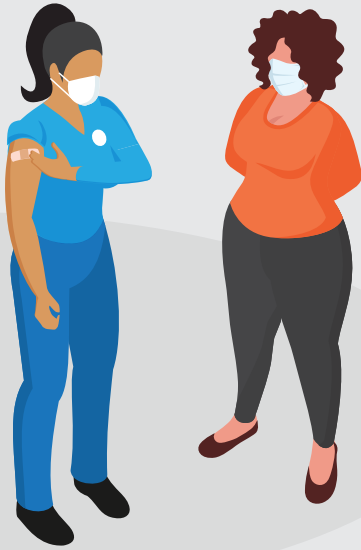




Front Line Workers: Talking with Participants about the Vaccine



As a trusted staff person, participants rely on you to provide information. If you are comfortable you can share:

- Why you chose to get the vaccine
- What your experience was like
- How you feel now that you've had the vaccine
- What freedoms you are enjoying or looking forward to after getting the vaccine

You can help participants understand that COVID-19 vaccines are safe, effective and help prevent hospitalization and death from COVID-19. Whether or not you have made your own decision, you can still ensure participants have the information they need to make the best decision for themselves.
