





### Length of Time Homeless



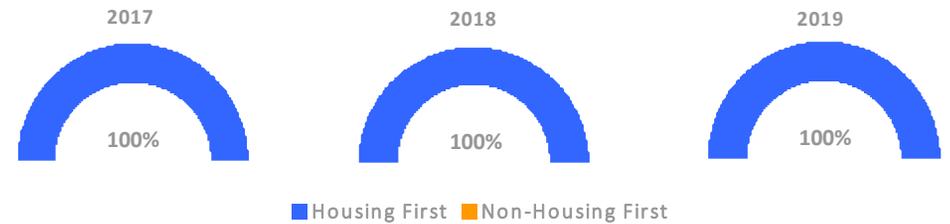
### Returns to Homelessness Over Time
