While there is significant overlap between the prior and the new data collected, data cannot be combined into a single year-end Profile Report.

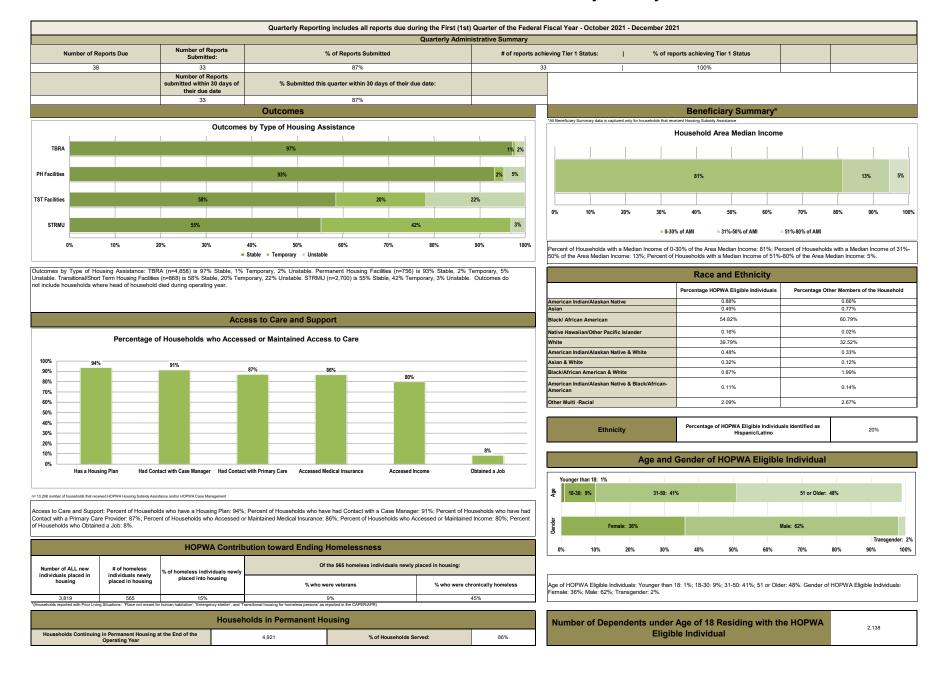
This National-level Report summarizes households served and expenditures by eligible HOPWA activities.

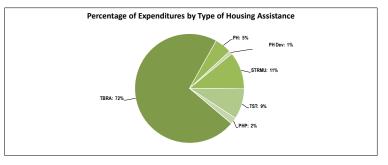

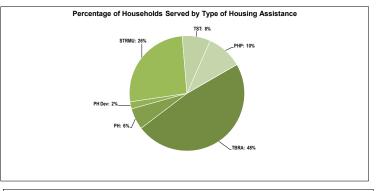

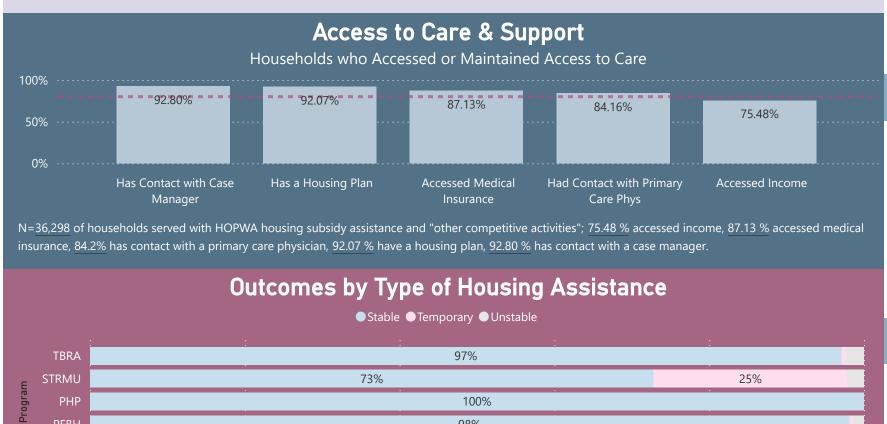

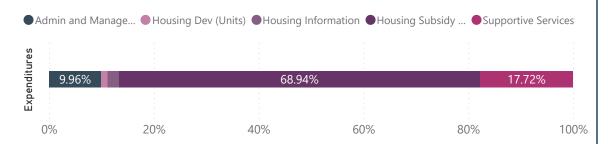

Overall Totals by Category for this Performance Period



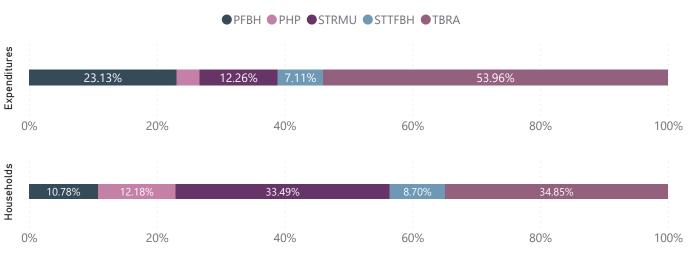
