Changes to HUD User Interface for HCS V14.17.0.0

An update to HCS is planned for release on February 26, 2019 and includes the following user interface changes:

- Agency Profile Agency Summary 9902 Reporting Status:
 - Display NOT REPORTED instead of N/A if an agency has not reported a 9902.
 - Change the date used to determine if a 9902 report has been submitted on-time from the last updated date to the original submission date.
- Submission History Display error message for failed submissions.
- Agency Profile HUD Affiliation Update to interface to allow entry of multiple state and zip code affiliations.
- Grant Budget Allocation Display calculated client projections based on budget, grant, and previous 9902 reporting.
- CMS List Update CMS list to no longer display CMS that are in-progress, but have been inactive.

Note: data displayed in screens is for example purposes only and does not reflect actual data

Agency Profile – Agency Summary – HUD-9902 Submission Summary – 9902 Reporting Status

- The HUD-9902 Submission Summary will display NOT REPORTED instead of N/A if:
 - ✓ the current date is after the due date for a fiscal year and Qtr 9902 reporting period, and
 - ✓ an agency has not reported a 9902 for that fiscal year and Qtr.



Example:

The agency has not reported a 2018 Qtr 4 9902 report. Since the current date is after the due date for FY 2018 Qtr 4, **Not Reported** displays as the submission status.

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Agency Profile – Agency Summary – HUD-9902 Submission Summary – 9902 Reporting Status

- A HUD 9902 Submission will be identified as on-time or late using the original submission date, instead of the last updated date.
- If an agency originally submits the 9902 report before the due date for that FY and Qtr, but then updates the 9902 after the due date, the 9902 will continue to show as ontime.
- A HUD 9902 Submission will only be considered late if the original submission date was after the due date.

Example:







A smaller window will display that provides the submission information and the specific error message for that submission.



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
Update to interface to allow entry of multiple state and zip code affiliations.

- HUD POCs can add multiple affiliated zip codes and states for those agencies that service multiple localities.

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


Example: Remove Affiliated Zip Codes




Example: Remove All Affiliated States


- Click the Clear State Selection button.

- 2. Click the **OK** button at the bottom of the screen.



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

Example: Remove Individual States


- 1. While holding down the CTRL key on your keyboard, select the desired state from the select list to remove. As a state is de-selected, it will be removed from the state list.

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Grant Budget Allocation – Display calculated client projections based on budget, grant, and previous 9902 reporting

- Calculated Projections have been added to the Grant Award Agency Budget Allocation screen
- Calculated Projections are based on the agency's budget information, grant award amount, and previous year's 9902 reporting.
- Calculated Projections are provided as a guide for determining how many counseling activities the agency may be able to conduct with the HUD grant.



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Grant Budget Allocation – Display calculated client projections based on budget, grant, and previous 9902 reporting

Grant vs Budget Ratio: Uses the grant ratio* and the previous year's 4th quarter 9902 total to identify a projected number of clients.


Example:

In this example the **Grant vs Budget** Ratio is **10,996** clients. The grant ratio is 23%. The total counseling activities reported in the previous year's 4th gtr 9902 is **47.807**.

47,807 X .23 = 10,995.61 (rounded up = 10,996)

* The grant ratio is the grant award amount of the agency's total budget. (Award amount/Agency **Budget)**

1,952,955.00/8,448,156.00 = .2311 (rounded down to .23).




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Grant Budget Allocation – Display calculated client projections based on budget, grant, and previous 9902 reportinga

 Cost Per Client: Identifies the cost per client based on the previous year's total budget and 4th quarter 9902 total to identify how many counseling activities can be conducted

with the award amount.





Example:

In this example the Cost per Client projection is **8,703** clients. The cost per client for the previous fiscal year is the total budget divided by the total households served (**10,727,435** / **47,807** = **224.39**)
The grant award (**1,952,955.00**) is then divided by the previous year's cost per client (**224.39**):

1,952,955.00/224.39 = 8703.39 (rounded down to **8703**)


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Grant Budget Allocation – Display calculated client projections based on budget, grant, and previous 9902 reporting

Application Projection: If a projection is requested on the grant application, that
projection amount will display as the Application projection. N/A will display if there is
no Application Projection.

Note:

N/A will display for a projection if any value needed to calculate a projection is not available.
