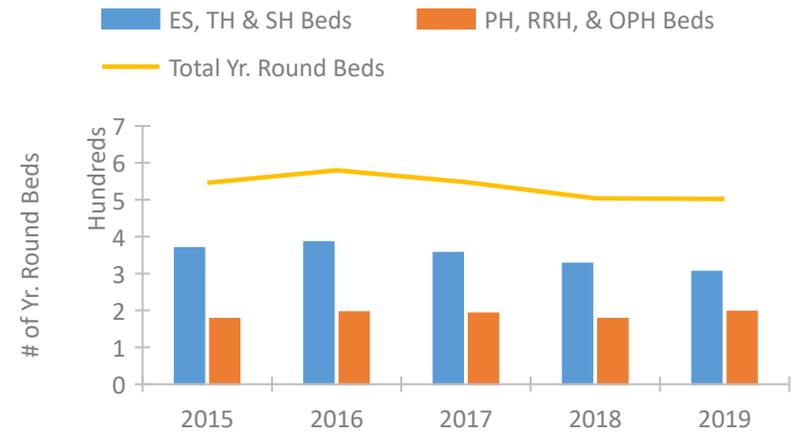


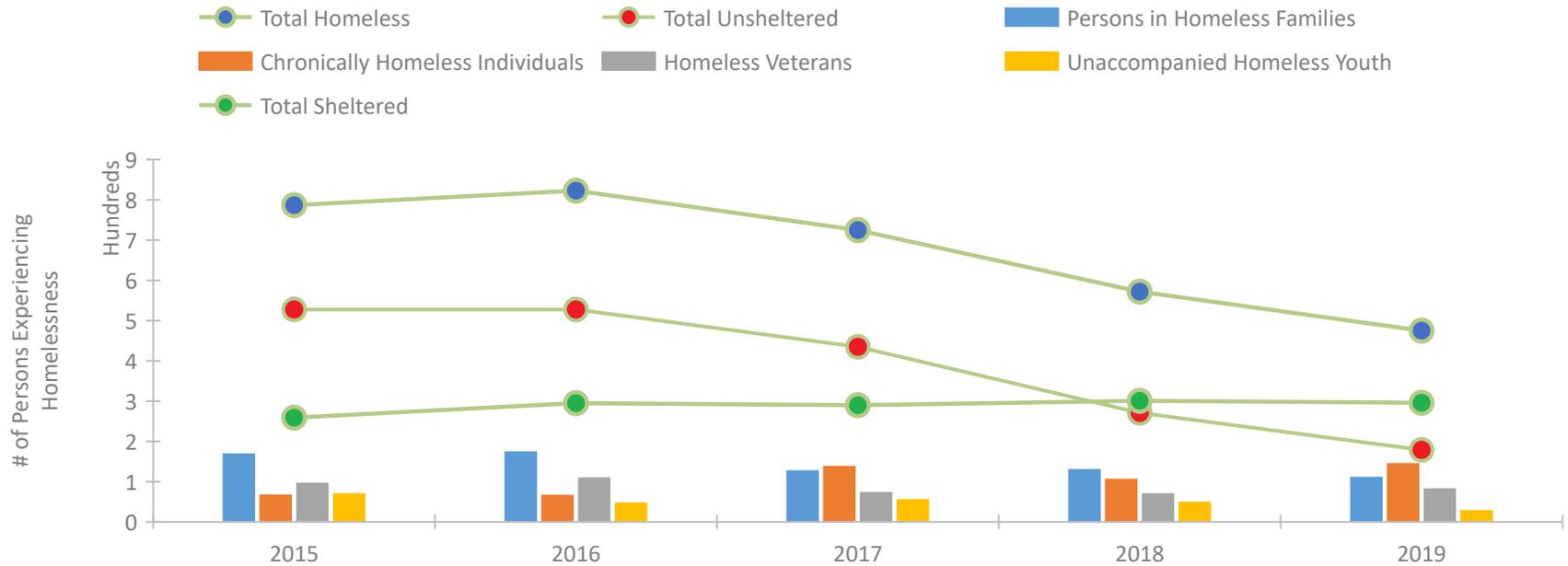

Housing Inventory Count by Program Type

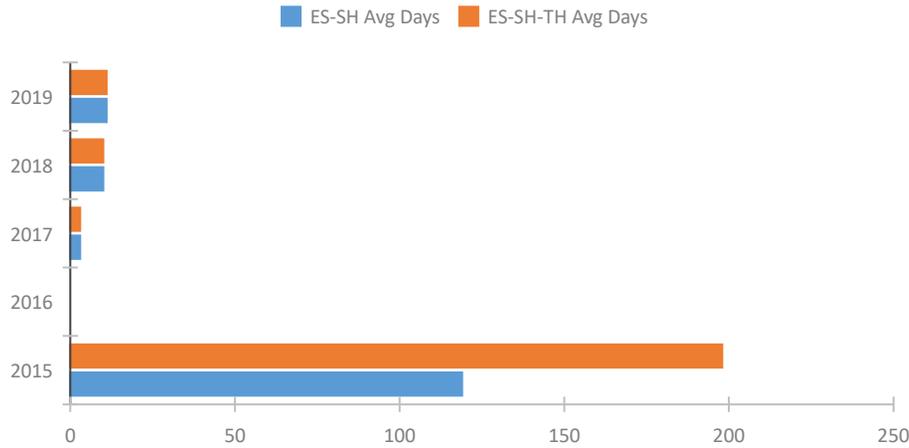


Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count

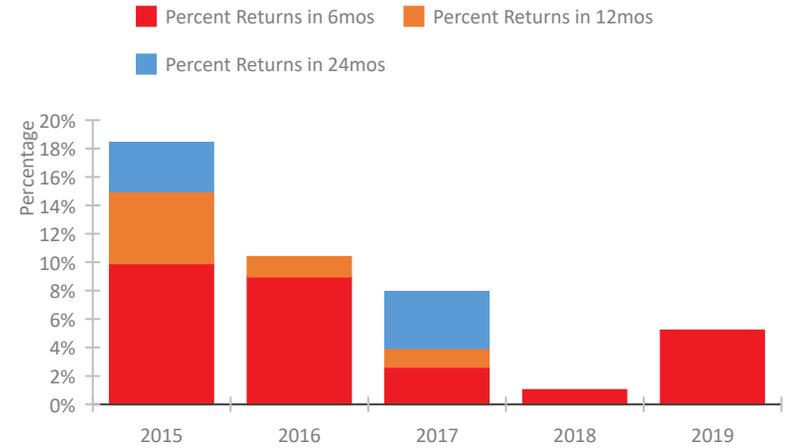

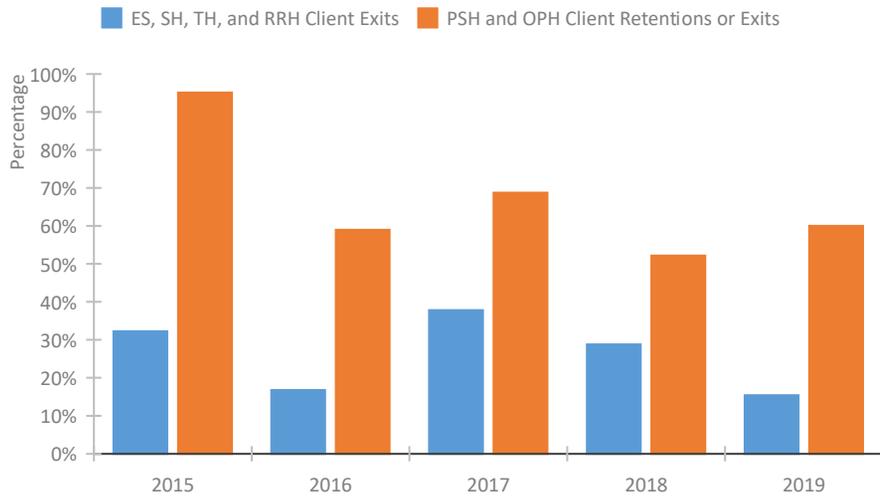
Length of Time Homeless



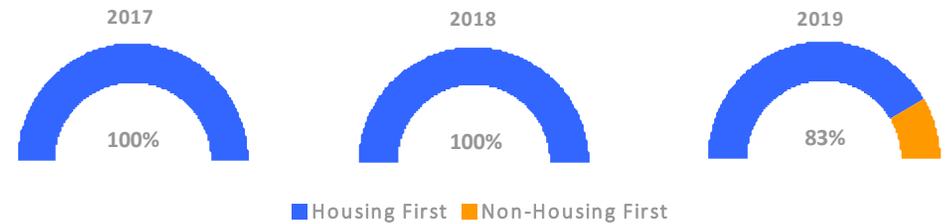
Returns to Homelessness Over Time
