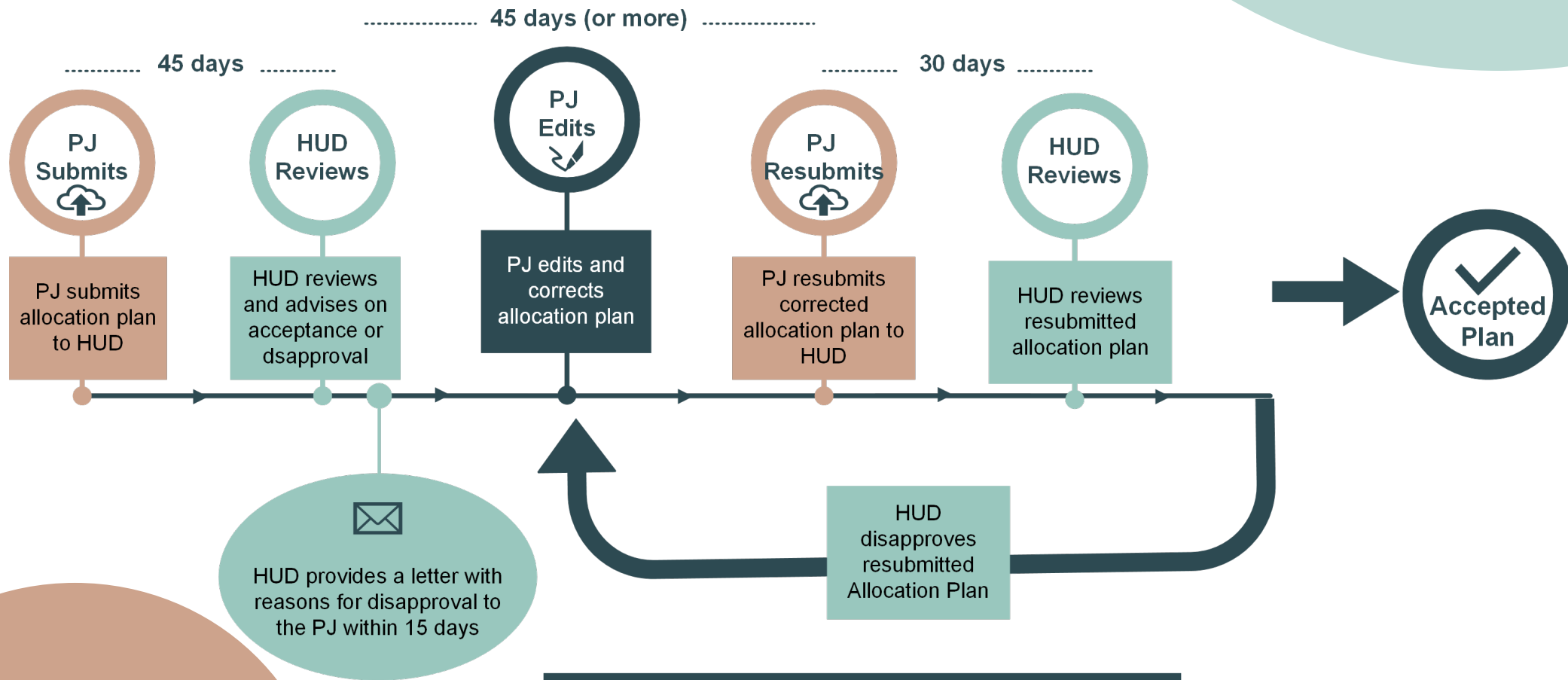


HOME-ARP: Path to Allocation Plan Acceptance
