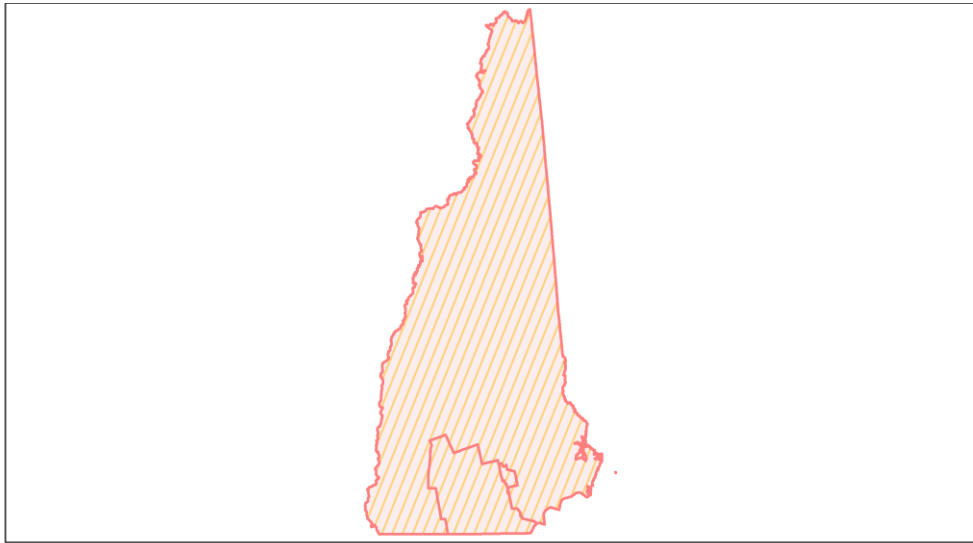
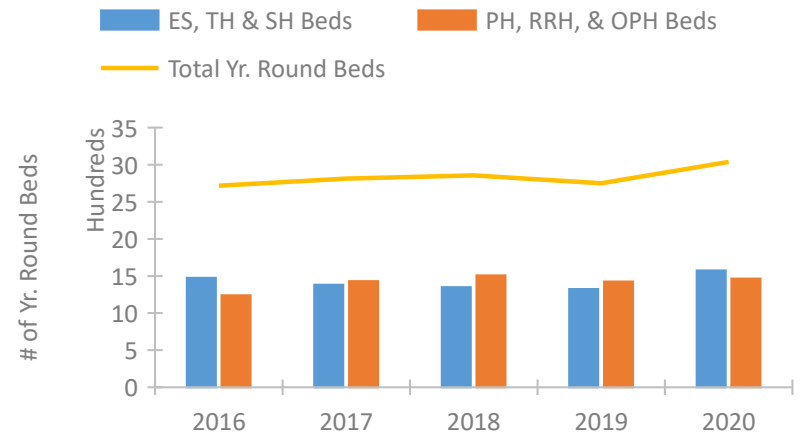


New Hampshire Continuum of Care Performance Profile

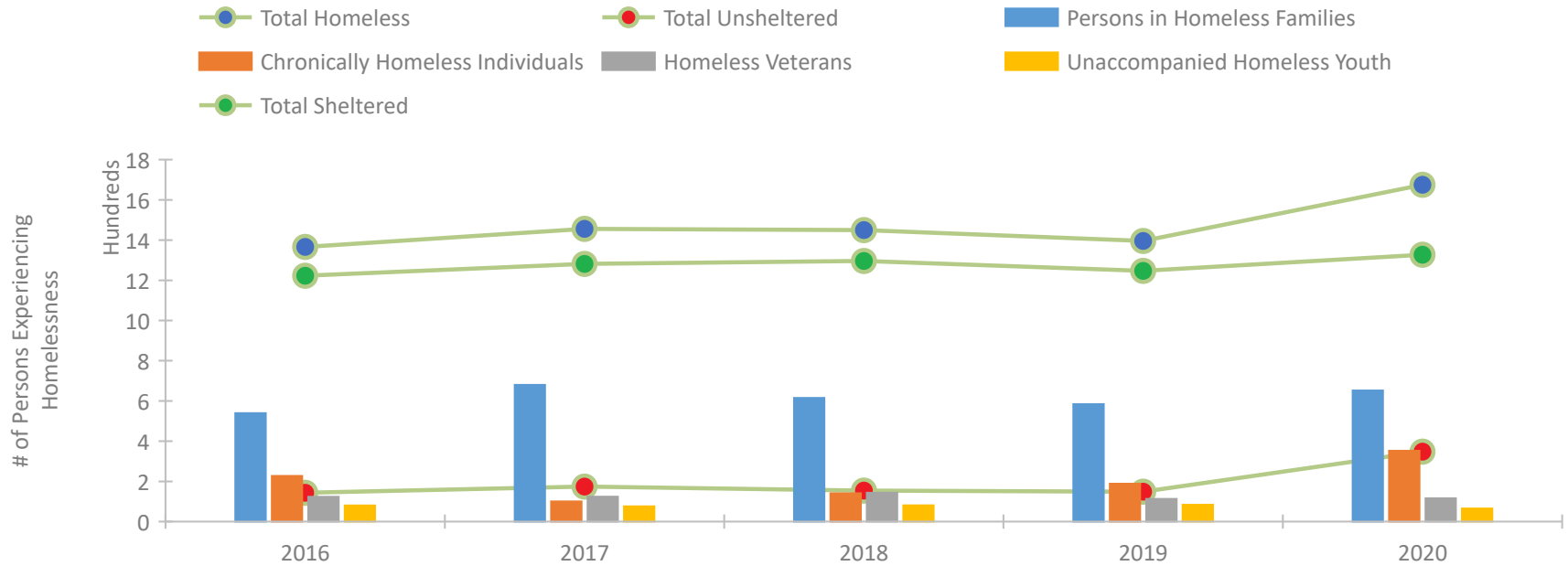


2020 CoC Boundaries 2019 CoC Boundaries

Housing Inventory Count by Program Type

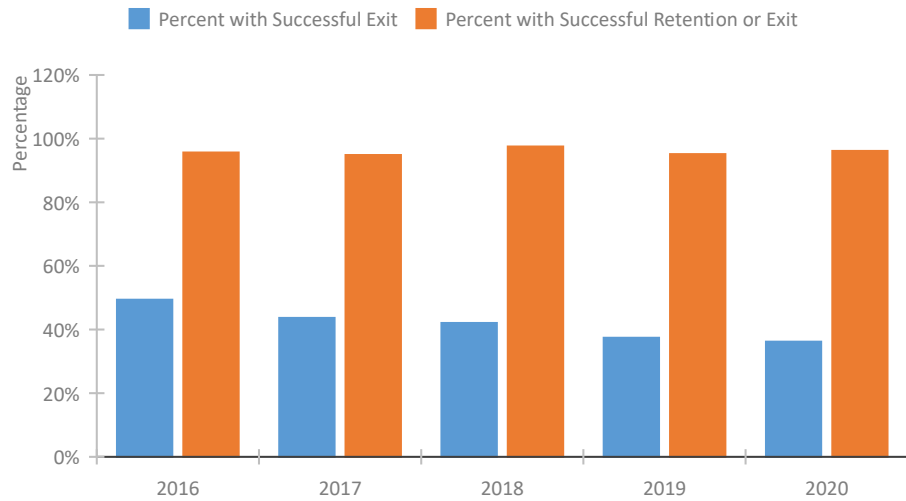


Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count

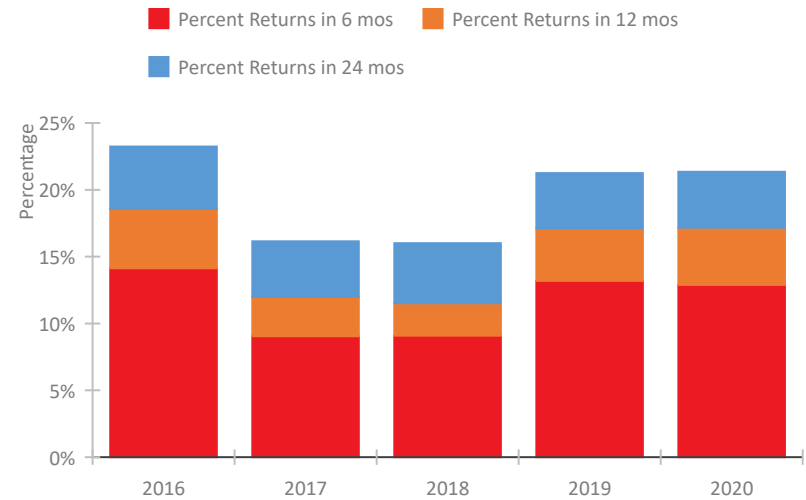

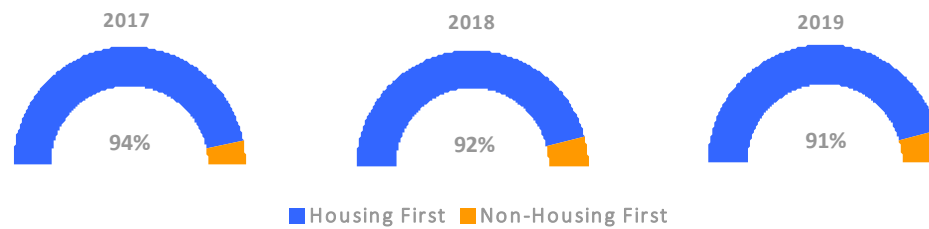
Exits to Permanent Housing by Program Type
