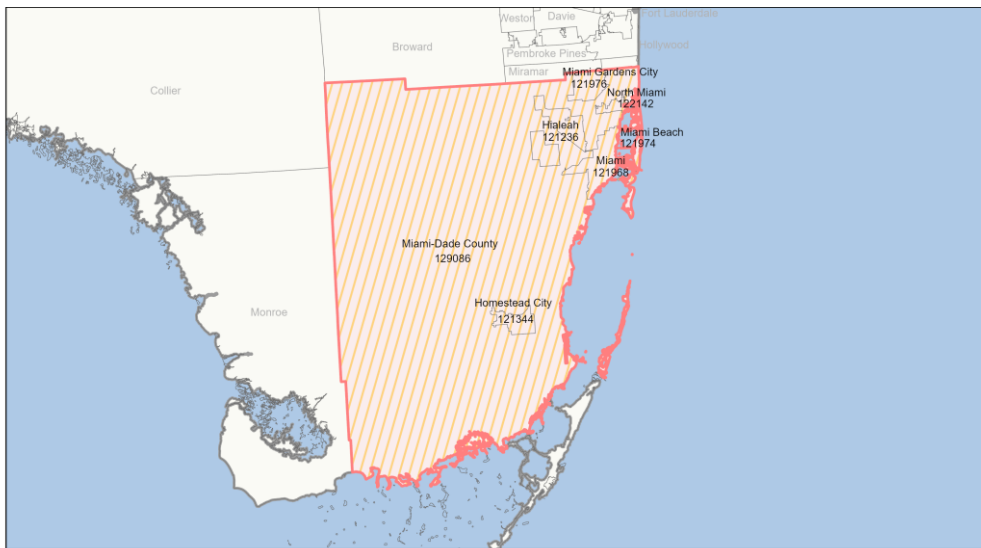


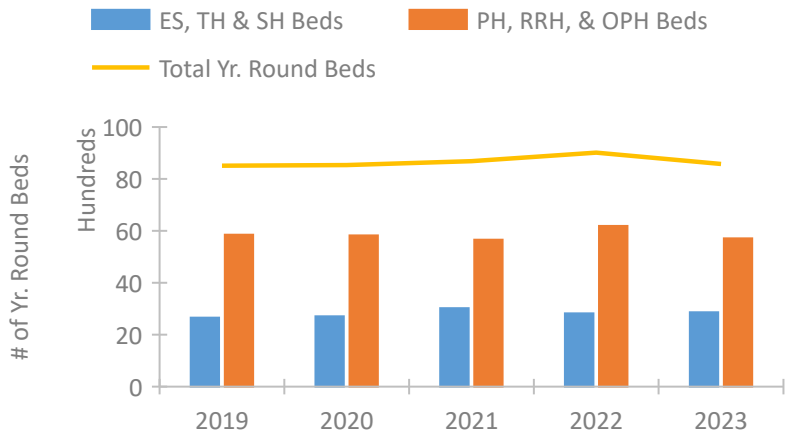

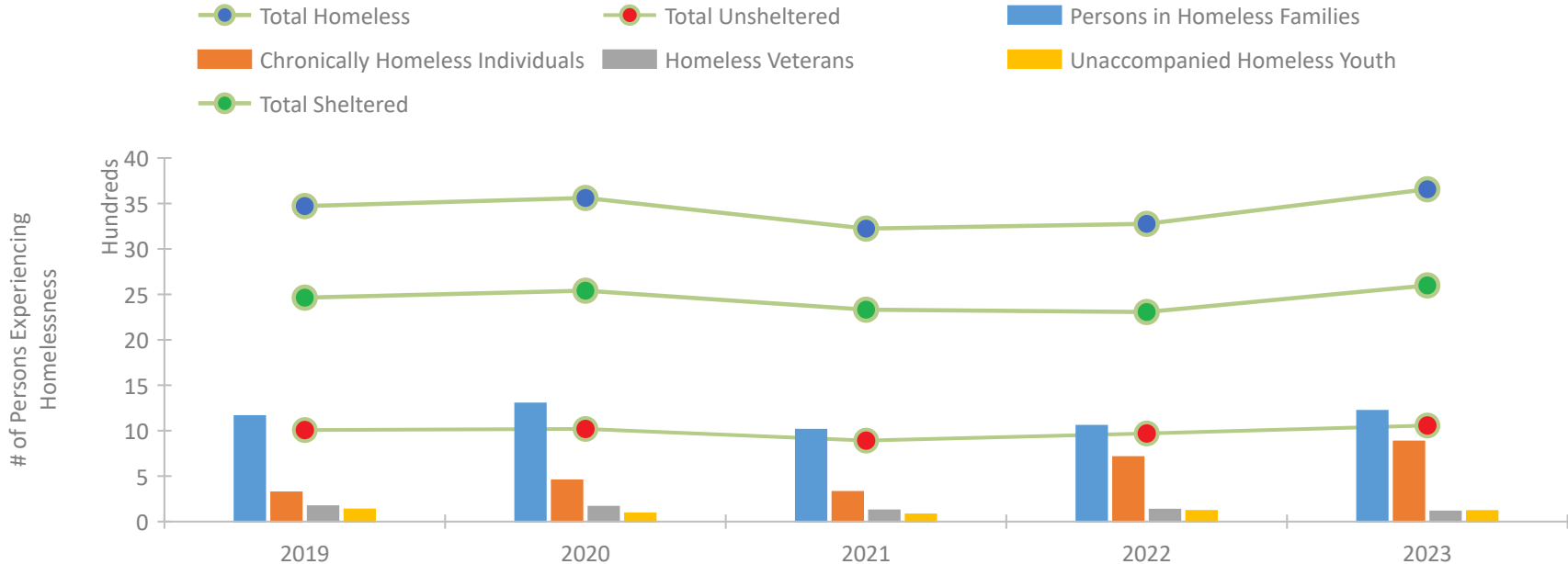


2023 CoC Boundary 2022 CoC Boundary

Housing Inventory Count by Program Type



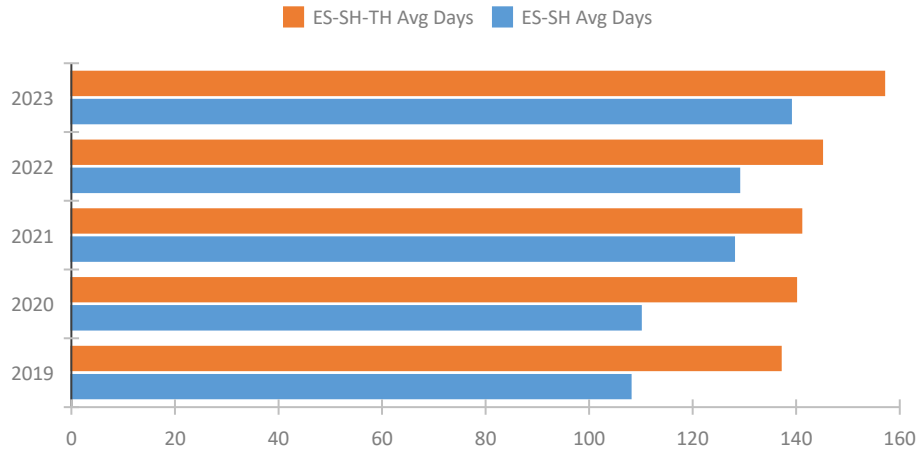
Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count*



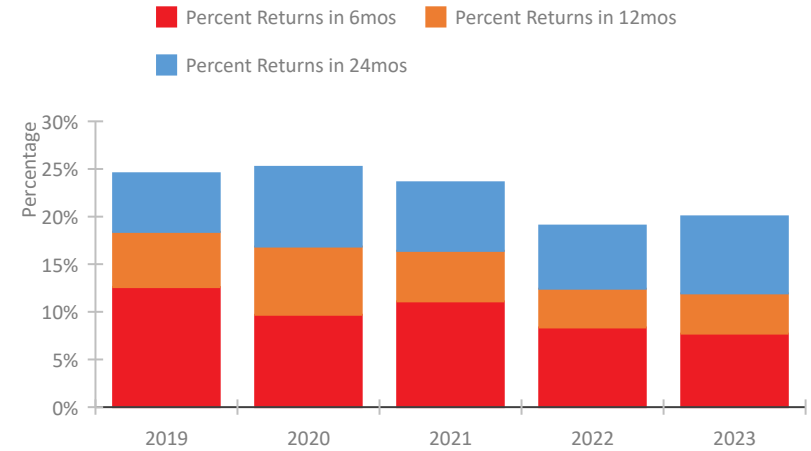

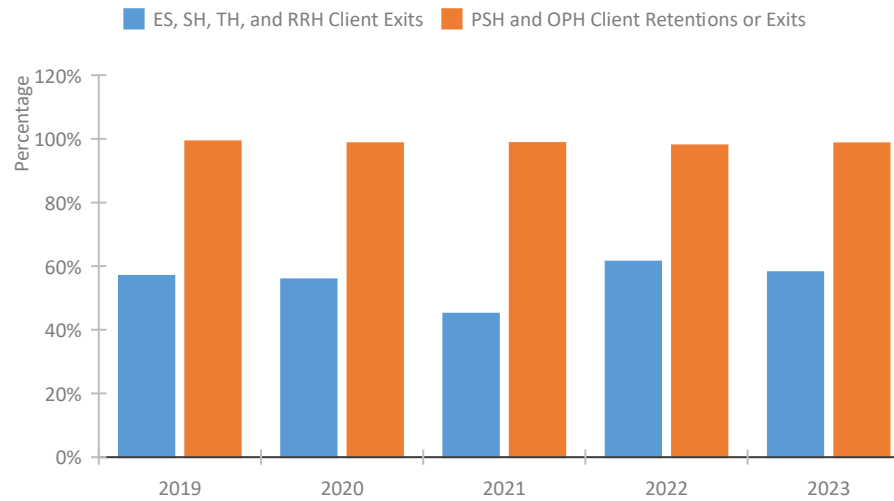
Length of Time Homeless
