Reviewer -

The City stated that it referenced the NSP funding sources twice for each of the activities. The City was stated initially in the activity budget and in the additional funding sources. As a result, the NSP funding amount was double counted. The City was requested to make the changes to clearify each activity in DRGR during the NSP training.

The City also Made change to one activity titles (only one has been made) from DC Habitat Ivy City Demonstration to Reconstruction ¿ DC Habitat Ivy City Demonstration.

Additionally, the City indicated that the proposed changes did not make any changes to NSP funding amounts, private amounts, accomplishments, national objectives or beneficiaries.
