



DRGR REPORT RELEASE NOTES

Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) Data Clean-up Performance Reports, Version 3.0 (May 2024)

Summary of Changes and General Notes.

After the retirement of the MicroStrategy project “DRGR OLAP,” this legacy report has now been recreated in the current MicroStrategy project “DRGR Analytics.” Efforts have been made to ensure that the report remains consistent with the legacy report.

Changes were made to both the NSP Data Clean-up Performance Report and NSP Data Clean-up Financial Report. The related report guidance and fact sheet have been updated to reflect changes made to the reports. MicroStrategy reports referenced in the guidance documents have been updated to the current numbering convention.

Please note that the performance report does not present the number of households entered by race, ethnicity, or gender. Grantees should review report “P33 – QPR – Household Characteristics for Direct Benefit Activities by Tenure and Ethnicity.” This report has not changed from the previous version.

The performance report also does not review green measures required by NSP2 and NSP3. Grantees should review report “P42 - CUM - Projected vs Cum Totals for Performance Measure Sorted by Resp Org and Activity Type.” This report has not changed from the previous version.

Changes to the Report Layout, and the Included Attributes and Metrics.

In both reports, the grant number was added to the table header. In the performance report, the HUD Office column was removed.

In Tab 1 of the financial report, the column “Activity Total Disbursed (PF+PI)” was added. This is the cumulative sum of draws for the activity including program funds (line of credit) and program income.

Tab 2 of the financial report only displays the program, grantee, and grant. It no longer displays individual activities. This tab only reports on grant-level metrics and flags. The following columns were added to Tab 2: “Program,” “Grantee,” “Grant,” “LH25 Expended,” and “Admin Expended.”

Please also note that the report is now only available to export to PDF.

Flag Inconsistencies in Actual Accomplishments Only. Planned Accomplishments are not Flagged.

The performance report was changed so that only actual reported accomplishments are considered by the flags. Missing or incomplete proposed accomplishments in the Action Plan are no longer flagged. The inclusion of planned accomplishments was confusing for many users. The focus on actual performance measures and program beneficiaries better reflects the intent of the report and its use to complete and correct cumulative QPR values to facilitate grant close-out.
