Overview of DRGR Release 7.14

DRGR 7.14 was released in November 2017 and includes the following enhancements and defect fixes:

ACTION PLAN

USER TYPE	FUNCTIONALITY
Grantee	Grantees can now associate multiple HEROS reviews to DRGR activities. See separate Fact Sheet for additional detail.
HUD	HUD users can now access “View Action Plan” from the HUD Review screen (on the left-hand tool bar). The View Action Plan screen is where documents attached by grantees can be viewed.

QUARTERLY PERFORMANCE REPORT

USER TYPE	FUNCTIONALITY
Grantee	The calculations on QPR PDFs were corrected for Public Service caps, Affordable Rental Housing targets, and progress toward numeric targets. In addition, additional caps/targets/thresholds can be configured (added) without a release.
HUD	HUD users can now access “View QPR” and “Download QPR” from the HUD Review screen (on the left-hand tool bar). The View QPR screen is where documents attached by grantees can be viewed.

ACTION PLAN AND QUARTERLY PERFORMANCE REPORT

USER TYPE	FUNCTIONALITY
Grantee	Grantees can now edit Action Plans and QPRs for grants in “Ready to Close” status. Previously, if the close-out process identified a correction was necessary, the grant status had to be changed back to “Active”. This will better enable grantees/HUD to identify and track grants near or ready to close-out.
Grantee	Grantees can now attach supporting documents at the Action Plan and QPR level. Previously, grantees could only attach a document at the activity level.
Grantee/HUD	Configurable benchmark data (caps/thresholds/progress etc.) can be displayed on the Action Plan and QPR View/Review screens to aid in review of Action Plan/QPRs, grant progress and compliance with expenditure requirements.

DRAWDOWN

USER TYPE	FUNCTIONALITY
Grantee	The Voucher Approval Date on the Voucher Approve screen will now default to the current date.

ADMIN AND HOME SCREEN

USER TYPE	CATEGORY	FUNCTIONALITY
Grantee/HUD	Recertification	All DRGR users must be recertified in June and December to avoid lock-out. Users will receive a reminder at login during June and December until the user is recertified. The reminder text was modified to clarify that users can still access DRGR during June and December, even if they have not yet been recertified.
Grantee/HUD	Emails	HUD can now configure the recipients and content of auto-generated emails without a release.
Grantee/HUD	FAQ	The FAQ search capability was restored (defect from R7.13).
Grantee/HUD	FEMA	HUD HQ is working with FEMA to make key data available for disaster grantees. DRGR will enable access to this data expected to be released in 2018.
Grantee/HUD	Flags	The following defects were corrected: The Edit Activity link is now hidden for flags that are not at the Activity level; updating selected flags no longer closes the flag when it should not; users can now sort search headers and navigate between previous and next page.
Grantee/HUD	Monitoring/TA	A defect was corrected to enable the search of Monitoring and TA events by grant number.
HUD	HUD Monitoring	HUD HQ users can now enter monitoring events into DRGR to enable finding/concern tracking, document exchange, and new report features. See separate Fact Sheet for additional detail.

USER TYPE	REPORT	FUNCTIONALITY
Grantee	SF-425	DRGR will now pre-populate data on SF-425 reports. See separate Fact Sheet for additional detail.
Grantee/HUD	All reports	MicroStrategy was upgraded to version 10.4. General use remains the same. See separate Fact Sheet for additional detail.
