PEER AMBASSADOR FAQs

What is a Peer Ambassador?

- A peer is a person who belongs to the same age group or social group as someone else.
- An ambassador acts as a representative or promoter of a specific activity.

CRT Peer Ambassadors:

- Engage unhoused Angelenos promoting the COVID-19 Vaccine.
- CRT Peer Ambassadors are rewarded for their volunteer work through a \$25 gift card for every hour worked.

Where will you work?

- Our Community Health workers work at over 250 shelters and throughout encampments across LA County.
- Our teams will connect with you through phone or email and link you to a location close to you.

VACCINE PEER AMBASSADORS

Join our team of Community Health Workers daily throughout Los Angeles County.

Vaccine Peer Ambassadors help our teams talk to unvaccinated people experiencing homelessness and promote the COVID Vaccine and other health resources.



When can you work?

- You will be eligible to be a Peer Ambassador until 6/31/2022.
- You can work Monday through Friday and up to but no more than 23 hours.
- You can work 1-8 hours a day depending on your availability and the need at our events.

Who can be a Peer Ambassador?

- To be a peer you must be currently experiencing homelessness or have formerly experienced homelessness.
- You should be vaccinated, and willing to speak to others about your story and the vaccine.
