

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

Steps from Selection to Implementation

- Complete & Execute the MTW ACC Amendment
- Prepare your Agency's MTW Finances
- Conduct Public Process and Complete Development of The MTW Supplement
- Submit the MTW Supplement to the PHA Plan
- Transfer PIC 50058 data to IMS/PIC Modernization
- Coordinate with PD&R and Evaluation Team
 - Receive Approval of MTW Supplement from HUD FO


1. Complete and Execute The MTW ACC Amendment

- Sets terms of participation and details requirements and covenants to be followed
- Must be signed and executed by PHA and HUD before using funds flexibly
- Email signed PDF MTW ACC Amendment to: mtwlandlordincentives@hud.gov

MTW ACC Amendment Section 5, Requirements & Covenants

MTW Agencies:

- Must operate in accordance with MTW Operations Notice
- Must cooperate with HUD and contractors for HUD-sponsored evaluation of cohort-specific study
- Can only be exempted from provisions of the Housing Act of 1937 as specified in MTW Operations Notice



MTW ACC Amendment Section 6, Transition Plan

- Submit plan at least one year prior to MTW ACC Amendment expiration (Year 19)
- Transition plan will:
 - Describe plans for phasing out MTW activities
 - Specify proposed duration
 - Provide justification for extensions
- HUD reviews and responds within 75 days, or it is deemed approved
- Added based on public feedback




MTW ACC Amendment Section 7, Termination & Default

- If the PHA violates the ACC, this Amendment, or by extension the Operations Notice
- · HUD may undertake one or all remedies available by law, including but not limited to:
 - i. Require additional reporting on deficient areas and steps being taken to address deficiencies
 - ii. Require PHA to prepare and follow a HUD-approved schedule of actions and/or management plan for properly completing approved activities
 - iii. Suspend MTW waiver authorization for affected activities
 - iv. Require reimbursement by PHA for amounts used in violation of MTW ACC Amendment
 - v. Terminate MTW ACC Amendment and require PHA to transition out of MTW
 - vi. Restrict PHA's ability to use MTW funding flexibly
 - vii. Take other corrective or remedial action legally available



MTW ACC Amendment Sections 8 & 9, Future Laws




 Future laws that conflict with any provision of MTW ACC Amendment supersede it



• Any invalid clause, or portion of a clause, shall be stricken, while remainder of Agreement continues to be in full effect

3. Conduct Public Process and Complete Development of the MTW Supplement

- The MTW Supplement
 - Informs HUD, residents, community about planned MTW activities
- The Public Process
 - Up to two required public meetings
 - Receive feedback regarding potential MTW Activities to be implemented
 - Potential modification based on public's feedback

Hold public hearing(s) regarding the Supplement

Discuss potential MTW activities with program participants

Gather public feedback

Finalize PHA's program

4. Submit the MTW Supplement

- Electronically submit & receive HUD approval (via letter from field office) prior to implementing MTW activities
- Continue to submit Annual PHA Plan, along with MTW Supplement as addendum

5. Transitioning 50058 Data – IMS/PIC Modernization

- MTW agencies must:
 - Report using HUD-50058 MTW Expansion in new IMS/PIC Modernization system for those households that MTW flexibilities are being applied to (will continue to use the HUD-50058 for other households)
 - Migrate tenant and public housing building and unit data to IMS/PIC Modernization




6. Coordinate with PD&R and Evaluation Team

- Attend meetings with the Office of Policy Development and Research (PD&R) and evaluator
- Set up research, in coordination with PD&R, on MTW activities

Reflecting on Change



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


Change Management Basics

What is Change Management? Change Management captures all the components of preparing for, implementing, and sustaining change.

4. Regularly evaluate progress and adjust support as necessary

3. Enable and reinforce change



1. Distinguish change from transition, clarify rationale for change, and build buy-in from those affected by change

2. Identify resistance to and advocates for change (Sponsors and Champions), and create communication plans

Tools To Support Change Management

Case for Change

- What are the most notable MTW-related changes we anticipate?
- What organizational changes are needed to support each MTW impact? Why?
- How will these changes affect staff, residents, and other stakeholders differently?
- Where might we encounter the most resistance to change?

Introspective Questions Tool

Plan for Change

- Who will be most impacted by each MTWrelated change?
- How should we prioritize each facet of change required?
- Who needs to be engaged from the onset to make the changes successful?
- How can we ensure that staff, residents, and other stakeholders fully understand upcoming MTW-related changes?

Mapping Key Players Tool Strategic Communications Plan

Tools To Support Change Management

Implement Change

- Who could serve as change champions?
- What strategies will we use to communicate changes to each group impacted by them?
- How should our messaging and timing differ by group?
- How will staff be supported as they roll out the new MTW-related changes?
- What is our plan to address individual questions and concerns regarding the changes?

Sequencing Key Persons Template

Active Listening and Feedback Tips

Sustain Change

- How will we monitor progress in changes? What metrics will be captured?
- How will we set up feedback loops?
- How will we respond when we find it challenging to get buy-in on certain changes?
- How will we address resistance from various stakeholders (e.g., staff, residents, other agencies, advocates, landlords, etc.)
