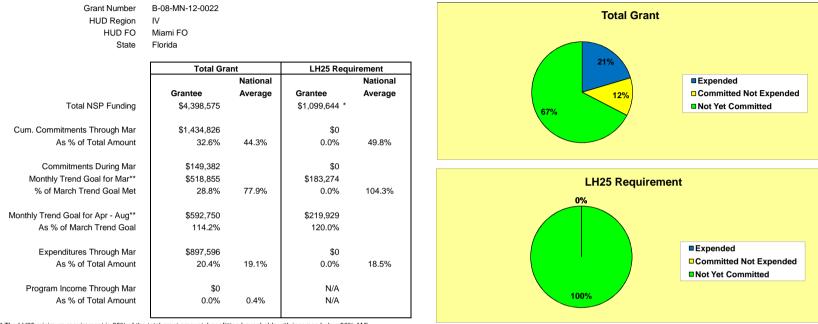

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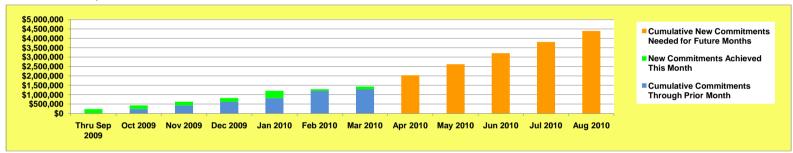

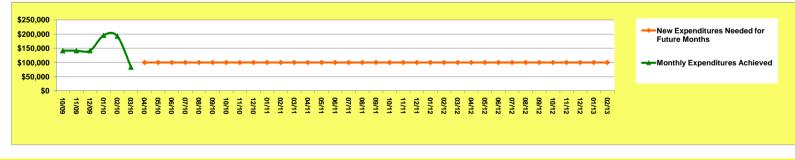




Pembroke Pines, FL Commitments Versus Total Grant Amount







Pembroke Pines, FL expended \$83,725 during March and needs to average \$100,028 per month for April 2010 through February 2013



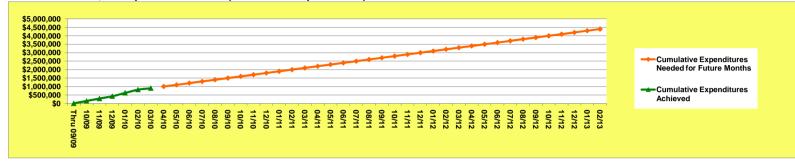

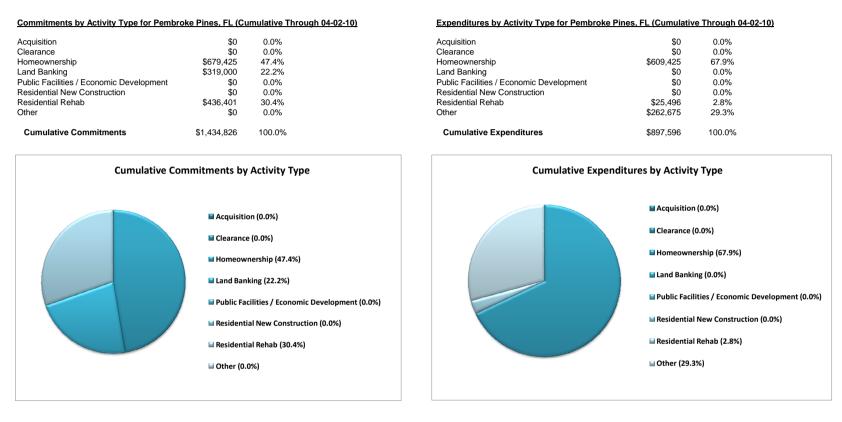
