

## **HUD 2022 Continuum of Care Homeless Assistance Programs Housing Inventory Count Report**

Important Notes About This Data: This report is based on information provided to HUD by Continuums of Care in the 2022 Continuum of Care application and has not been independently verified by HUD. CoCs were instructed to collect data for a point-in-time during the last week of January 2022. The data presented in this report are limited to beds available for occupancy on the night of the count (beds under development are excluded).
