Testing

- Regression Test FY 2014 Submissions in ARM4. Just like the Pilot environment, in PROD all 2014 submissions using ARM4 will go to the current ARM URL. All 2015 submissions will go to ARM5 which will have its own URL.
- Begin testing Agency and Counselor submissions in ARM5.
- It is expected that CMS will be ready for the 10/01/2014 deadline for entry of the new required 9902 and client data and that submission testing will continue after 10/01/2014 in preparation for the first quarter 2015 submissions beginning 01/01/2015.
