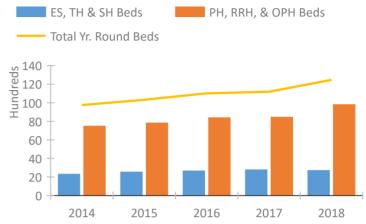
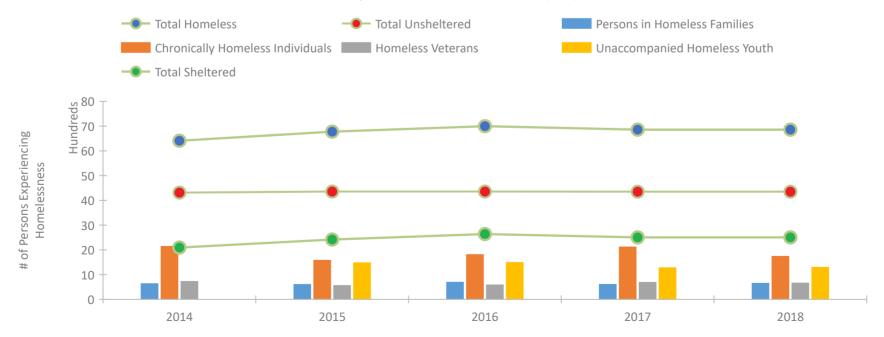

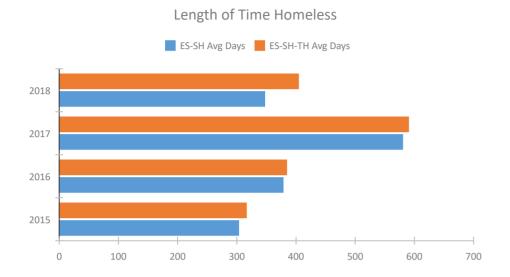
#### Housing Inventory Count by Program Type

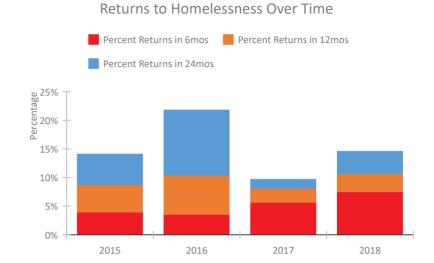


## Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count

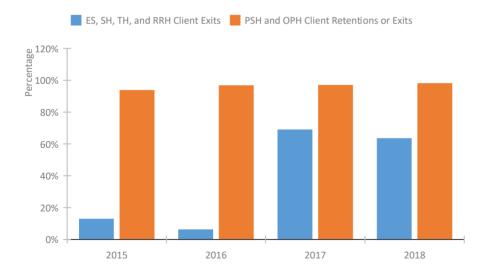
