



COVID-19 Cases Over Time




Weekly Trends in Number of COVID-19 Cases in The United States Reported to CDC

COVID-19 Community Levels Map





COVID-19 Variant Proportions





- 75.6% of ESG-CV allocation is drawn
- \$96.6 million not committed in IDIS
- \$7.8 million in grants not loaded in IDIS (reallocations)



ESG-CV Grants Status Report

- Draw rates have been down over the last few months
- Assess your progress to determine if you are on target to fully expend funds by the September 30, 2023 deadline.
- Project the HMIS and Admin funds needed for closeout (e.g., for final reporting, reconciling IDIS, etc.), which need to be expended by December 31, 2023.
- If you have concerns about not meeting the deadline, please reach out <u>now</u> for technical assistance.



ESG-CV Grants – Closeout Process

- The SNAPS Office is working on guidance and timelines for closing out ESG-CV grants.
- SNAPS will provide a closeout training to review the steps
- Recipients that have fully drawn their ESG-CV grant can close out their QPR reporting.
- Reporting guidance is posted in Sage instructing recipients how to submit their final QPRs.
- <u>ESG-CV Reporting Office Hours in September 2022</u> reviews the guidance for concluding quarterly reporting
