### **DRGR** Modules



#### Admin

Assign and certify users; add and track Technical Assistance (TA) and Monitoring Events



#### Action Plans Identify activities to be funded by organization, activity type, and project.



#### Drawdowns

Obligate funds for draws; create, approve, edit vouchers; receipt program income



#### QPRs

Summarize drawdowns, expenditures, obligations, and achievements for the guarter



#### Reports

Look at financial, reporting, and user account information in an easy-to-read and exportable format

### Grant Level: Adding an Action Plan -'Overall Narrative' data

- Narrative information at the <u>grant level</u> directly corresponds to the hard copy action plan
- Example of CDBG-DR sections:
  - Disaster Damages
  - Recovery Needs
  - Distribution and Use of Funds

*Text should only be copied into DRGR using NOTEPAD or .txt file.*

# Grant Level: Estimate Program Income (PI) for grant

Project and Activity Budgets include PI so the Estimated PI/Revolving Loan Fund at the grant level must have enough \$ to accommodate these increased amounts.

Estimated PI may be updated periodically as grantee re-estimates the program income to be received.



### Project Level: Adding 'Projects'

DRGR is a two-tier hierarchy system:

'Projects' vs. 'Activities'

'Projects' are usually listed by major 'Activity Type' categories listed in the published plan:

-Housing

-Economic Development

-Infrastructure/Public Facilities

-Administration

–Planning

Some state grantees define 'projects' by their Method of Distribution categories

Projects as fund "tranches" – based on each action plan submission and subsequent amendments

### <u>Reporting Grantee Oversight Activities –</u> <u>Preventing Fraud, Waste, and Abuse</u>

Purpose:

-Helps grantees keep track of their oversight activities

- Document monitoring, audit, and technical assistance activities
- Record findings, concerns

–Keeps HUD informed of grantee monitoring and technical assistance actions *Required for CDBG-DR grantees* 

Monitoring/Audit/TA Flow Chart

Two Basic Levels:

- 1. Events (4 different types of Events to chose from)
- 2. Findings, Concerns and/or Topics
