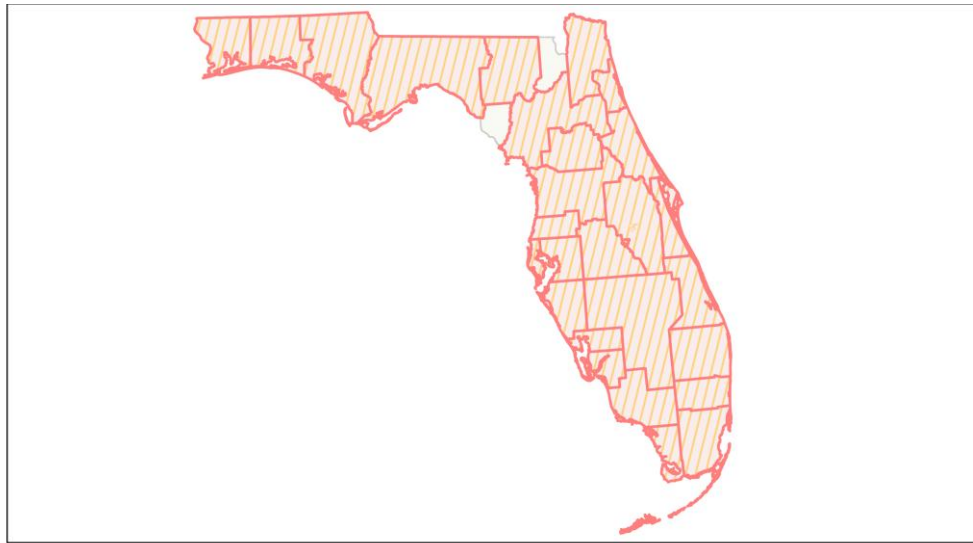
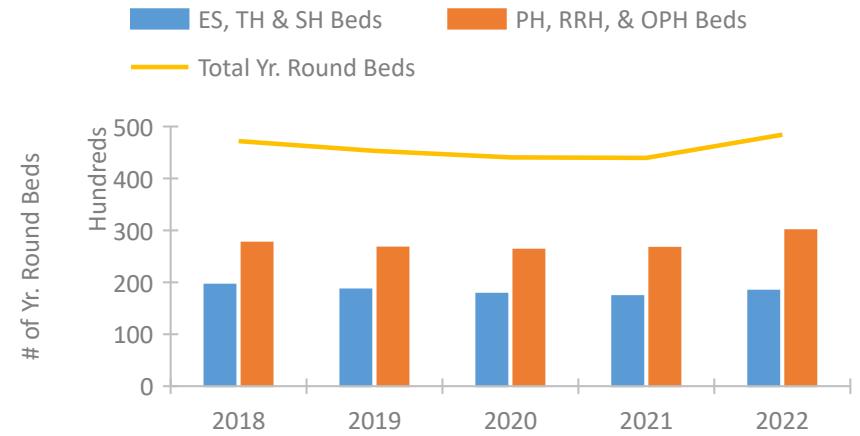

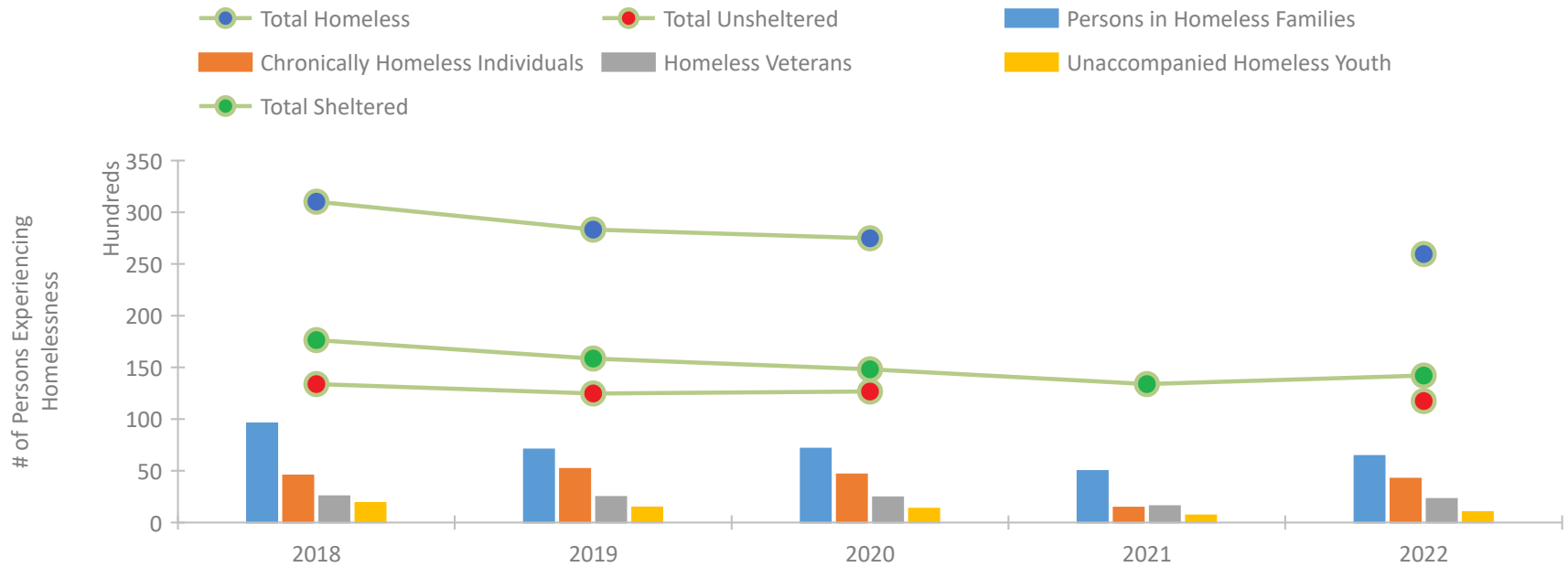


2022 CoC Boundaries 2021 CoC Boundaries

Housing Inventory Count by Program Type



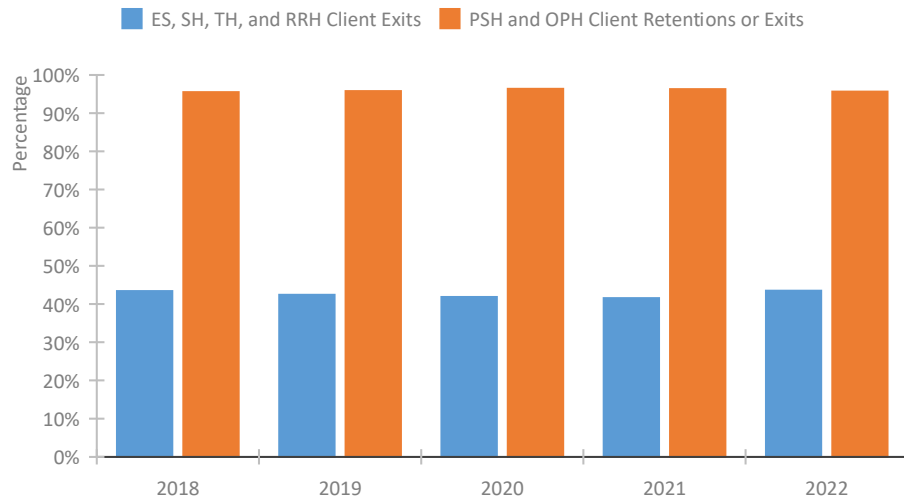
Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count*



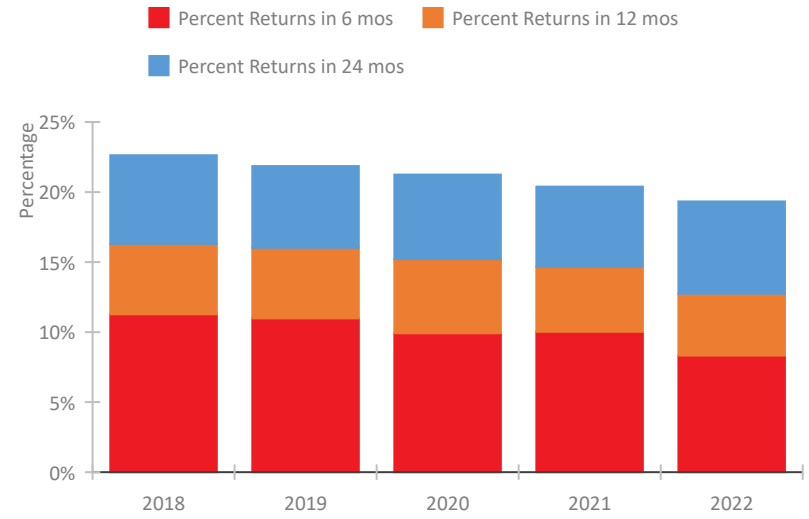
