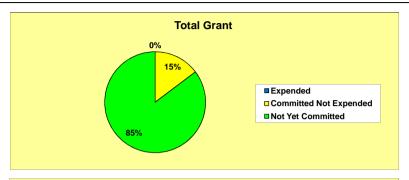

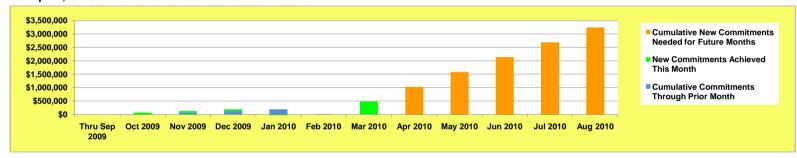

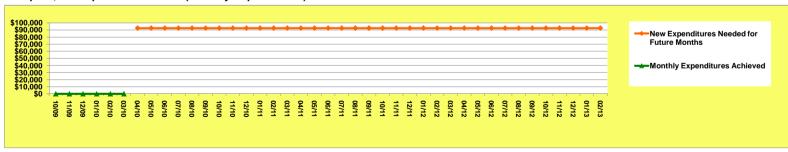




Compton, CA Commitments Versus Total Grant Amount



Compton, CA Expenditures Trend (Monthly Expenditures)

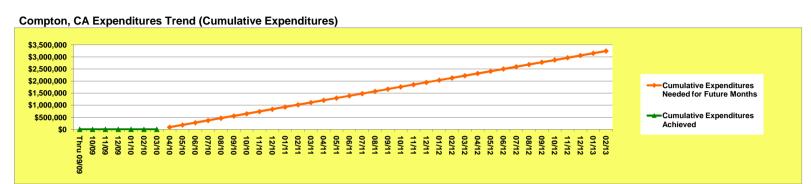

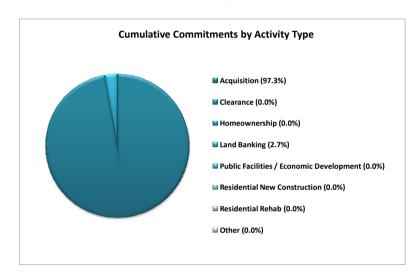
