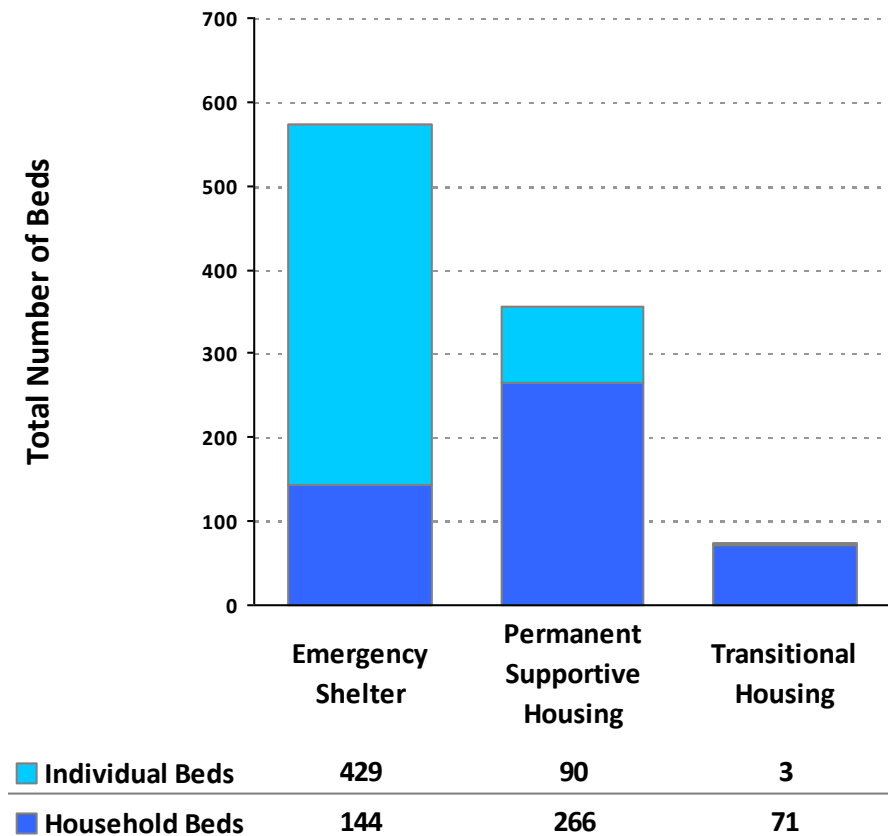

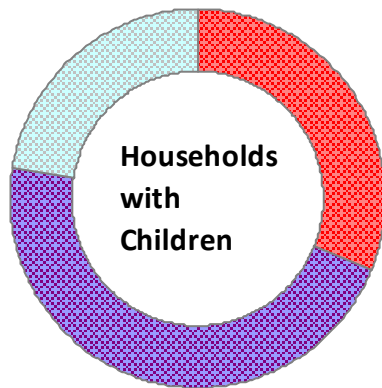

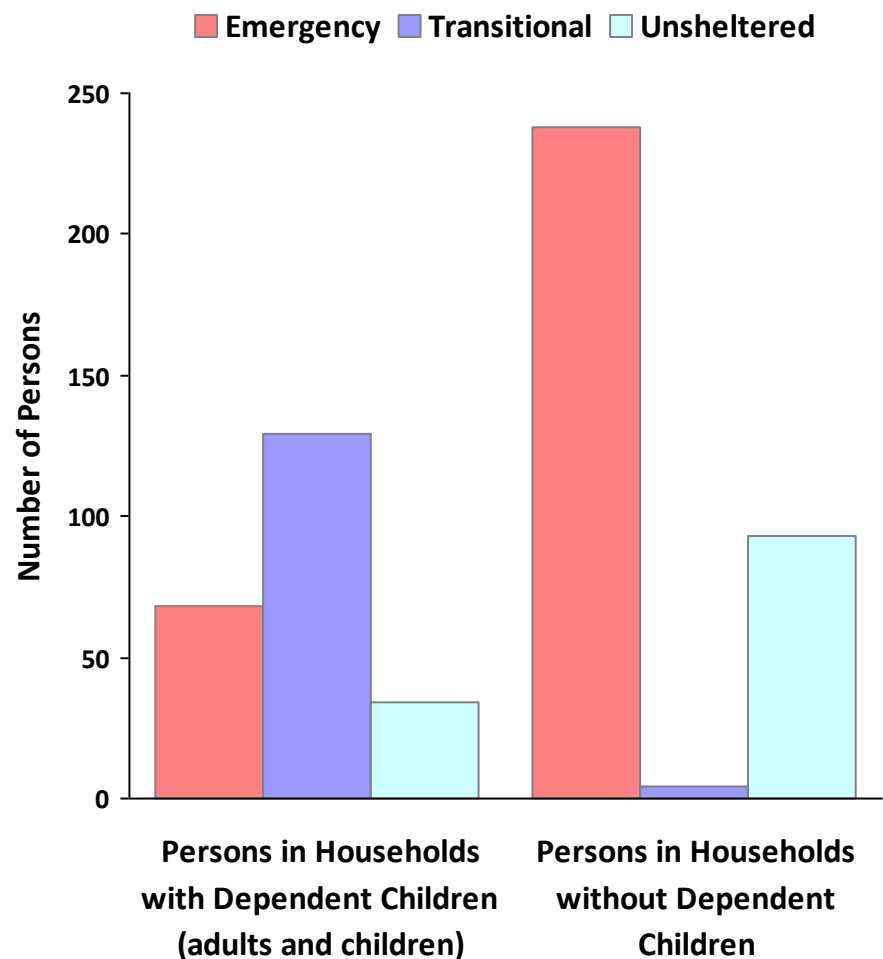
### **2009 Point in Time Count Summarized by Household Type**
