

AHAR Error Guide

To assist CoCs and improve the quality of data submitted for AHAR, the HDX contains many data quality validations which look for inconsistencies and uncommon or suspicious data.

This document describes the subset of these checks which are classified as validation *errors*. Errors, as opposed to *warnings*, are things which should be impossible. For instance, if you reported an unduplicated total of 20 people served in ES-IND, then you cannot report 21 adult males in ES-IND. Most (but not all) of the validation errors in the HDX are extensions of this basic principle; they check to make sure you have not reported more people than we would expect in a given question.

Most errors apply to both the All Persons and Veterans reports and may be triggered in either. Others, however, are specific to one or the other. The column "All Persons and/or Veterans " in the Error List identifies whether a given error applies to the All Persons report, the Veterans report, or both.

A series of columns in the Error List identify the question numbers associated with each validation error. In many cases, the question number (and the responses within it) depend on the reporting category (e.g., ES-FAM) as well as the report type (All Persons or Veterans).
