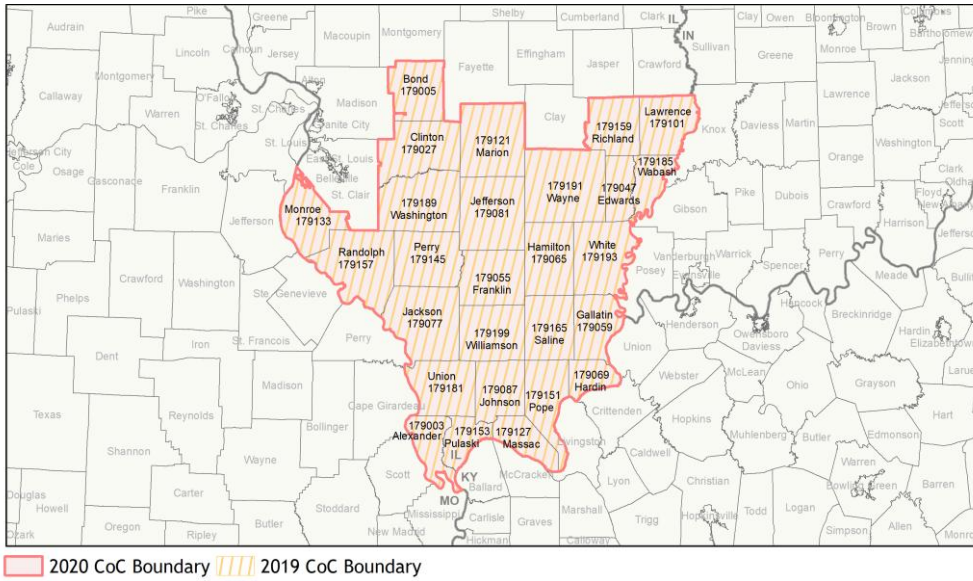
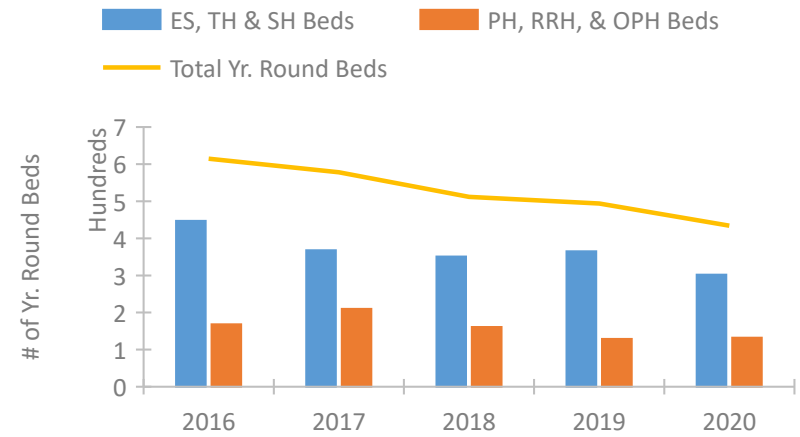

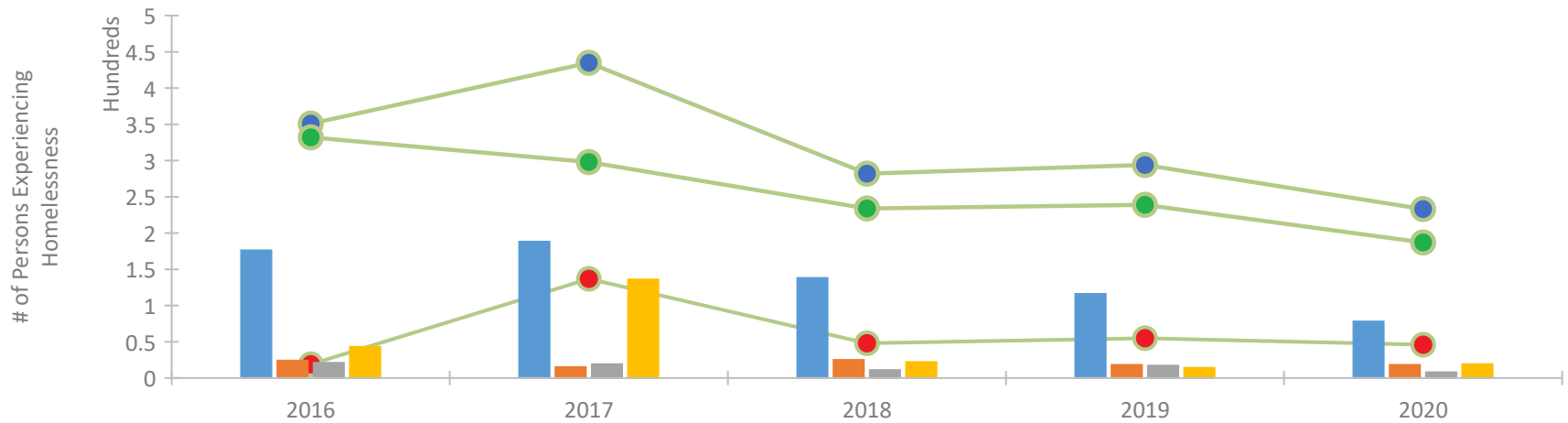


### Housing Inventory Count by Program Type



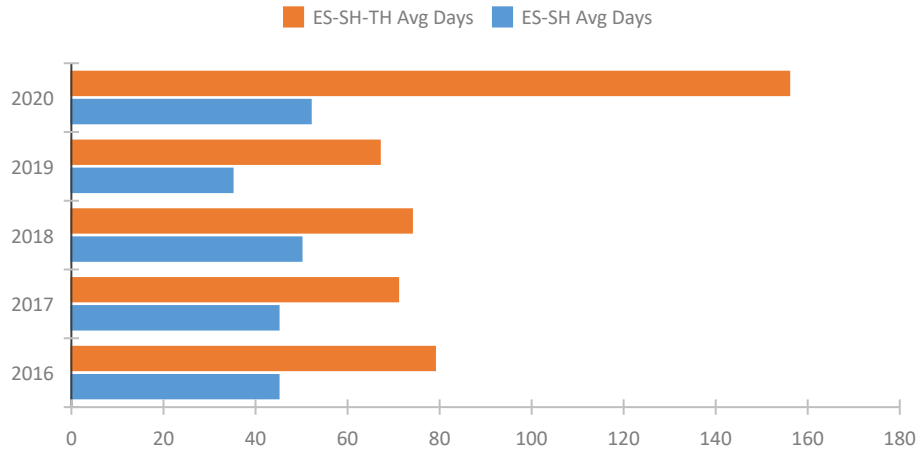

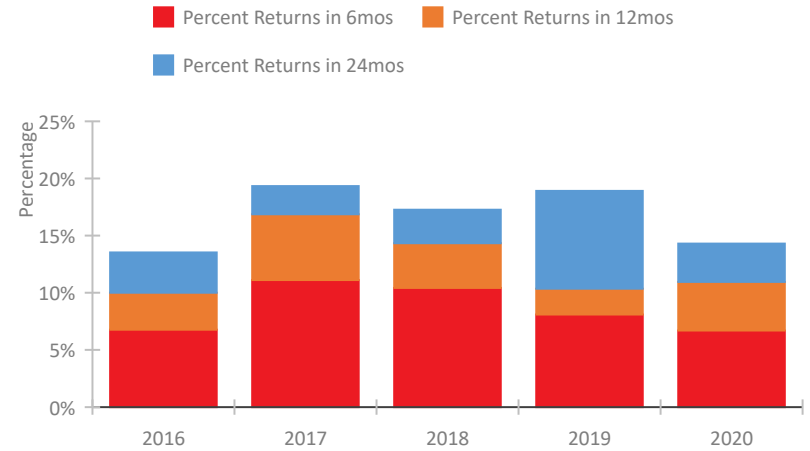

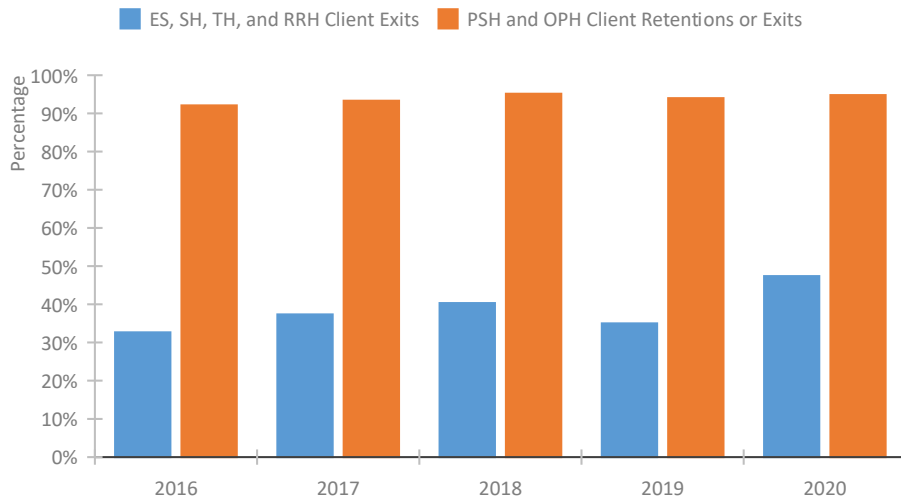
### Length of Time Homeless



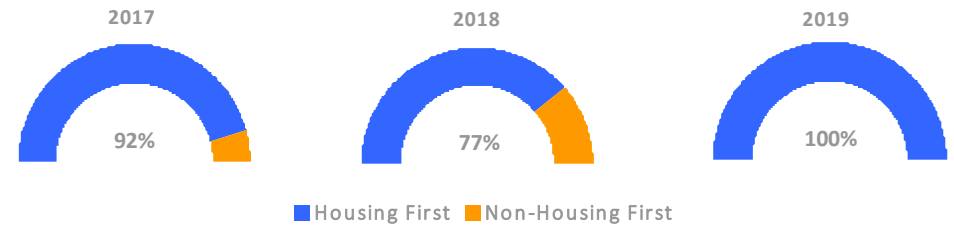
### Returns to Homelessness Over Time
