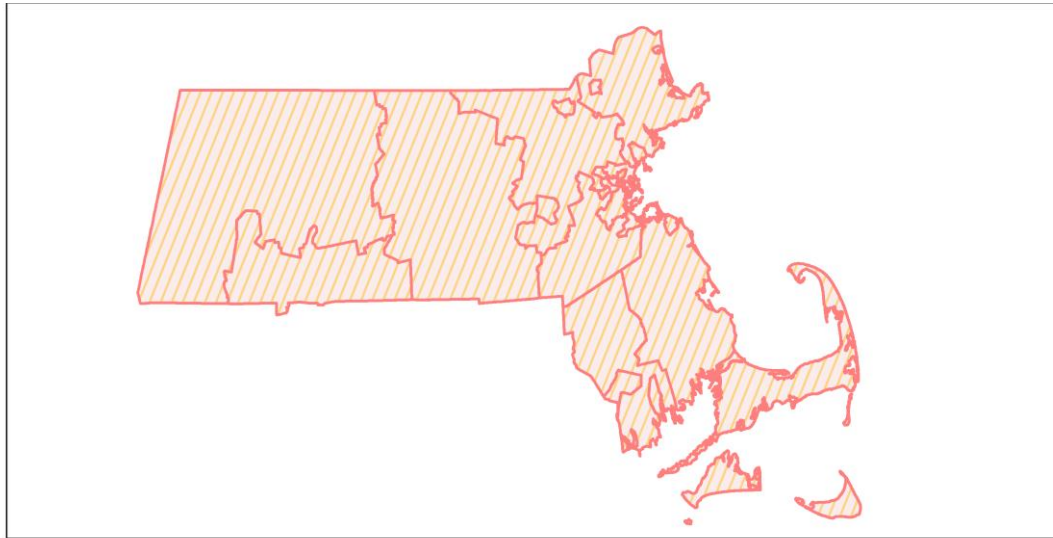
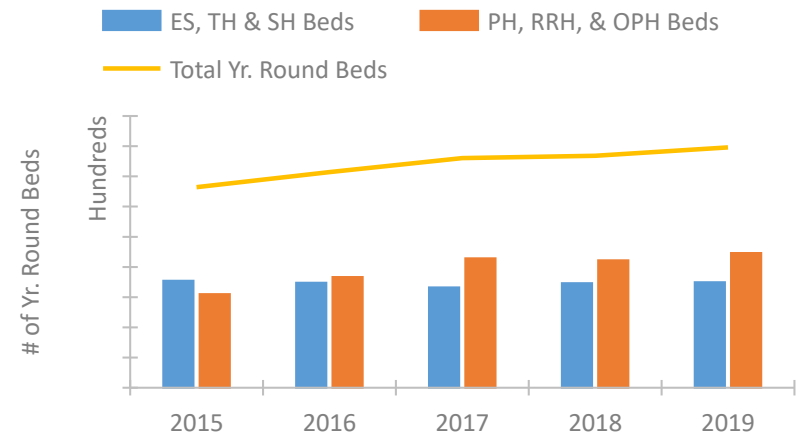


## Massachusetts Continuum of Care Performance Profile

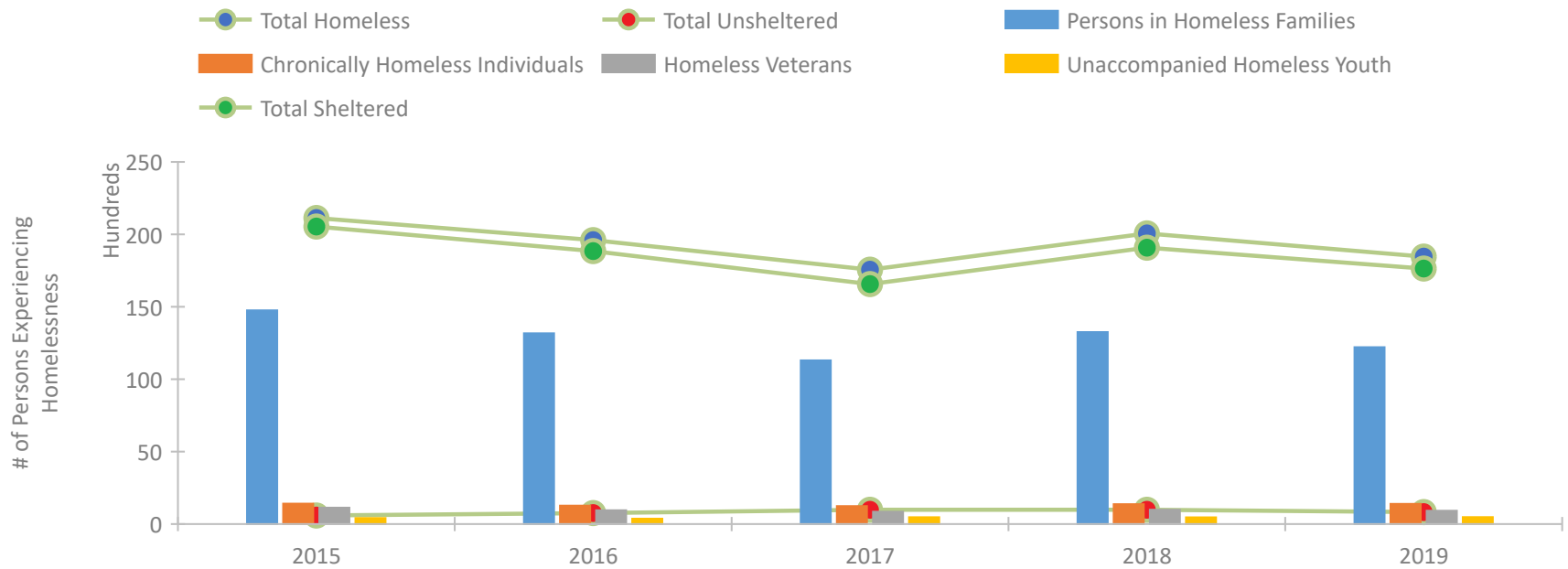


2019 CoC Boundaries 2018 CoC Boundaries

### Housing Inventory Count by Program Type

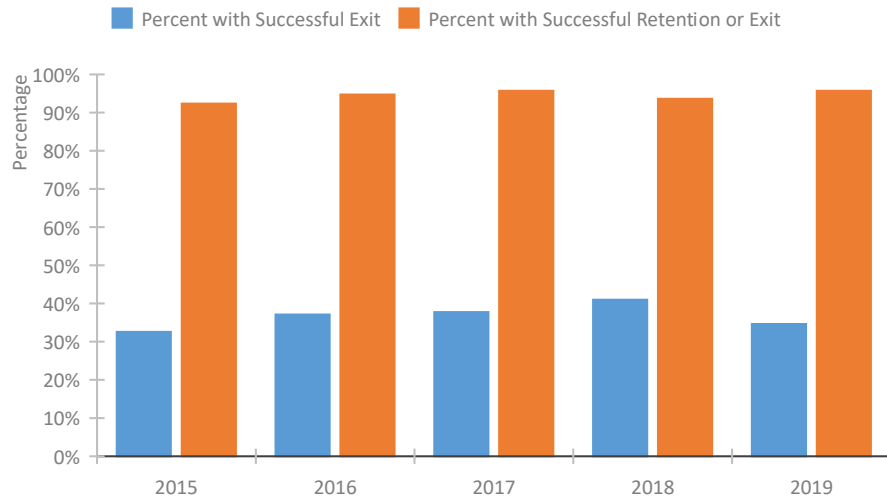


### Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count

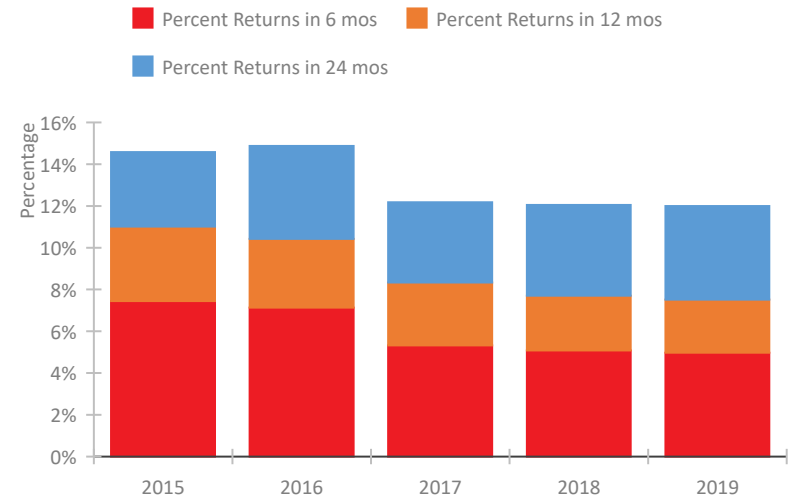

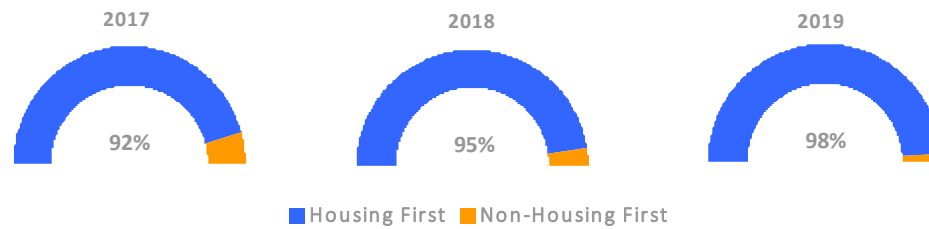
### Exits to Permanent Housing by Program Type
