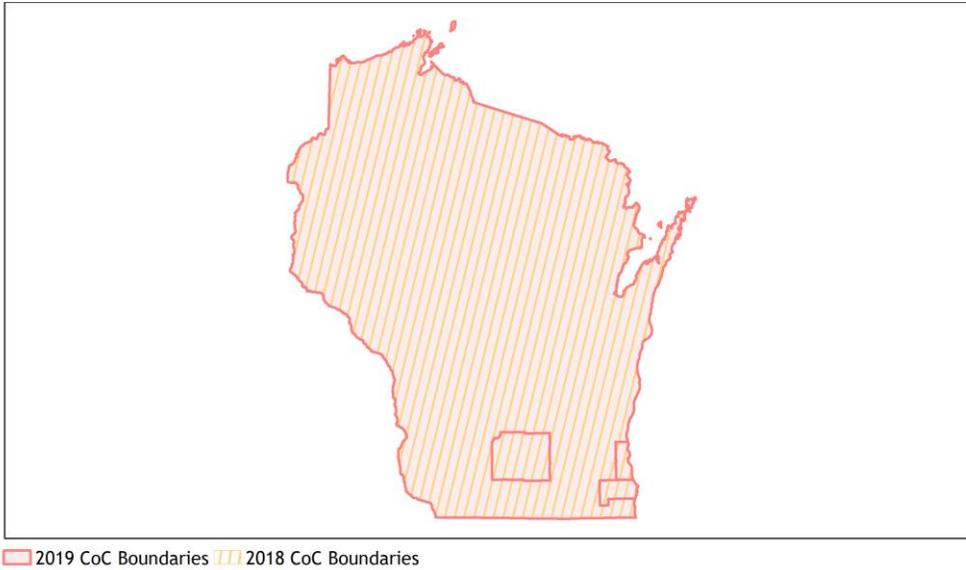
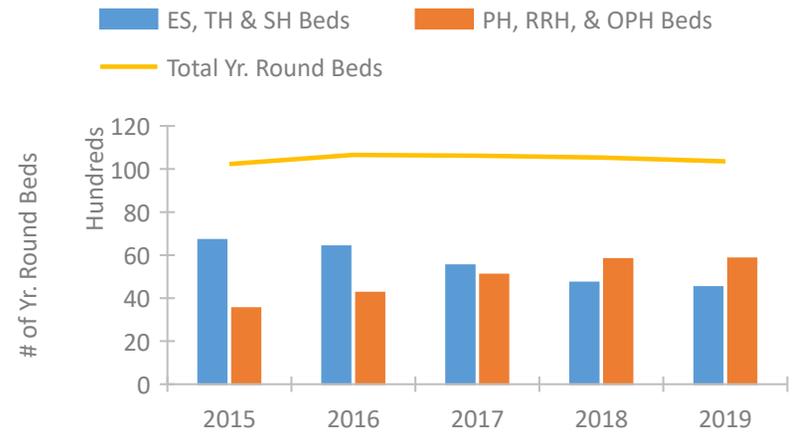


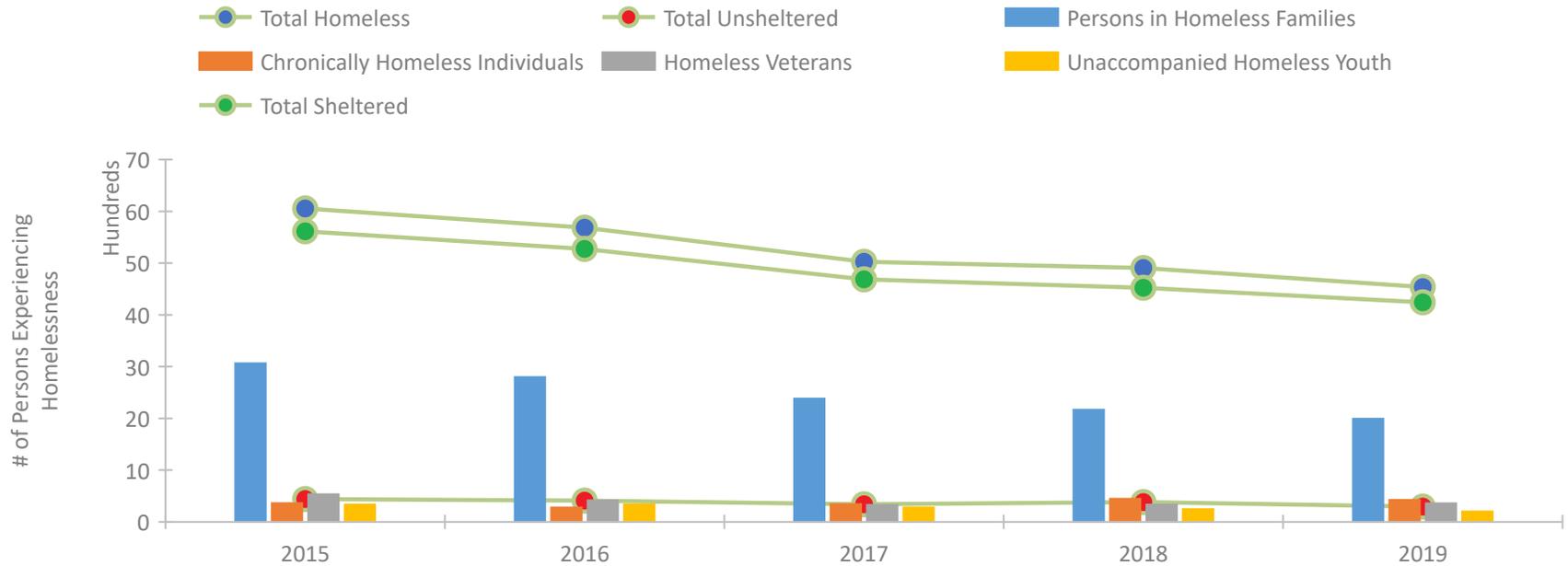
Wisconsin Continuum of Care Performance Profile



Housing Inventory Count by Program Type

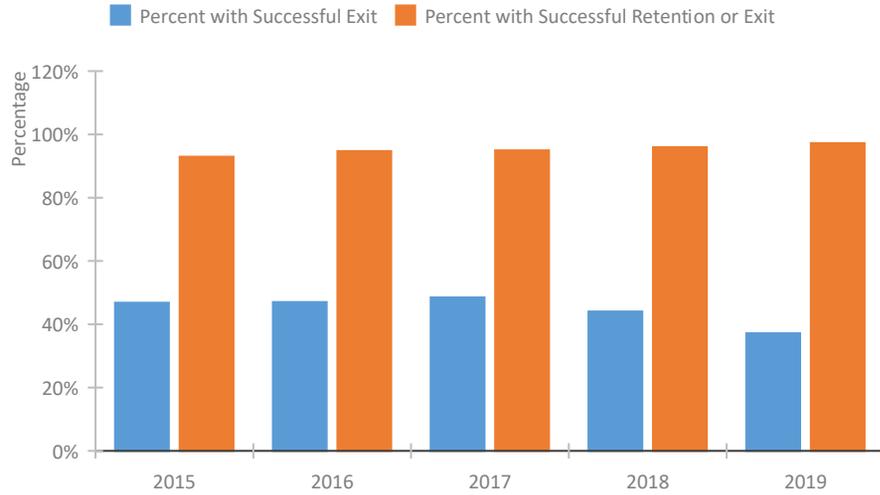


Homeless Population – Point-in-Time (PIT) Count

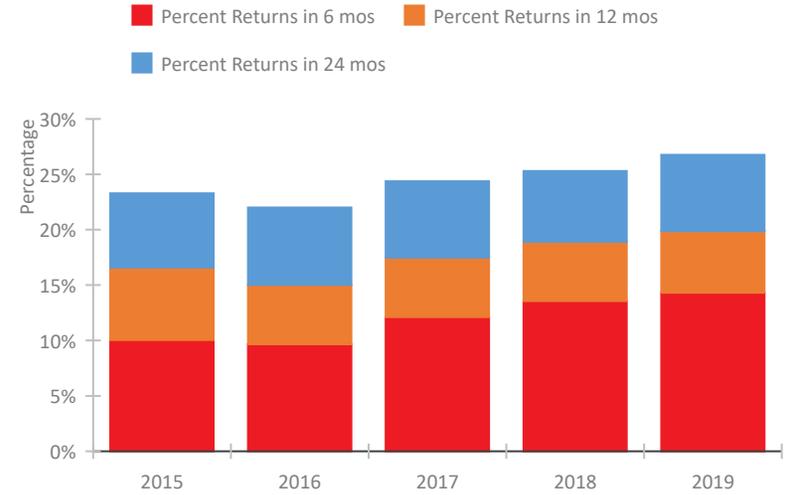

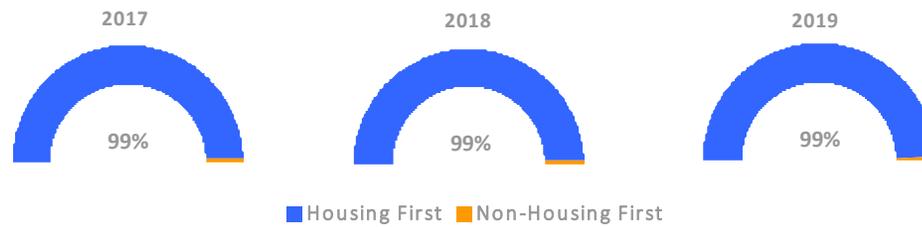
Exits to Permanent Housing by Program Type
