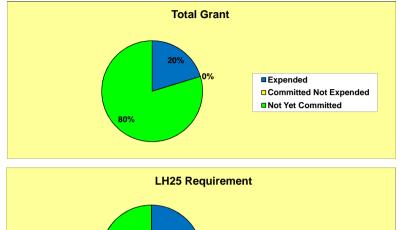

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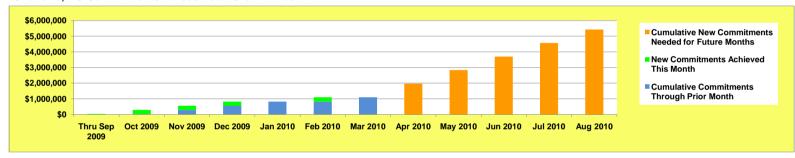


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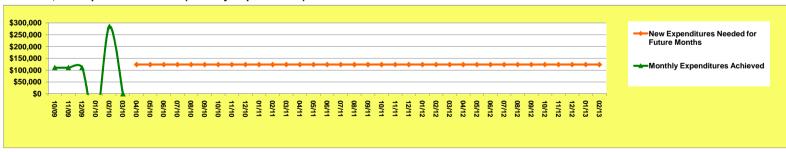
## Charlotte, NC Commitments Trend (Cumulative Commitments)

## Charlotte, NC Expenditures Trend (Monthly Expenditures)

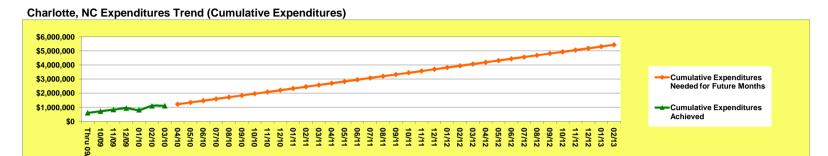

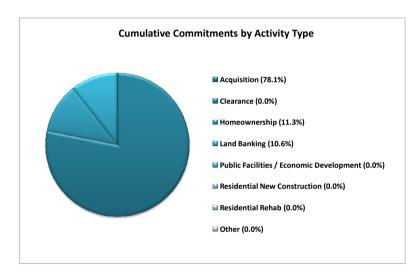

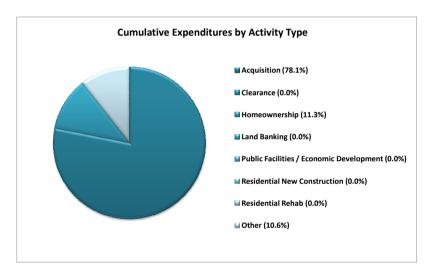
