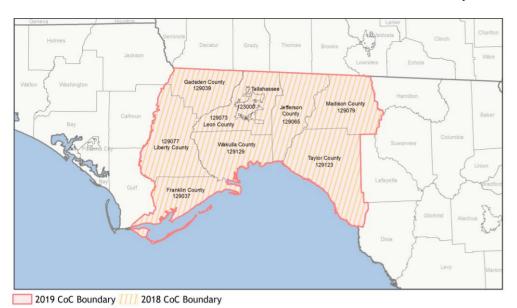

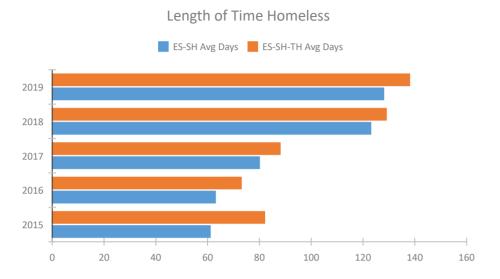
#### Housing Inventory Count by Program Type

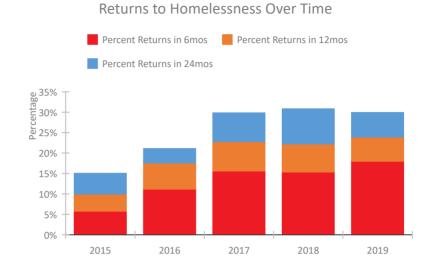


# Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count

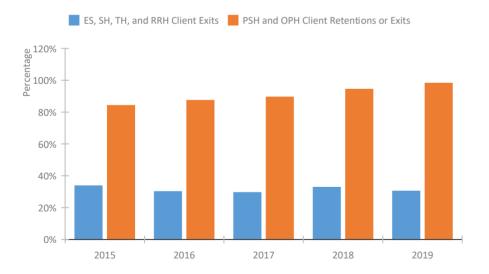
