Areas of Greatest Need:

To address Montgomery County's foreclose crisis and shortages of affordable housing. Priority emphasis for NSP funding must be directed to the areas of greatest need, including those with the greatest percentage of home foreclosures, those with the highest percentage of homes financed by a sub-prime mortgage related loan, those likely to face a significant rise in the rate of home foreclosures and those identified as meeting other need categories as determined by Montgomery County

Distribution and and Uses of Funds:

The funds will be use to purchase and rehabilitation of vacant, abandoned or foreclosed residential property. HUDs new Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) will provide emergency assistance to purchase foreclosed or abandoned homes and to rehabilitate, resell, or redevelop these homes in order to stabilize neighborhoods and stem the decline of house values of neighboring homes. The Department of Housing and Community Affairs will receive funding in the amount of \$2,073,965.00. All NSP activities will be limited to zip codes 20874 and 20906. Both are consistent with areas identified by HUD data as areas of greatest need

Definitions and Descriptions:

Clarification of definition of affordable rent: &ldquoRent will be considered affordable if it does not exceed 30% of the monthly adjusted household income and tenant paid utilities (based on an allowance schedule in use by HOC or otherwise approved by DHCA.&rdquo We anticipate acquiring a minimum of 7 rental properties, which will each house an average of 5 persons, for a minimum of 35 persons served. A minimum of 32 of these individuals will be at or below 50% AMI

Low Income Targeting:

A minimum of 90% of direct project NSP funds will be used to serve families at or below 50% of Area Median Income (AMI). The remaining 10% or less of direct project NSP funds will be used to serve families Specify amount of NSP budgeted to assist families at or below 120% AMI.

Acquisition and Relocation:

Montgomery County anticipates acquiring a minimum of 7 properties at an average acquisition/rehabilitation cost of \$250,000 per property. Obviously instability in the current housing sales market may provide additional acquisition opportunities. Montgomery County will begin NSP funded acquisitions when NSP funds are released or when our pending pre-award cost limit waiver is approved, whichever occurs first. We anticipate completing all initial acquisition activities within 18 months of that date
