### **Overall Progress Narrative:**

The City of Chicago has not drawn down NSP2 funds during the first quarter, however we have begun to survey eligible census tracts to identify available properties. Several tasks essential to implementing our program are already in place as much of our infrastructure designed for NSP1 will be utilized under NSP2. This infrastructure includes an expedited process with the Department of Environment for environmental reviews and an expedited permit system with the Department of Buildings. We are also planning to introduce a City Council ordinance to provide permit fee waivers for NSP homes.

Additionally, the Department of Community Development (DCD) and its subrecipient, Mercy Portfolio Services (MPS), have established relationships with financial partners and qualified developers. This infrastructure will enable us to begin acquiring properties in the second quarter of 2010. DCD also plans to execute its NSP2 subrecipient agreement with MPS in the second quarter of 2010.
