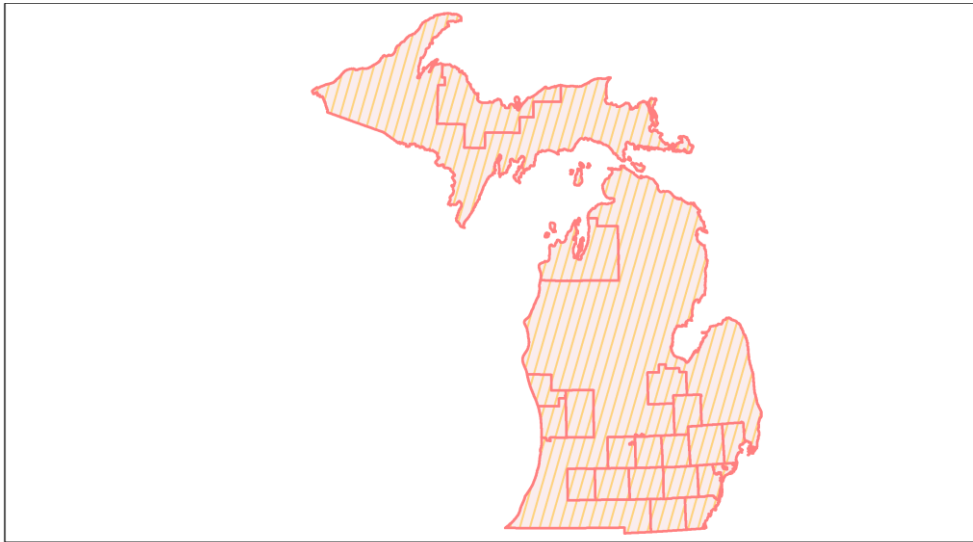
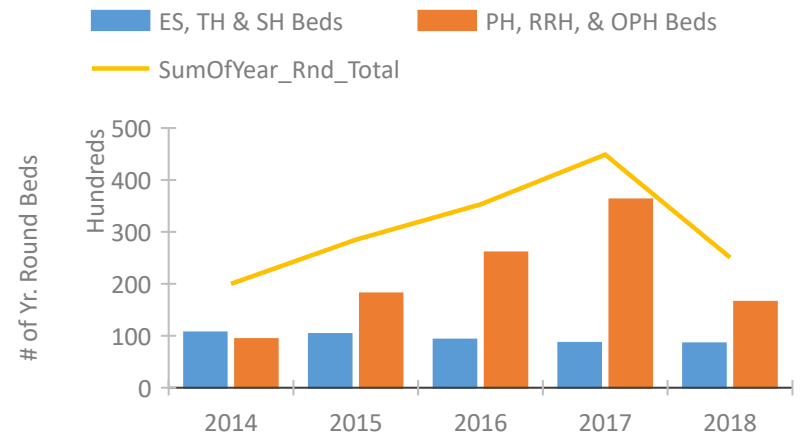

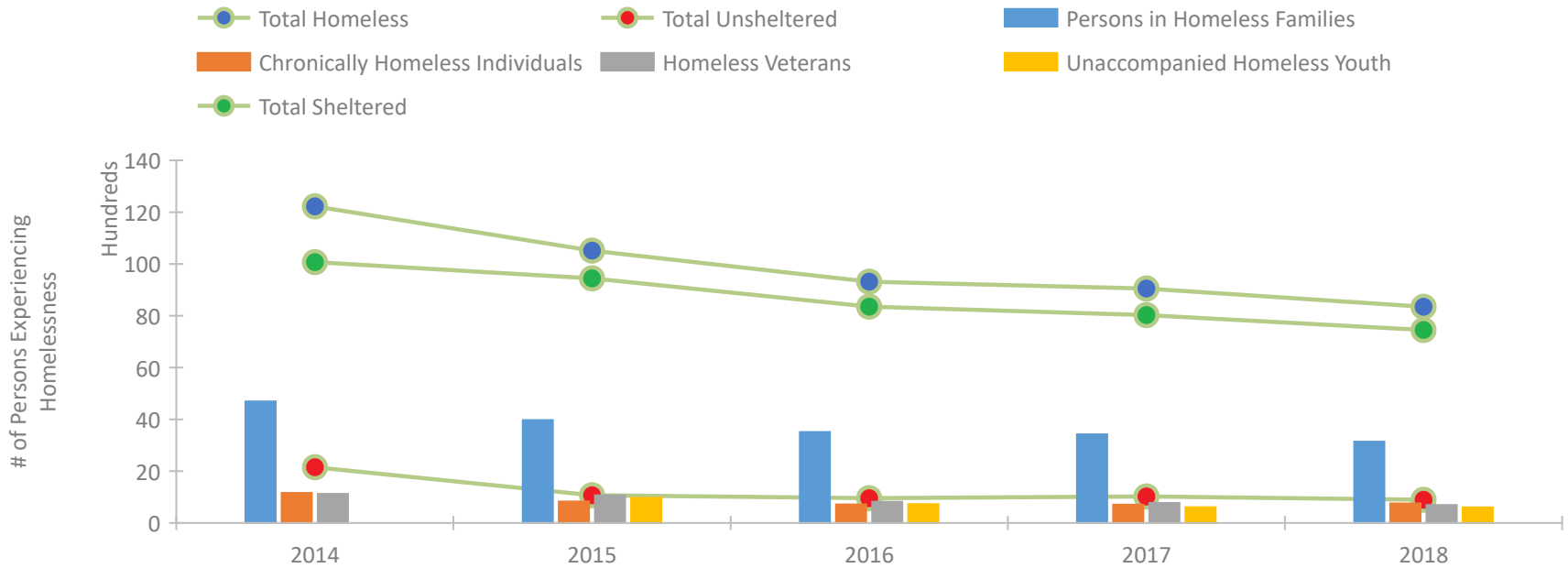


2018 CoC Boundaries 2017 CoC Boundaries

Housing Inventory Count by Program Type

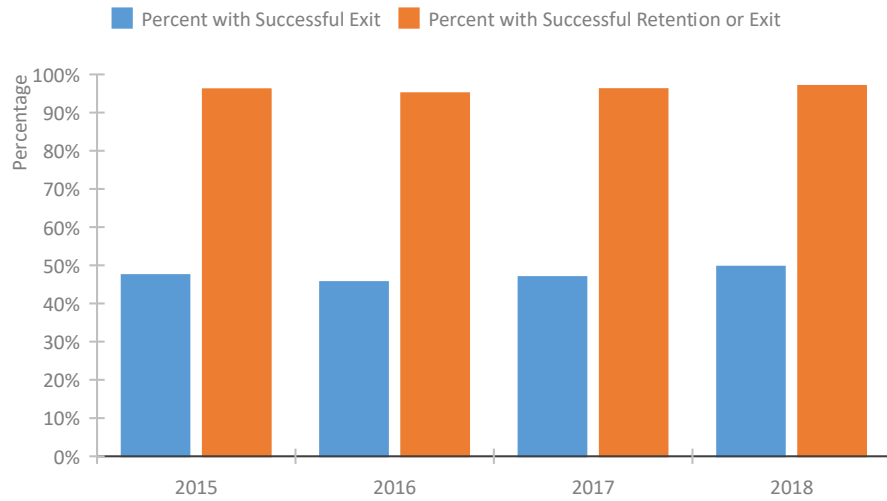


Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count

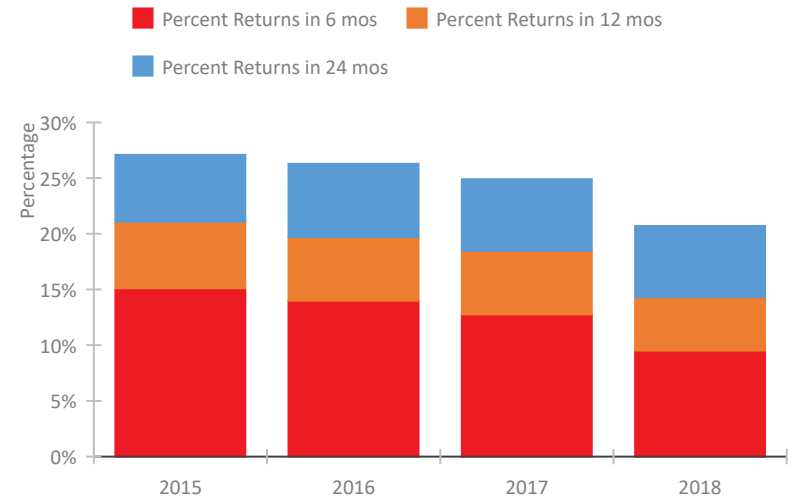

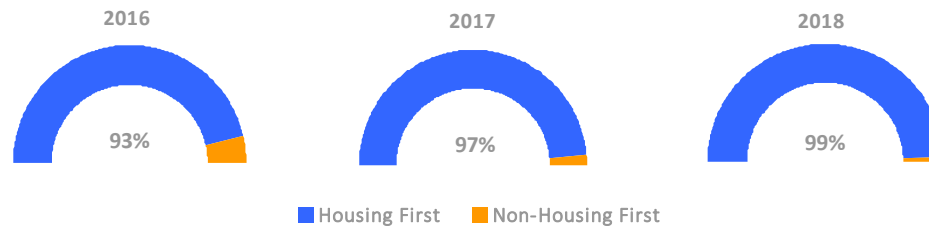
Exits to Permanent Housing by Program Type
