On a first-come, first-serve basis, eligible low-income home buyers participating in this NSP activity will be able to receive up to \$31,000 in down payment assistance. This amount will be distributed as follows: up to \$3,000 for assistance with the closing costs and/or prepaid expenses to purchase an NSP eligible single family home they will occupy as their primary residence, up to \$8,000 to be applied to the required down payment, and up to \$20,000 in mortgage principal subsidy. \$24,489 in funding is allocated under this activity to provide mandatory housing counseling services to those individuals receiving assistance through the Low-Income Down Payment Assistance Program and the Moderate/Middle Income Down Payment Assistance Program. The Housing Counseling Assistance Program identified in Waterfords NSP is not a separate program to assist 100 low/moderate/middle-income households, but rather the housing counseling assistance required to be provided to the 20 low-income households to be assisted through the Low-Income Down Payment Assistance Program and to the 80 moderate/middle-income households to be assisted through the Moderate/Middle-Income Down Payment Assistance Program. This direct association between the down payment assistance programs and the housing counseling assistance will be documented by the Township to ensure conformance with HUD regulations.
