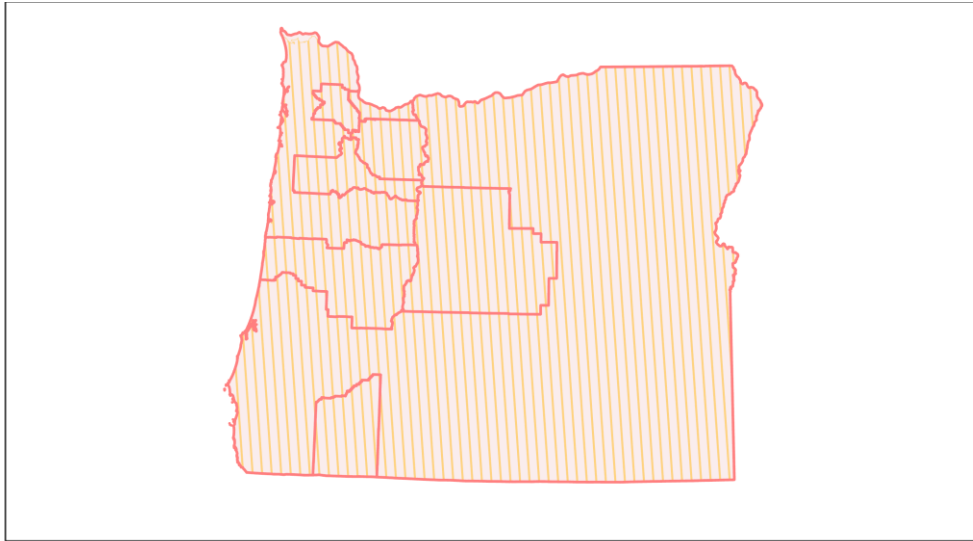
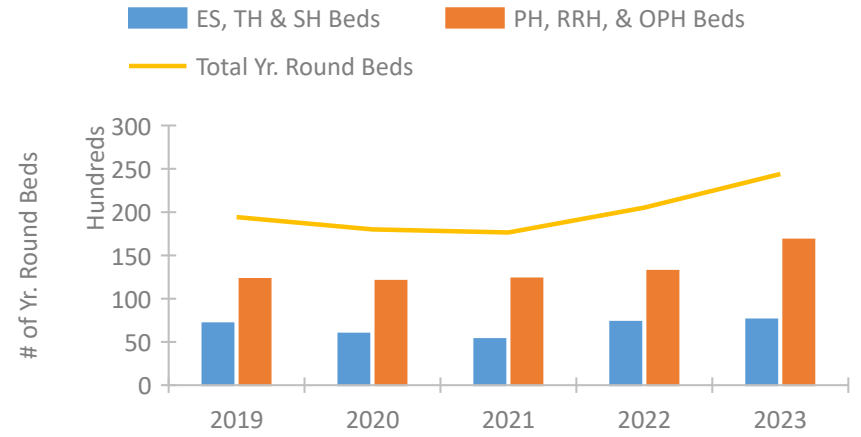

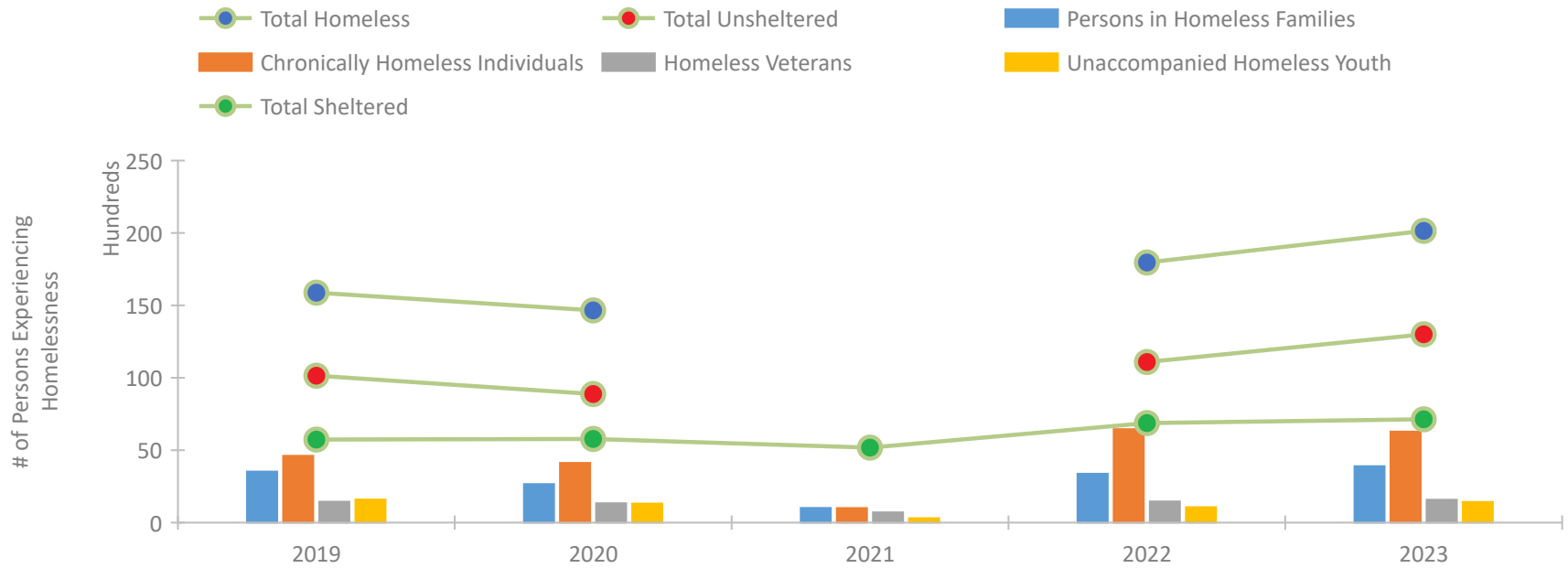


2023 CoC Boundaries 2022 CoC Boundaries

Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count*

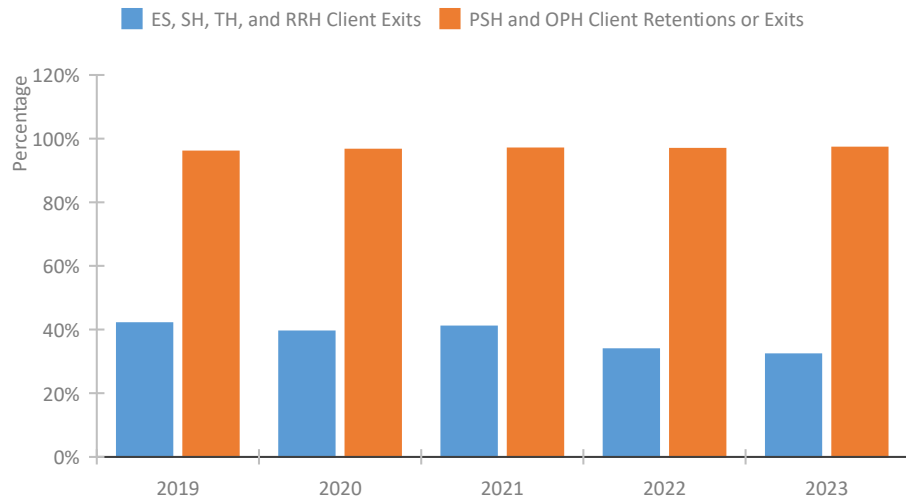

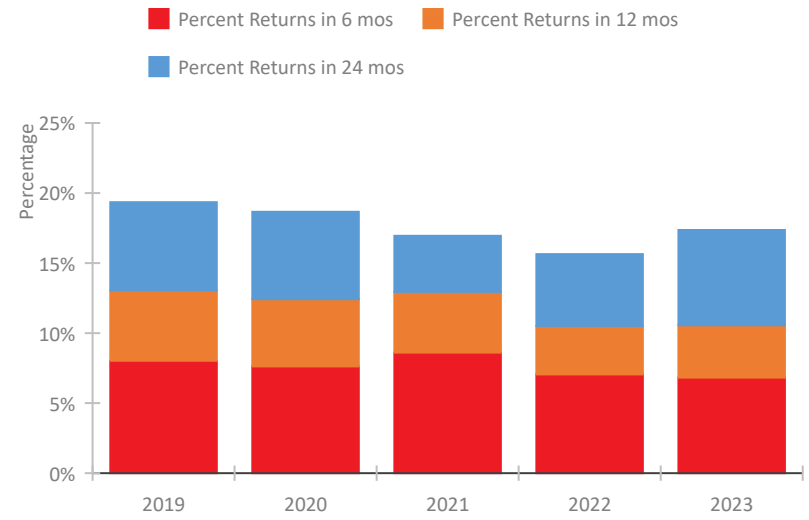
