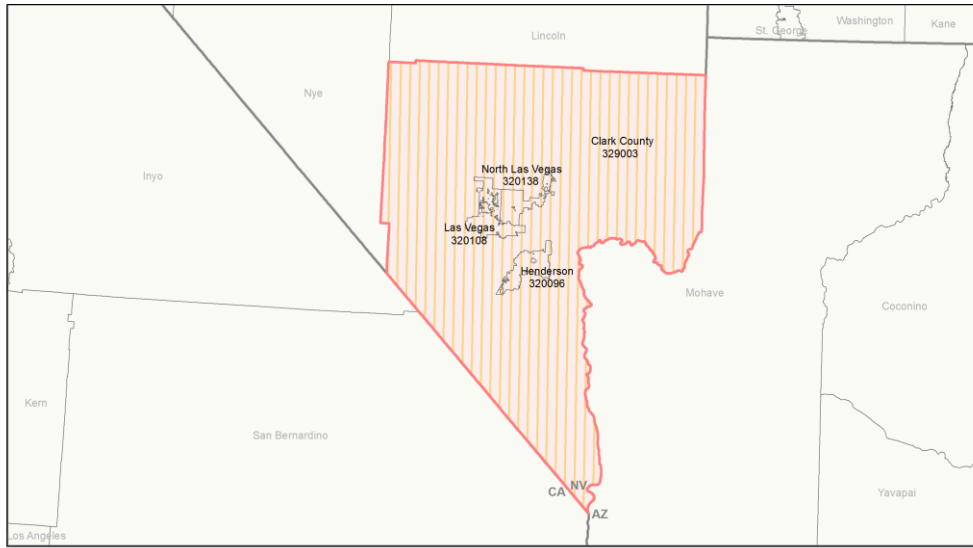
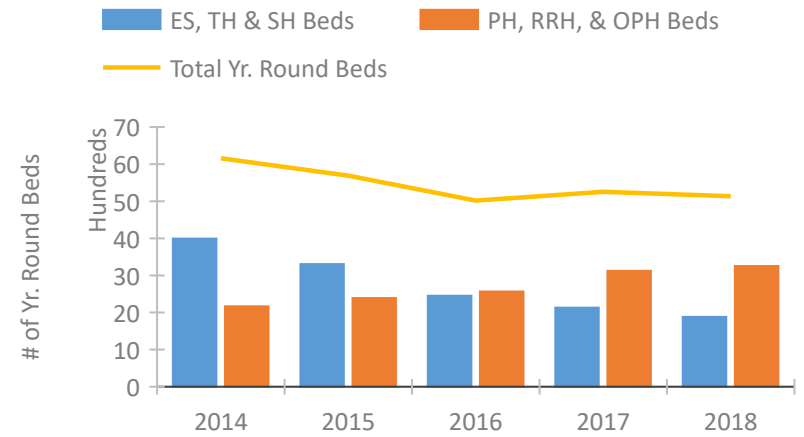


## CoC Performance Profile NV-500 Las Vegas/Clark County CoC

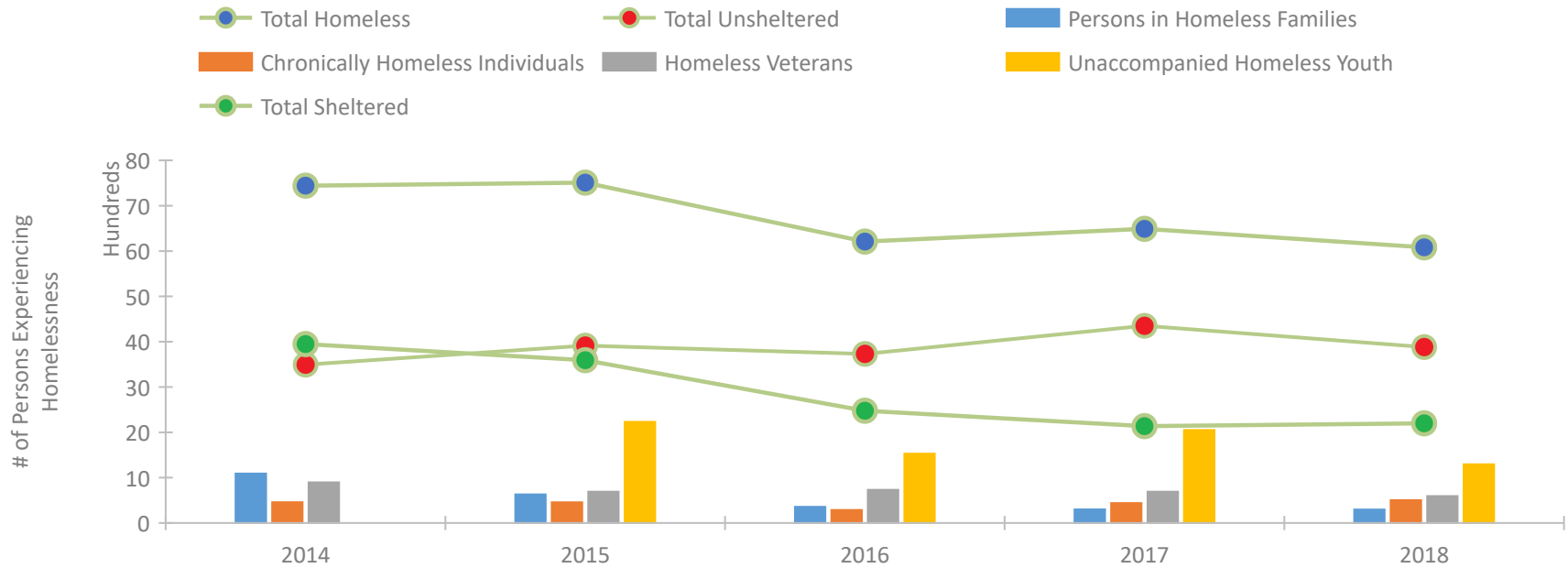


2018 CoC Boundary 2017 CoC Boundary

### Housing Inventory Count by Program Type

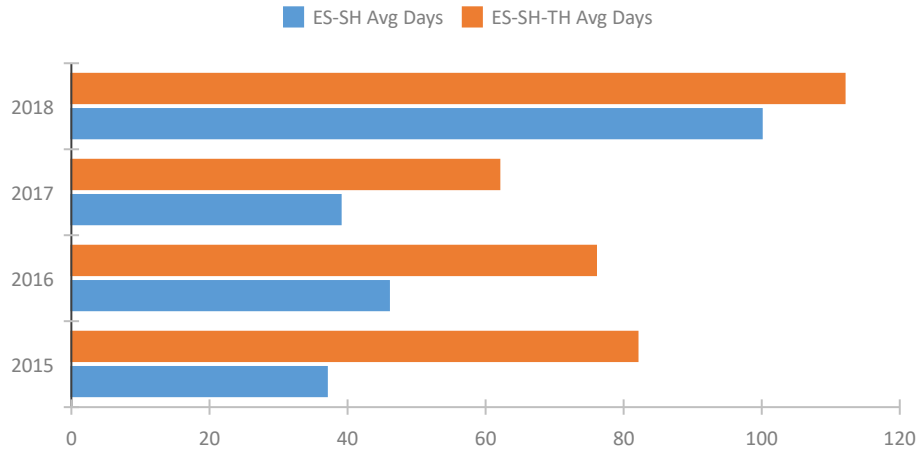


### Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count

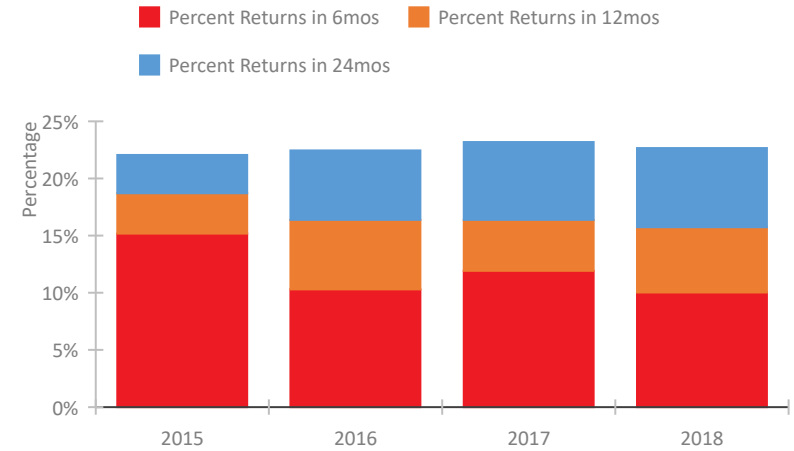

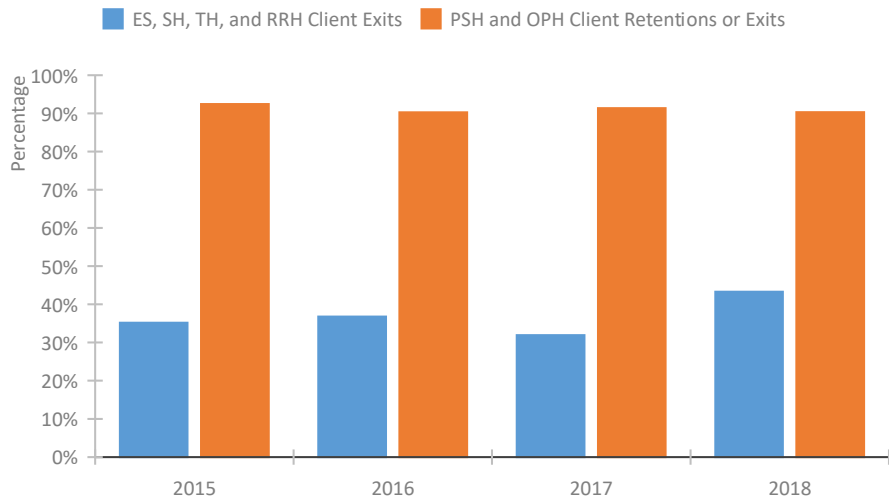
### Length of Time Homeless



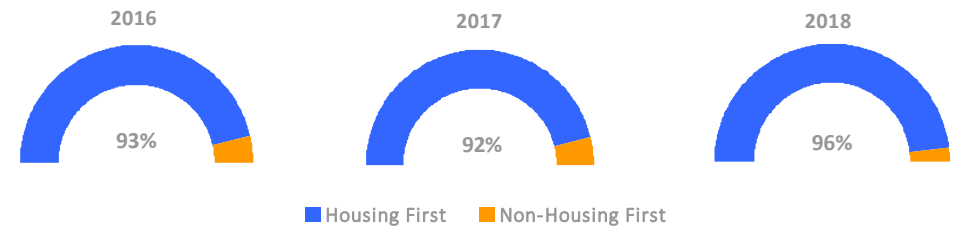
### Returns to Homelessness Over Time
