Purchase of specific foreclosed properties will be dependent on highest degree of neighborhood need and availability of foreclosed, moderately priced properties. Note that all of the funds used for this activity will benefit moderate or middle-income housing requirements for those below the 120% of area median income. Definitions and Descriptions:

Low Income Targeting:

The areas of greatest need - the Elgin Historic District, the Northeast Neighborhood Association, the Southwest Area neighborhood and the Southeast neighborhood are areas with a predominance of low to moderate income demographics.

Acquisition and Relocation:

The City of Elgin has utilized NSP funds to purchase eleven properties. Five of the eleven properties will be rehabilitated by Habitat for Humanity of Fox Valley of which four are completed and one is in the process of being rehabilitated. The completed projects are:

355 Moseley Street 485 E Chicago Street 108-110 S. Channing Street 511 Washburn Street

The property in the process of being rehabilitated is: 315 Jewitt Street

Each of the above properties will be rehabilitated by Habitat for Humanity and offered for sale to low income homebuyers only, as part of the 25% of funds set aside to benefit low-income owners.
