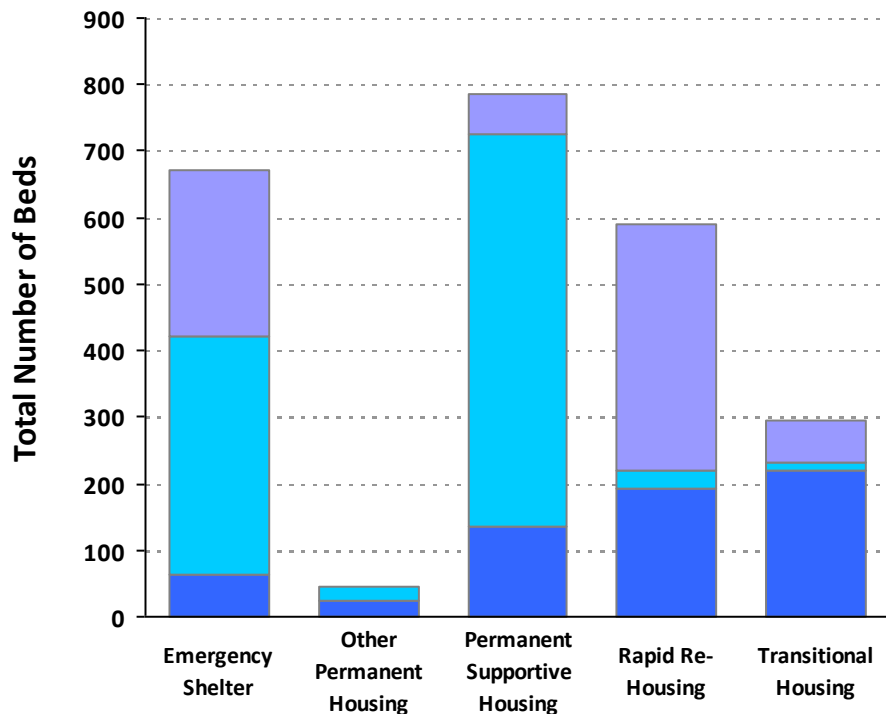
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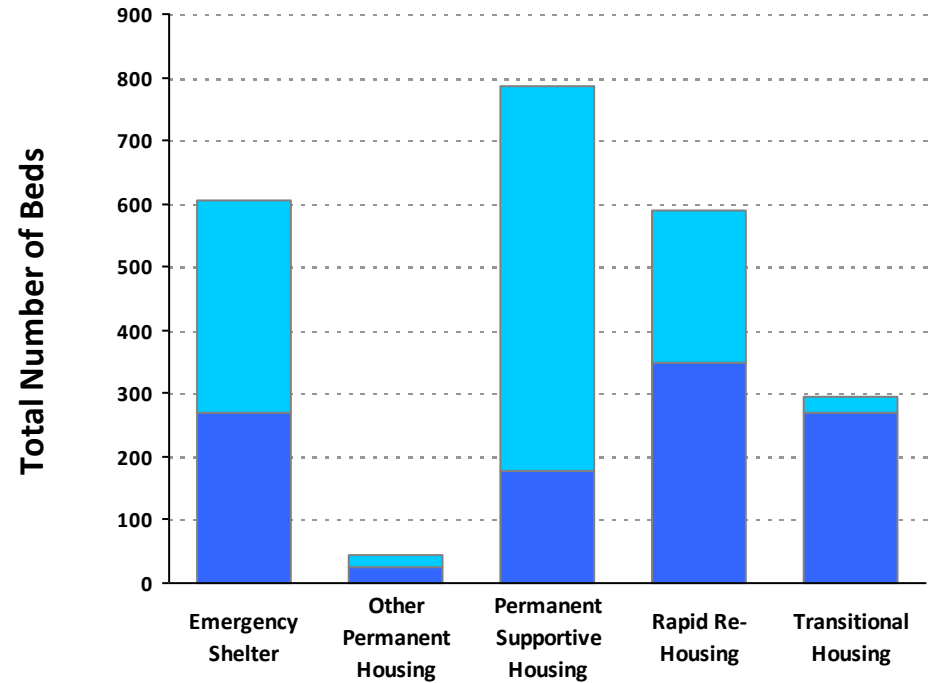

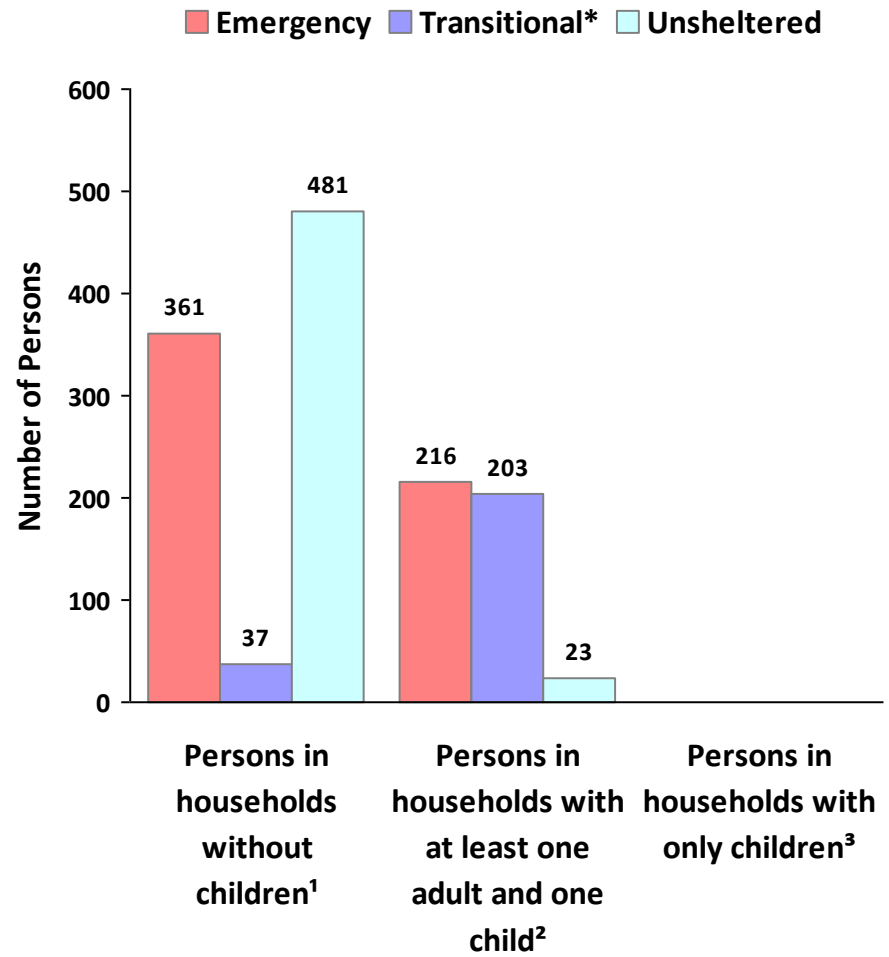
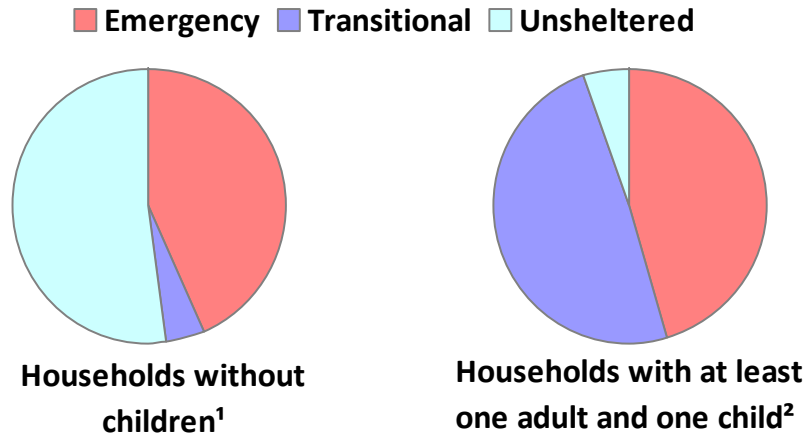

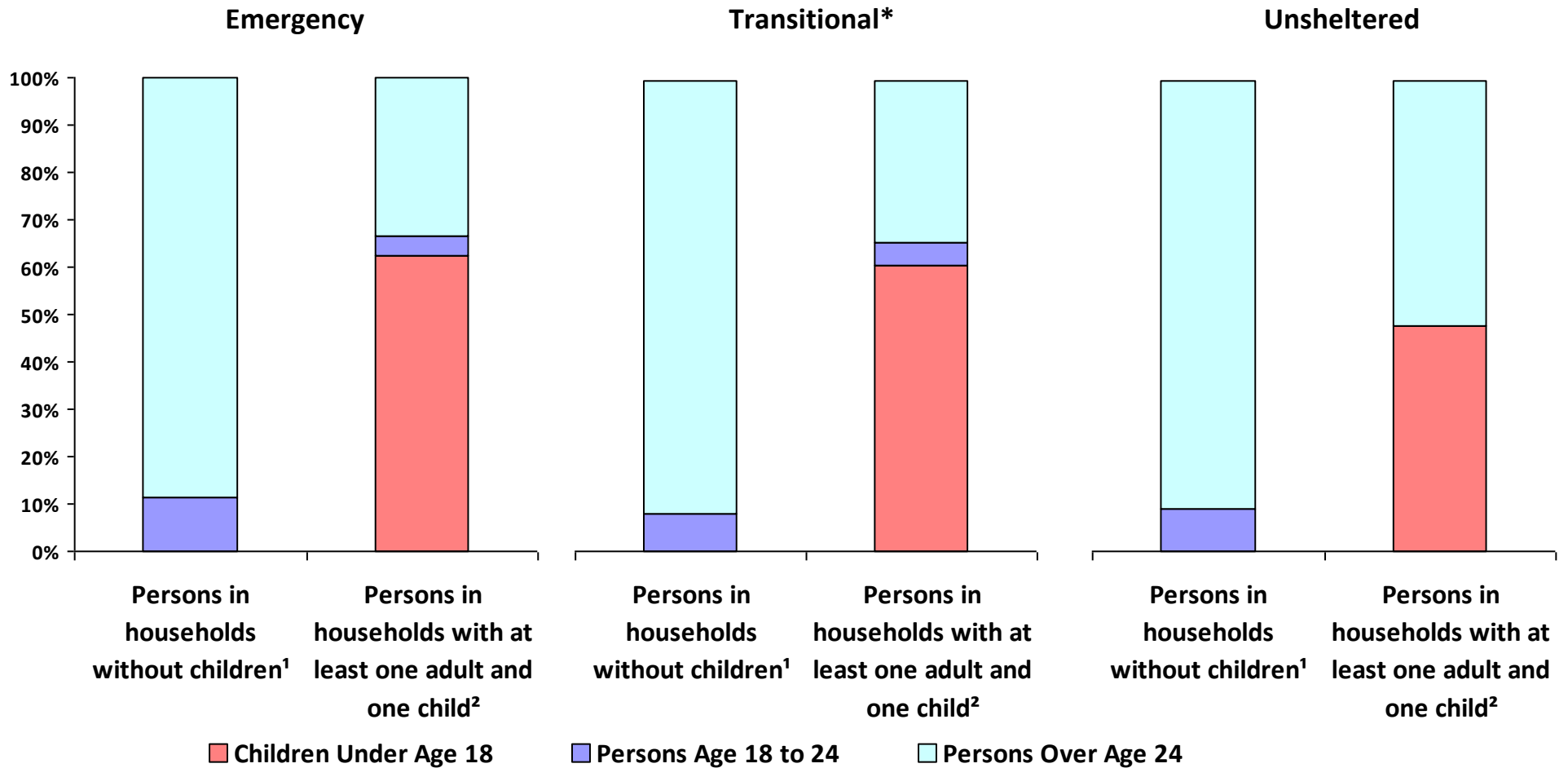


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2017 Point-In-Time Count Proportion of Persons in each Age Group by Household Type



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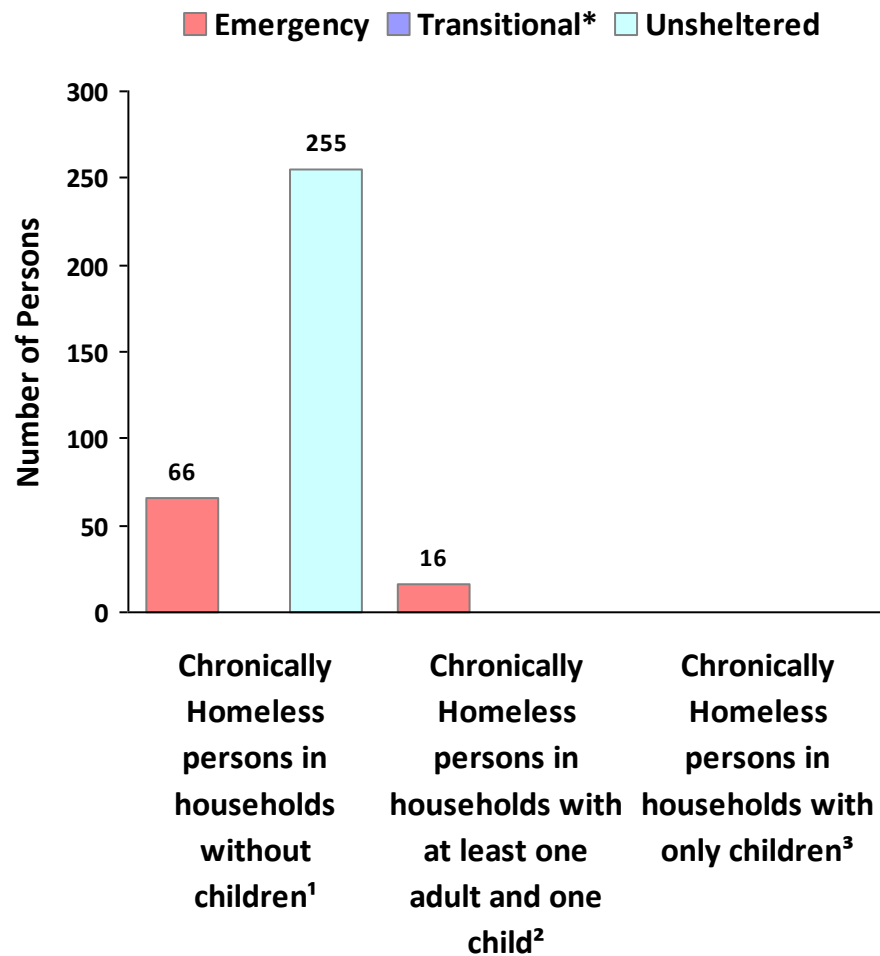
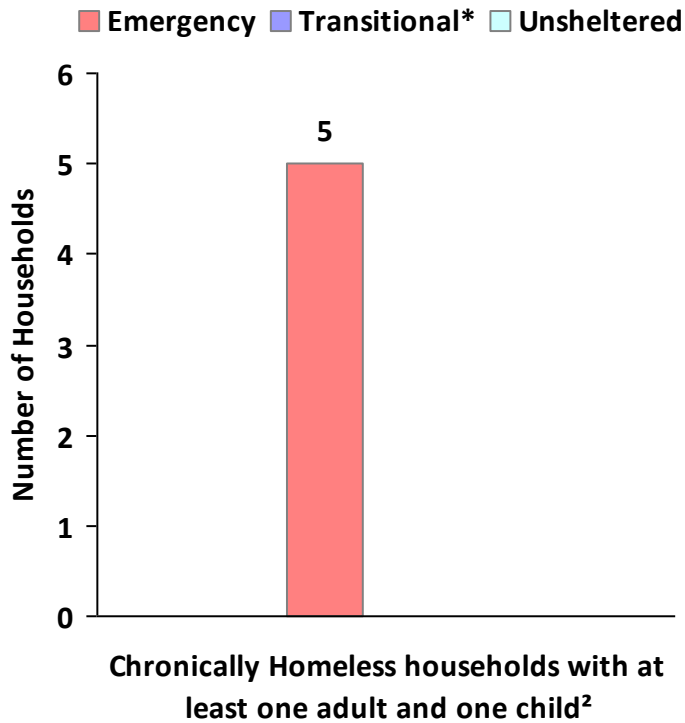


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2017 Point in Time Count Summarized by Chronically Homeless by Household Type
