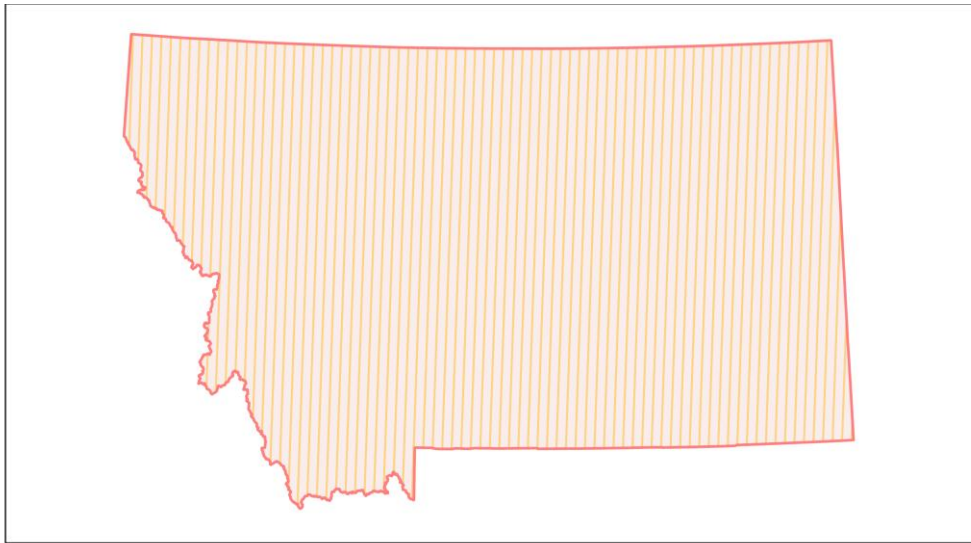
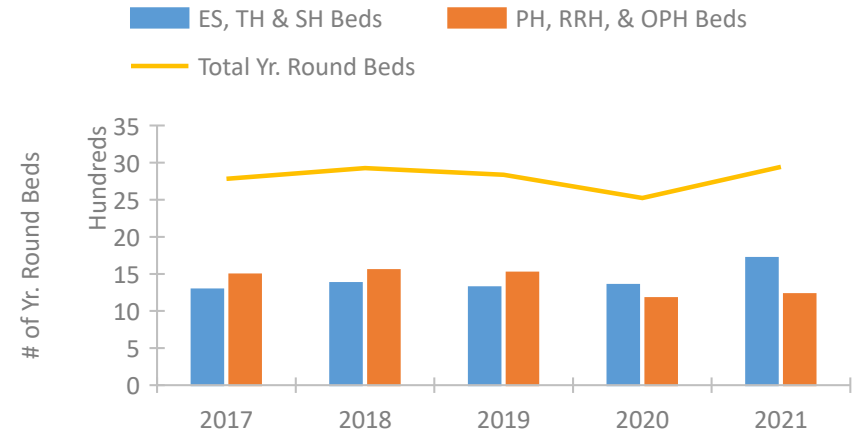

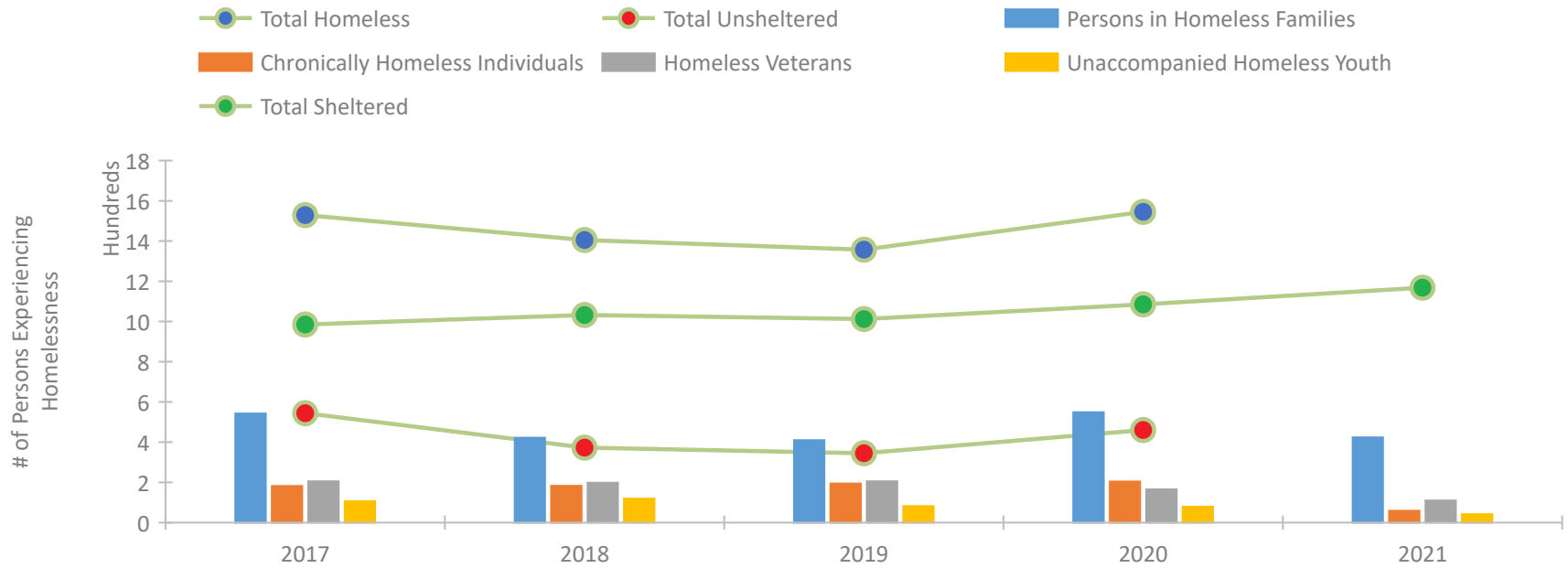


2021 CoC Boundaries 2020 CoC Boundaries

### Housing Inventory Count by Program Type



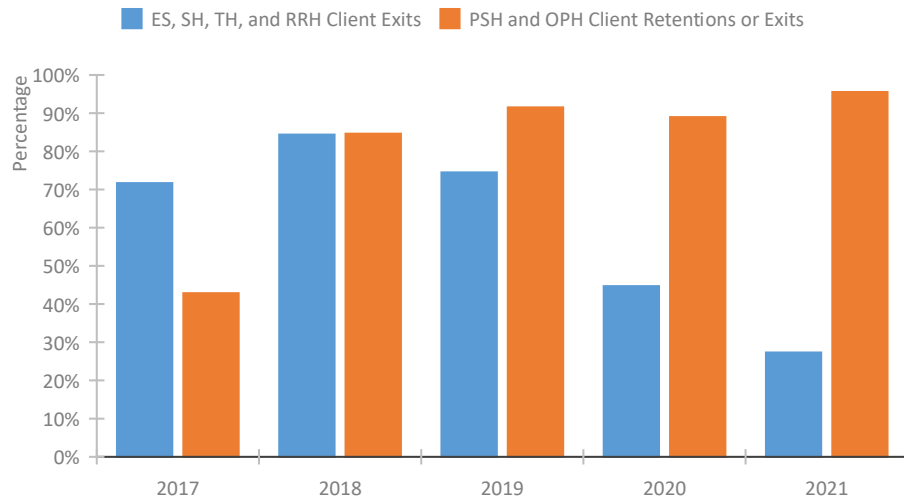
### Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count\*



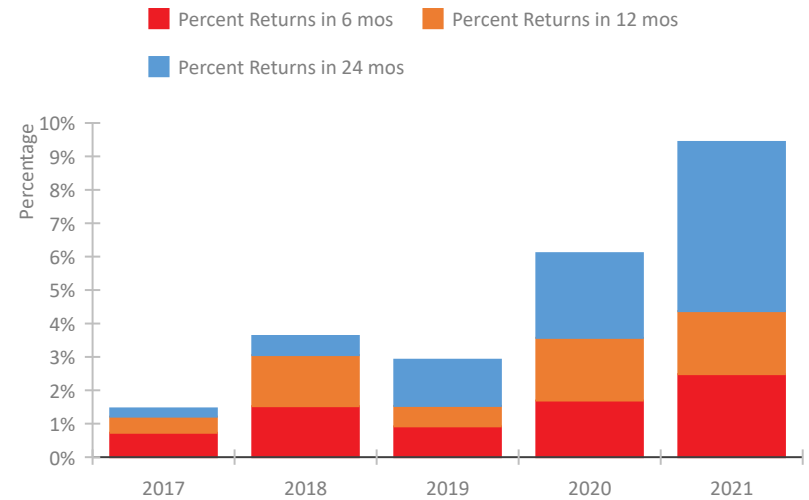

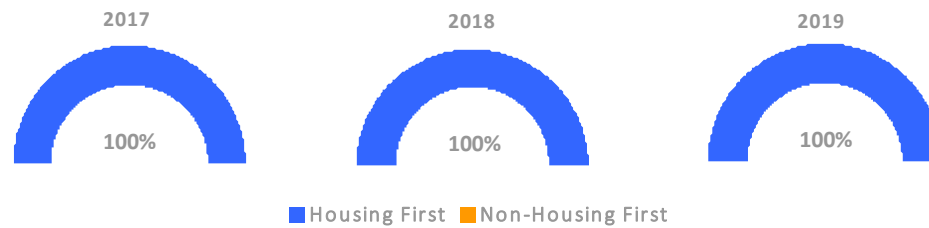
### Exits to Permanent Housing by Program Type
