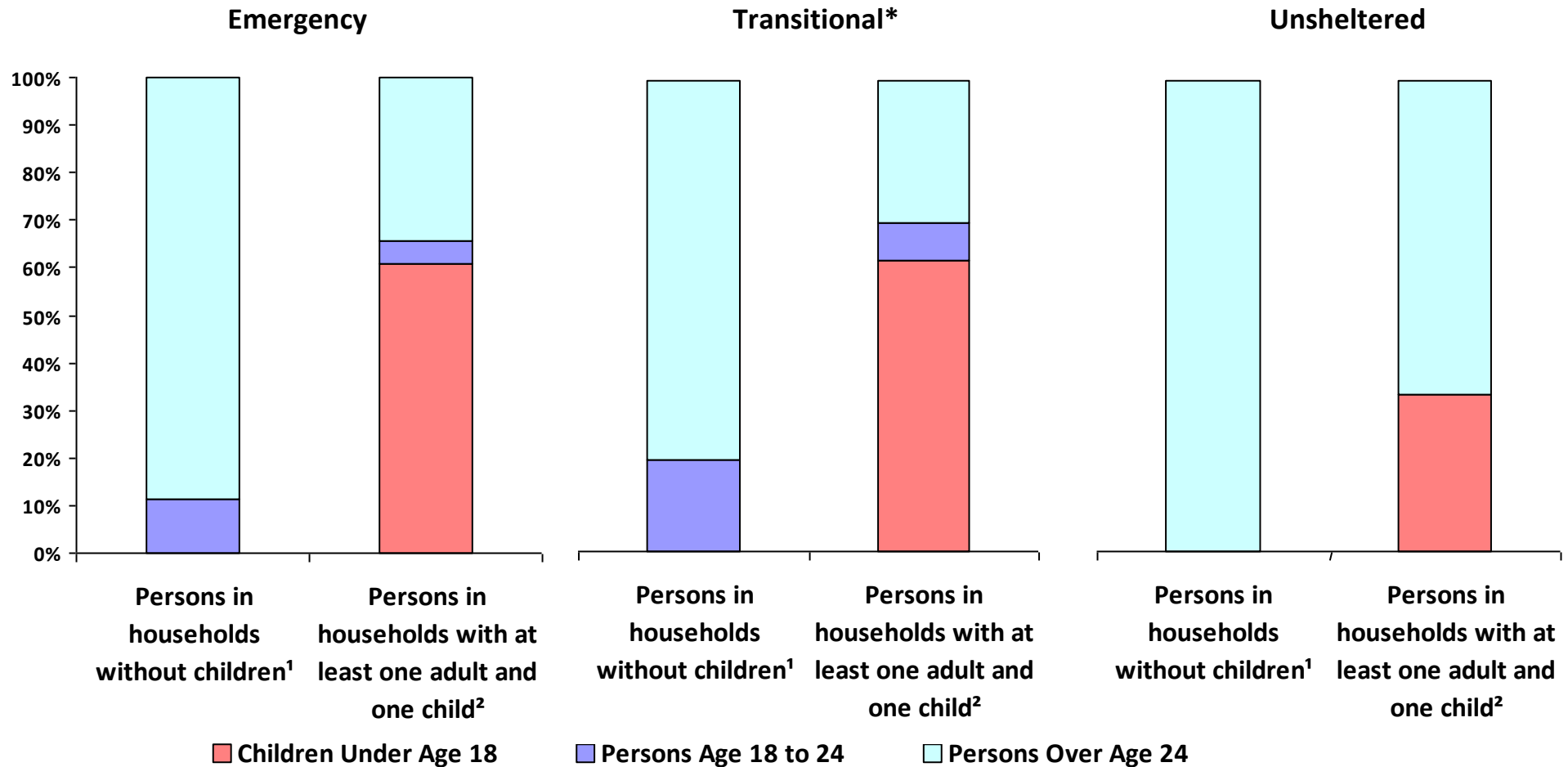


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## 2019 Point-In-Time Count Proportion of Persons in each Age Group by Household Type



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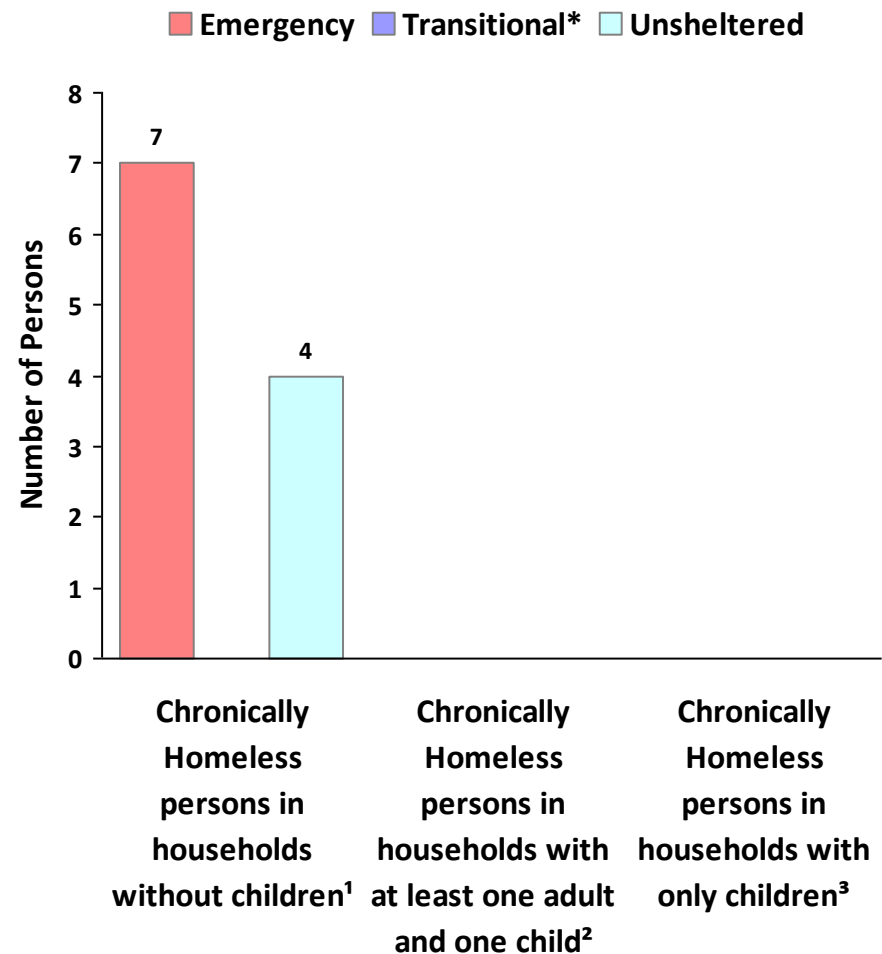


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### **2019 Point in Time Count Summarized by Chronically Homeless by Household Type**
